-Selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the third round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of Cypress Creek High School.

-Signed for \$600,000, forgoing his commitment to Tulane University.

-Made St. Louis Opening Day roster in 2018 having never pitched above High-A (used as a starter in minor leagues).

-Appeared in 73 games in 2018, posting a 3.59 ERA in 77.2 innings while holding opponents to a .208 batting average against.

-On May 20, 2018, threw the fastest pitch in MLB history (tied with Aroldis Chapman), registered at 105.1 MPH.

-Recorded 14 saves and a 3.14 ERA in 28.1 innings with St. Louis in 2019.

-101.1 MPH average pitch velocity in 2019 was highest in MLB and threw fastest pitch of the season at 104.3 MPH.

-Underwent Tommy John surgery on June 25, 2019.

-Opted out of 2020 season due to COVID-19 concerns (has Type 1 diabetes).

-On March 14, 2021 was involved in 22pitch at-bat with Luis Guillorme of the New York Mets in Spring Training (longest AB in MLB history).

-Made 10 appearances with St. Louis in 2021 before going on IL with right elbow inflammation.
