ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Vancouver Canadians fell to the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) 9-6 on Saturday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

Hillsboro scored four runs in the first inning - including a lead-off homer from Jorge Barrosa - to jump out to an early lead, but the C's came roaring back with two runs in the second on Will Robertson's two-run blast then took the lead with three runs in the third. In that inning, Zac Cook was hit by a pitch before Rafael Lantigua doubled to put two runners on. Tanner Morris extended his hitting streak to 17 consecutive games with a two-RBI double to tie the game then Spencer Horwitz made it 17 straight with a hit with a run-scoring single to make it 5-4 Vancouver.

The lead proved to be short-lived. A three-run bottom of the third put the Canadians behind by two before back-to-back solo shots in the home half of the fourth ran the score to 9-5 Hops.

Horwitz hit his second home run in as many days in the fifth to bring Vancouver within three, but despite putting runners on base in three of the final four innings the C's couldn't mount another comeback and dropped their third game of the series.

Willy Gaston and Thomas Ruwe were excellent in relief. The former tossed three shutout innings, allowed two hits and K'd two while the latter put up a zero in the eighth with a walk and two punch outs in his third career High-A outing.

BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO: Vancouver and Hillsboro meet for their fourth series of the season this week. The C's faltered in round three August 3-8 when they were the home team for the first time; they lost the final four games of the series after taking the first two. Hillsboro has outscored the Canadians 117-100 in the season series thus far.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: August 29, 2018 - Vancouver overcame a 3-0 deficit and scored 10 unanswered runs to beat Everett 10-3 at The Nat. A four-run sixth - highlighted by Griffin Conine's seventh home run of the year - proved to be the difference Conine finished the day with two hits and three RBI. Will McAffer got the win in relief.

DING DONG DAYS OF SUMMER: Three homers last night give the C's 33 jacks this season, the most they've hit in any given month this season. Their previous high was 21 in June.

HOMER HOP-PY: The Canadians have homered in all five games of this series, their most consecutive games with at least one long ball.

BMOC: Spencer Horwitz was named High-A West Player of the Week for August 17-22. The Timonium, MD native went 13-for-21 (.619) with three doubles, two home runs, six runs scored, six RBI and five walks. He reached base 67% of the time, slugged 1.048 and compiled an OPS of 1.715 in a series split with the Tri-City Dust Devils (Angels) while raising his season average from .260 to .274.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Spencer Horwitz and Tanner Morris have a hit in 17 consecutive games, the longest hitting streak by any C's hitter this season. Horwitz has gone 30-for-67 (.448) with seven doubles, five homers, 14 runs scored, 20 RBI and 15 walks while Morris is 21-for-74 (.284) with six doubles, a triple, nine runs scored, eight RBI and seven walks.

ACE OF ON BASE: Tanner Morris has reached base in a season-high 26 consecutive games since July 25. He's 32-for-108 (.296) with eight doubles, a triple, 11 runs scored, 12 RBI and 11 walks.

ON THE HILL: #13 Blue Jays prospect Sem Robberse makes his second start of the series this afternoon. He took the loss in the opener on Tuesday but turned in his first quality start in High-A; that night, the Dutch right-hander went six innings, allowed three runs on three hits - including a two-run homer - walked one and struck out four. He finished the outing by retiring the last 10 batters he faced after the home run. Robberse, 19, started the year with Low-A Dunedin where he went 5-4 with a 3.90 ERA in 14 games (12 starts) across 57.2 innings pitched and limited Low-A Southeast hitters to a .214 batting average. He signed with Toronto on July 24, 2019 after growing up in Woudenberg, Netherlands where he taught himself how to pitch. Woudenberg is a suburb of Utrecht, the fourth-largest city in the country and 26 miles south of Amsterdam.

Kyler Stout goes for Hillsboro. He last got a start on August 22 in Spokane when he allowed four unearned runs on three hits in two innings of work. Today is his eighth outing (second start) against the C's; he's compiled a 6.14 ERA across 7.1 innings versus Vancouver and the Canadians hit .267 against him. Stout, 26, was Arizona's 18th round pick (549th overall) in 2018 out of Oral Roberts, where he went 2-2 with a 2.70 ERA and 13 saves over 26.2 innings pitched as the Golden Eagles' closer.
