YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Fightin Phils, 6-1. Richmond took a 3-0 lead in the first inning with a sac fly by **Andy Thomas**, an RBI single by **Carter Williams** and an RBI single by **Jimmy Glowenke**. In the sixth, Thomas hit a solo home run to extend the lead to 4-0. Richmond added a run on an error in the seventh to pull ahead, 5-0. Reading broke the shutout in the eighth inning with a solo home run by Johan Rojas. In the top of the ninth, Glowenke added solo homer, his second in the last two carnes.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the second of the year between the two teams. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with a three-game sweep against the Fightin Phils at The Diamond on April 8 and 9. The Flying Squirrels have now won back-to-back series after not winning a single series since late April.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 10-2 in their last 12 games since June 18, including taking four-of-five so far this week in Reading to open the second half of the season. They won six straight from June 23 through Friday, their longest winning streak since a seven-game stretch from April 28-May 5, 2022. Over the last 12 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .270 (108-for-400) with 14 homers, 26 doubles and have scored 72 runs. In that same stretch, the Richmond pitching staff has a 2.80 ERA (33 ER/106.0 IP) with 132 strikeouts. Over the last 18 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 2-2 with a 1.99 ERA (14 ER/63.1 IP). For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.75 ERA is tied for the best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 264.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 374.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.43 ERA, which is second-lowest in Double-A and seventh-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS were 28-40 in the first half of the season, which was last in the Eastern League. They have lost six-of-eight, including four-of-five in this week's series. The Fightin Phils opened the season 0-5, including a three-game sweep at The Diamond to begin the year. The Reading offense leads the league in batting average (.261), hits (645), total bases (1056), doubles (136), triples (16) and OPS (.777). In this week's series, the Fightin Phils are batting .181 (28-for-155) and averaging 2.4 runs per game (12 runs/5 games). Reading's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including RHP Mick Abel (No. 2), RHP Griff McGarry (No. 4), OF Johan Rojas (No. 5), OF Ethan Wilson (No. 11), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 17) and OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 22). McGarry is rated by Baseball America as having the best fastball, Ortiz is rated as having the best outfield arm and Baron Radcliff is rated as the best power hitter. MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospect list includes Abel (No. 2), McGarry (No. 4), Rojas (No. 6), De La Cruz (No. 9), Wilson (No. 14) and Ortiz (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his 14th start of the season and his third appearance against the Fightin Phils. In the series opener on Tuesday, Murphy threw four perfect innings and struck out five batters. In his last five starts since June 4, Murphy is 0-2 with a 2.41 ERA (5 ER/18.2 IP). He pitched against the Fightin Phils out of the bullpen in the season-opener on April 8 at The Diamond and threw two scoreless innings. Last year, Murphy made his home debut at The Diamond against Reading and pitched five hitless, scoreless innings. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. For more on Murphy, see page two.

FOR READING: Left-hander Josh Hendrickson makes his 11th start of the season. He made his last three appearances pitching out of the bullpen with Triple-A Lehigh Valley, posting a 7.20 ERA in 10 innings of work. He last started for Reading on June 11 against Binghamton and matched a season high with six runs allowed over four innings in a loss. Hendrickson made his season debut on April 9 at The Diamond and allowed five runs (one earned) over three innings in a loss. A native of Perth, Australia, Hendrickson was selected in the 38th round by the Phillies in the 2019 MLB Draft out of the University of San Diego. He first reached Double-A in 2021, going 4-3 with a 3.64 ERA in 14 games en route to being named an MiLB.com Phillies Organization All-Star. Last year, he was limited to 10 starts across four levels. Hendrickson has pitched 29 games (26 starts) for Reading in his career, going 5-11 with a 5.00 ERA (75 ER/135.0 IP).

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** Andy Thomas has picked up 11 RBIs over his last six games since June 24. From last Saturday through Thursday, he collected nine RBIs over a four-game span, including a two-run homer on Thursday night at Reading. On Sunday night, he added a sac fly and a solo homer. In his last six games, Thomas is batting .348 (8-for-23) with two homers, three doubles, a triple and 11 RBIs. For the season, Thomas leads the Flying Squirrels with 38 RBIs. Thomas has at least one extra-base hit in six consecutive games, the longest active streak in the Eastern League.

**VAUN GONE WILD: Vaun Brown** is riding an eight-game hit streak since June 22. He has homered three times in that stretch, including home runs in each of the first two games of this week's series. In his last eight games, Brown is batting .361 (13-for-36) with three homers, four doubles and nine RBIs, adding three stolen bases. Over his previous nine games from June 9-20, Brown hit .057 (2-for-35) with three walks and 16 strikeouts.

**GLOW SHOW:** Jimmy Glowenke hit his first Double-A homer on Saturday night, a two-run shot, and added a solo home run on Sunday night. It marked the second time Glowenke has homered in back-to-back games in his professional career. He last did it on September 18 and 19, 2021, the final two games of the regular season, with Low-A San Jose. Prior to his four hits over the last two games, Glowenke hit .032 (1-for-31) over his previous nine games from June 15-30.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Since his promotion to Double-A on June 13, Logan Wyatt is batting .306 (11-for-36) with three homers, two doubles and eight RBIs. Between his time with High-A Eugene and with Richmond, Wyatt has homered 11 times this season in 63 games. Wyatt hit his first Double-A homer on June 23 at The Diamond against the Senators. He hit his second Double-A home run on Thursday night at Reading and finished the game with four RBIs, which tied his career high. Wyatt added another homer, a solo shot, in a two-RBI performance on Friday. He has driven in six runs over his last three games.

RETURN OF THE MECK: In Game 1 of June 23's doubleheader, Wade Meckler closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game. In the first four games of this week's series, Meckler has reached base 12 times with nine hits, including four on Thursday, and three walks. Meckler has now reached base in all 20 of his Double-A games, including 31 hits and 15 walks. His on-base streak is the longest active streak in the league and the longest by a Richmond player this season. He also leads the league with seven consecutive games scoring a run. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 180 PA) this season with a .424 batting average and a .492 OBP. On Friday, he hit an inside-the-park homer, his first Double-A home run. It was the fourth inside-the-park home run in Flying Squirrels franchise history, joining Brandon Crawford (2010), Tyler Graham (2014) and Tyler Fitzgerald (2023).

RAGIN' CANTRELLE: In his last 14 games since June 14, Hayden Cantrelle has reached base 22 times, posting a .431 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up 10 hits, walked 10 times and been hit by a pitch twice in 51 plate appearances. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. He also ranks sixth in the league in on-base percentage (.395) and tied for seventh in walks (45). He is also second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year.

**DLD FRIENDS:** Reading's roster includes former Flying Squirrels pitcher Matt Seelinger, who played with Richmond in 2021. The reliever spent that entire season with the Flying Squirrels, going 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was selected by the Phillies in the minor-league phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. With Reading last year, Seelinger pitched against Richmond twice, both at The Diamond, and allowed one unearned run over 2.2 innings of work with four strikeouts. Seelinger is one of five former Richmond players in the Eastern League this year. Frankie Tostado, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is playing with the Senators. Diego Rincones, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for the Erie SeaWolves. Pitcher Grey Fenter, a member of the 2022 Flying Squirrels, is now with the Somerset Patriots. Patrick Ruotolo, who pitched with Richmond in 2018, 2021 and 2022, signed with the Nationals over the weekend and joined the Harrisburg Senators.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 2), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
