Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the fifth game of a six-game series. This is the penultimate meeting in the 23-game season series between the two clubs; the Whitecaps are 16-5 against Lansing this season, winning each of the last three games.

Starting Matchup: Knuckleballer **Devin Kirby-Williams** makes his fifth start for the Lugnuts, his first against West Michigan, opposing Whitecaps right-hander **Brady Smith**, part of the three-player package acquired from the Dodgers for recent Whitecaps bobblecap **Tarik Skubal**. The other two players: **River Ryan**, who is on the Triple-A Toledo Injured List and has not pitched since June 17, and the pride of Stafford, Virginia, **Zyhir Hope**, who is 2-for-31 with a single and double for Double-A Erie. Back to **Brady Smith**: he made his High-A debut against Lansing on July 25, allowing seven runs on eight hits (including a **Jared Sprague-Lott** home run) and three walks in in four innings, taking the loss.

Last Night: Whitecaps 5, Lugnuts 3. The 'Caps received back-to-back home runs from **Jackson Strong** and **Bryce Rainer** in the first inning and a pair of home runs from **Beau Ankeney** en route to the Friday night victory. **Jake Reinisch** went 3-for-5 with an RBI double in the losing cause.

Streaking: Outfielder **Jake Reinisch** went 3-for-4 with an RBI double yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 26 games, the longest of the Nuts' season. Reinisch is batting .291/.445/.477 with 25 base hits and 22 walks during the streak.

Major League Lugnuts: Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics, and – on August 9 with two scoreless innings in relief – 2021 Lugnut **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets. In all 48 Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season.

Filling the Squad: On the current Athletics active roster, there are 10 former Lugnuts: **Brady Basso**, **Hogan Harris**, **Gage Jump**, **Jack Perkins**, **Max Muncy**, **Tommy White**, **Jacob Wilson**, **Henry Bolte**, **Lawrence Butler** and **Tyler Soderstrom**.

Cooperstownian Nut: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted on July 26 into Cooperstown alongside **Jeff Kent** and **Andruw Jones**. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

2024: In front of 6,628 Lanstronauts, the Cap City Olive Burgers overcame a constant rain to grill the West Michigan Whitecaps, 6-5, on a Lansing Facts Thursday night at Jackson® Field™. Right fielder Nate Nankil went 4-for-4 and center fielder Ryan Lasko went 3-for-5 to lead a 14-hit Olive Burgers attack.

2015: Leo De Vries dominates Dayton, crushing two home runs and a triple with five RBIs to help the Nuts thump the Dragons, 11-6.

In a Nutshell: The right-hander with the seven-pitch arsenal (including a knuckler) became the 12th different Lugenut to start a game this season on July 23 vs. Great Lakes, the 26th different pitcher (including position-player/pitcher Gunner Gouldsmith), and the 1,007th player in Lugenuts history... opened the year with the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs (5 GS, 1-0, 3.09, 23 1/3 IP, 11 BB, 22 K) before his contract was purchased by the A's on May 22... made four appearances with the Complex League A's and six appearances with Single-A Stockton before he was called up to replace the promoted Ben Hansen and Zane Taylor.

Hometown Hero: Ukiah is located just south of Redwood Valley in northern California, 115 miles north of San Francisco... Aaron Rodgers spent several years of his youth in Ukiah... the iconic Don Mossi lived in Ukiah after retiring... Kirby was a two-time First Team All-Conference at Ukiah High School, 2016-2017.

College Life: Kirby spent 2019 with Santa Rosa Junior College and was named First Team All-American, All-Conference, All-State and All-Region, posting a 1.09 ERA with 79 K in 49 2/3 IP, 17 SV, 28 games pitched... transferred to UConn and missed the 2021 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery... returned in 2022 as UConn's relief ace, recording the final five outs to beat Xavier to win the Big East championship... in 2023, went 7-1, 4.35, 49 2/3 IP, 43 K, as the Huskies won the Big East regular season championship.

Off to Pro Ball: Spent 2023-2025 in the Twins' organization... pitched in the 2024 Arizona Fall League (6 G, 9.53 ERA, 11 1/3 IP, 11 H, 13 BB, 8 K)... released May 28, 2025... signed with the Orioles on June 6, 2025... released by the Orioles on August 2, 2025... signed with the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs to open 2026... signed with the A's, May 22... moved up to Lansing, July 22.
