Springfield Clinches First-Half Crown for Second Consecutive Season

The Springfield Cardinals are headed back to the Texas League Playoffs after securing First-Half North Division Champions on Thursday, June 19 at Hammons Field. The Cardinals took down the Corpus Christi Hooks in a 7-1 victory, guaranteeing that playoff baseball returns to the Ozarks for the third consecutive season. Springfield has now won the first-half title in back-to-back years.

Springfield handled business in the victory. Joshua Baez launched two home runs in the game. It was his third two-homer game this season, his second with Springfield. Pete Hansen tossed six innings of one-run baseball. He struck out six batters en route to his fourth win.

After the game, the Cardinals celebrated inside the Bill Rowe Training Facility beyond the right field fence. Third-year Cardinal Noah Mendlinger led the celebration with his teammates, bringing a pair of goggles to shield his eyes from the sparkling cider sprayed through the air. First-year Springfield Manager Patrick Anderson couldn't escape two ice water baths from his players. The Birds danced the night away, celebrating a hard-fought first-half title that didn't come without adversity. At one point, the team had dropped ten of thirteen games in the second half of April before exploding in May and June.

Thanks to their efforts, the Cardinals will host games two Thursday, September 18 and three (if necessary) Friday, September 19 of the North Division Championship round. Should they advance, they would host game one Sunday, September 21 of the Texas League Championship. Three-game playoff packs are available for fans to purchase on SpringfieldCardinals.com.

Cardinals Make Strange History in Franchise's First Nine-Inning No-Hitter

Mark it down: June 20, 2025, the Springfield Cardinals no hit the Corpus Christi Hooks at Hammons Field in a 1-0 victory. Tink Hence, Zane Mills, Austin Love and Sean Harney completed the feat as a unit on that Friday night. But what's the strange history? It occurred exactly one year to the day that the day the Cardinals threw the first-ever no-hitter (seven innings) in franchise history. Against the exact same opponent as well (June 20, 2024 at Corpus Christi).

"It's hard to put into words. I just wanted to come out and do what I could do," Hence expressed in a postgame interview. The fourth-ranked prospect in the St. Louis system threw 4.1 innings while striking out eight batters on 66 pitches. The righty had been working his way back from a rib injury, which he sustained at the end of Spring Training. He's anticipated to pitch for Triple-A Memphis when he's fully healthy and stretched out. June 20th happened to be Hence's first start back with Springfield after winning Texas League Pitcher of the Year in 2024.

"The guys behind me: Mills comes in and shuts them down, Sean [Harney], Love, it was an all-around job," Hence continued. "From defense, we end up scratching one, and tonight it was all we needed."

The Cardinals pitching staff struck out a combined 13 Hooks in the game. Mills made clean work in 2.2 innings, Love pitched a perfect eighth while Harney gathered the final three outs and started the party in the center of the infield. The only Springfield run scored on an infield single from Darlin Moquete in the bottom of the fifth inning.

It was a Thursday night in South Texas when the Cardinals made history in 2024. Cooper Hjerpe fired five innings, followed by Andrew Marrero's two that completed the first no-hitter in team history. It was game one of a doubleheader that the Cardinals won 5-0. They would end up sweeping the doubleheader and clinching the first half divisional crown that Sunday.

According to Minor League Baseball, the same Major League team has never thrown a no-hitter on the same calendar day in back-to-back years in MLB history.

It ended up being an eventful ending to the longest homestand of the year. The Cardinals had clinched a playoff spot with a victory on Thursday night, threw the no-hitter on Friday, then came back and threw a one-hitter on Sunday led by Hancel Rincon's career-best 11 strikeouts. All told, Springfield won 11 of 12 games over the Tulsa Drillers and Corpus Christi Hooks, one of the most successful homestands in franchise history. Picking a standout moment? Near impossible. Maybe if you asked the 22-year-old Hence he might have an answer.

"A no-hitter? It's just unbelievable."





Patrick Anderson - Manager

After three seasons as manager of the Peoria Chiefs (A+), Anderson will now become the eighth-ever manager in Springfield Cardinals history. Anderson, who calls nearby Columbia, MO home, previously spent seven years in the Nationals organization (2013-19) as manager with the Single-A Hagerstown Suns (2014-19) and Gulf Coast League Nationals (2013). Across ten Minor League managerial seasons, he holds a 661-619 record and a 2013 Gulf Coast League Championship.

Anderson played collegiately at Mars Hill (NC) University and played three years of Independent League Baseball. He brings a wealth of experience to Springfield, as he began coaching in 1996 as an assistant with Gannon (PA) University. He also spent time at Hofstra University as an assistant coach (1999-2001) and head coach (2009-11). Inbetween his college coaching were coaching positions in the Royals organization in the GCL (2001), Midwest League (2002-06), Pioneer League (2007) and Appalachian League (2008).



Eric Peterson-Pitching Coach

Eric Peterson returns for his third season as Springfield's Pitching Coach after guiding a staff last year that featured the Minor League Pitcher of the Year Quinn Mathews and Texas League Pitcher of the Year Tink Hence in 2024. Under his leadership, the 2024 Springfield pitching staff set a franchise record 1,279 strikeouts. The Bear, DE native played college baseball at Temple University for two seasons before transferring to North Carolina State University. He was drafted in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros and suited up for the Corpus Christi Hooks in the Texas League during the 2016 and 2017 campaigns.



Casey Chenoweth-Hitting Coach

Casey Chenoweth enters his third season in the Cardinals organization after spending the 2024 season in Springfield and the 2023 campaign with High-A Peoria, both as hitting coach. The 2025 season will mark his second with Springfield. The Tollhouse, CA native previously spent three years from 2020-22 as the assistant hitting coordinator for the Arizona Diamondbacks and two seasons from 2018-19 as a minor league hitting coach in the San Francisco Giants system. An infielder at East Central University in Ada, OK, Chenoweth played one season of professional baseball in 2017 for the East Side Diamond Hoppers of the United Shore League.



Danny Black-Coach

Danny Black is a newcomer to the Springfield Cardinals. A former utility player with six seasons of experience in the Florida/Miami system. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as a Defensive coach with Double-A Pensacola. He began his coaching career in 2018 and has served in various coaching roles since in the Marlins system.




Alex Wolfinger-Athletic Trainer

Alex Wolfinger joined the St. Louis Cardinals organization in 2018, spanning five different levels including Double-A. The 2025 season marks his fourth consecutive with Springfield. He was named the Texas League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2023 while with Springfield. Wolfinger earned his Bachelor's degree at Neumann University and his Masters at the University of Memphis.



Ryan Duffy-Strength and Conditioning Coach

Ryan Duffy joined Springfield in 2024 after spending two seasons with the Peoria Chiefs (High-A) of the Midwest League (2022, 2023). This is his fourth year in professional sports and his second with the Springfield Cardinals.



Hunter Broadbent-Appiliate Fellow

The 2025 season marks Hunter Broadbent's first in the St. Louis Cardinals organization and his second in affiliated baseball. He spent the 2024 season working for the New York Mets in a similar role with the Double-A Binghamton Rumble Ponies. Broadbent is a 2023 graduate of the University of Connecticut where he worked with the university's baseball program as a Director of Baseball Development and Analytics.
