JUMBO SHRIMP DROP REGULAR SERIES FINALE

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell 4-1 on Sunday in their regular season finale at the Norfolk Tides. A pair of RBI singles from Silas Ardoin and Terrin Vavra in the first got the scoring started for Norfolk. Jacksonville got on the board with a Bennett Hostetler RBI single in the fourth inning to halve the deficit. However, a Tides run in the sixth on an RBI gorund out and another in the eighth on a wild pitch set the final at 4-1. The teams combined to leave a whopping 28 runners on base, with 12 of those contributed by the Jumbo Shrimp offense (1-for-12 with runners in scoring position).

THE CHAMPIONSHIP CHASE

On Tuesday at VvStar Ballpark, Jacksonville will host Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the best-of-three International League Championship Series. The postseason appearance is the first for the Jumbo Shrimp since 2017, and the first playoff home game in Northeast Florida in 11 years. Jacksonville will be vying for its eighth championship in the city's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). The 1968 Jacksonville Suns won the 1968 Governors' Cup to win the IL before claiming six Southern League titles.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 1964

Jacksonville finished the regular year with an 89-61 (.593) record, the best mark in Triple-A. The 89 victories tied the 1964 Jacksonville Suns for the fourth-most in Jacksonville Minor League Baseball history, which dates back to 1904, and were also the most in franchise history since those 1964 Suns. By winning percentage, Jacksonville just enjoyed its best season since the 2006 Suns posted an 86-54 (.614) record.

MEN OF STEAL

In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered only 86 stolen bases, 29th in Triple-A and 119th out of the 120 MilB teams. Jacksonville was not much better in the 2023 (124 steals. 20th in Triple-A) nor 2022 (114, 23rd in Triple-A) campaigns. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp swiped a franchise-record 305 bags, second-most in Triple-A and sixth-best in MiLB. Jacksonville, which had not finished in the top five at their level in stolen bases since at least 2005, has more games with multiple stolen bases (84) in 2025 than games with either one steal (32) or no steals (34) combined.

RECORDS ARE MADE TO BE BROKEN

Jacksonville set franchise-records in 2025 in stolen bases (305) and pitching strikeouts (1,344). The club also neared a pair of other records: The Jumbo Shrimp used a whopping 90 players this season, matching the club record set last year. Of those 90 players, 49 were pitchers, just two away from tying another club record set last season. Jacksonville logged 35 different starting pitchers, smashing the previous record of 28 set last year. At VyStar Ballpark, the club's 44 home victories in 2025 were their most at home since 2010. (also 44), while their 45 road triumphs were their most in recorded club history (since at least 2005).

FORMULA ONF

With a 29-14 (.674) record in one-run games, Jacksonville tied with Indianapolis for the most one-run victories in all of Minor League Baseball. The 29 one-run triumphs are the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp went 58-34 (.630) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 65.2 percent of their 89 victories came by those slim margins.

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

While the Jumbo Shrimp made 126 errors in 2025, sixthmost in Triple-A, Jacksonville's rangy defense helped the club yield the fewest hits and second-fewest runs at the level this season. The Shrimp led Triple-A in defensive efficiency, which simply measures how many batted balls put into play that are turned into outs, at .715, meaning they have turned 71.5 percent of balls put in play into outs.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville bashed home runs in 16 of their final 21 games dating back to August 30. During this stretch, the Shrimp bashed 26 round-trippers, tied for the sixth-most in Triple-A. Comparatively, the club hit just 16 home runs in the 23 games from August 2-28, the fewest at the Triple-A level.

SHRIMP BITES

On the heels of dropping six of seven, the Jumbo Shrimp closed the season by winning 13 of their final 20 games... Jacksonville is hosting its first postseason game since September 12, 2014, a span of 4,029 days



ABOUT ROBBY

-Snelling was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the supplemental first round (39th overall) of the 2022 draft.

On July 30, 2024, the Padres traded Snelling, infielders Jay Beshears and Graham Pauley and right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur to the Miami Marlins in exchange for right-handed pitcher Bryan Hoeing and left-handed pitcher Tanner Scott.

-As a senior at Robert McQueen High School in Nevada, Snelling set a Nevada record for strikeouts in a seven-inning game with 20 strikeouts and posted a state large-class record with 145 strikeouts in 62.1 innings. He posted a 0.56 ERA.

-Snelling was a star high school quarterback and linebacker, and as a 4-star linebacker recruit, had offers to be a two-sport athlete in college. He likely would have committed to Arizona to play both sports, but when then-U of A baseball coach Jay Johnson accepted the same position at LSU, Snelling committed there to only play baseball. He passed on that commitment to sign with the Padres.

-During the summer of 2021, he participated in the High School All-American Game as well as in the All-Star High School Home Run Derby at Coors Field where he hit 21 home runs.

2025 SEASON

-Snelling was named the International League Pitcher of the Month for August after allowing just five runs (three earned) in 30.0 innings over five starts for a 0.90 ERA and 3-1 record. Among those five starts, he had two scoreless outings and struck out 38 against just nine walks. Opponents hit just .189 against Snelling.

-Snelling was promoted to Jacksonville on July 9 from Double-A Pensacola.

-At the time of his promotion, Snelling ranked tied for fourth in the Southern League in strikeouts (85), seventh in WHIP (1.22), 11th in ERA (3.61), 13th in batting average against (.238), tied for 13th in games started (14) and 14th in innings pitched (72.1).

2024 SEASON

-Snelling was transferred to Jacksonville on September 20 from Double-A Pensacola.

With both Double-A San Antonio and Pensacola, held opponents to a .254/.335/.457/.792 batting line in 257 plate appearances. With runners on, that swelled to .322/.376/.503/.879 in 223 plate appearances.

2023 SEASON

-Earned Baseball America's Minor League Pitcher of the Year award.

-Between three levels, Snelling went 11-3 this season with a 1.82 ERA. He struck out 118 and walked 34 in 103.2 innings. He allowed just four home runs in 22 starts. Since 2000, just seven teenage minor league pitchers have recorded a sub-2.00 ERA in 100 innings or more. Snelling is joined on the list by Cole Hamels (2003), Will Inman (2006), Madison Bumgarner (2008), Michael Piñeda (2008), Jose Fernandez (2012) and Andrew Painter (2022). Painter and Snelling were the only two to reach Double-8.

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.
