**PAPILLION, NEB.** - The Omaha Storm Chasers won their fourth consecutive game in game two of this week's series against the Gwinnett Stripers, 7-2 at Werner Park. The Stripers jumped out the gate in the first inning on a Leury Garcia sacrifice fly, a 1-0 Gwinnett lead just a few batters into the game. Omaha did not trail for long as Cam Devanney hammered his second home run of the season to left field in the bottom of the 2nd inning tie the score up 1-1. The Chasers quickly took the lead for good in the 3rd inning, as rehabbing DH Michael Massey ripped his second double of the series to center field and brought John Rave home to give Omaha a 2-1 lead ... two batters later, CJ Alexander walked to load the bases, then Mike Brosseau was hit by a pitch to bring Tolbert home from third base and extended the lead 3-1. Omaha scored single runs in the final four innings, to progressively pull away from the Stripers ... after Nick Pratto singled in the 5th inning, Alexander hit his team-best fifth double of the season to score Pratto from second base and grow the lead to 4-1 ... in the 6th inning, Devanney and Nate Eaton connected on back-to-back doubles, extending the lead to 5-1. Catcher Brian O'Keefe kept the scoring going in the 7th inning, when he led off the frame with his first homer of the year and pushed to the lead 6-1 ... that long ball gave all nine Omaha starters at least one base hit for the second straight game. The Stripers briefly cut into the Chasers lead as Garcia nailed his first homer of the year to right field in the top of the 8th inning and cut the score down 6-2 ... the Chasers loaded the bases with three straight walks in the bottom of the 8th inning and O'Keefe grounded into a force out that brought Rave home and added some insurance for a 7-2 score that held to be final. With his best start of the season, Omaha starter Andrew Hoffman struck out five in 5.0 innings and allowed just the first inning run as he earned his first win of the year. After allowing his first two batters of the top of the sixth inning to reach, Hoffman was replaced by reliever Sam Long, who struck out two batters and retired all five he faced in 2.0 scoreless innings ... Dan Altavilla allowed the home run in the 8th but otherwise retired the side ... Will Klein pitched top of the ninth inning and stranded a runner on third base to finish off the game, Omaha's fourth straight win.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### ALEXANDER THE GREAT

Infielder CJ Alexander has been Omaha's top hitter through the first 10 games of the season, leading the team in nearly every offensive category. Alexander leads the Storm Chasers in hits (14), doubles (5), home runs (3), runs batted in (10), extra-base hits (8), total bases (28) and is tied first in runs scored (7) ... among qualified Chasers hitters, he also leads the team in batting average (.333), slugging percentage (.667) and OPS (1.016). The left-handed hitter is tied 4th in the International League in extra-base hits, tied 7th in total bases and hits, and tied 8th in RBI. CJ also tied for the team lead with 5 multi-hit games this season, with hits in 7 of 10 games he's played this year.

#### DAZZLING DEFENSE

While still early in the season, the Omaha Storm Chasers have established themselves at one of the best defensive teams in Minor League Baseball, with just 2 errors made in 390 total chances (league-best .995 fielding percentage). The Chasers haven't made a throwing error, just a caught stealing error (interference) on March 30 vs. Iowa and a fielding error yesterday. Omaha did not make an error in 7 games, between March 31 and April 7 ... since 2011, the Storm Chasers have just 6 stretches of 7+ games without making an error. Every other Triple-A team has made at least 4 errors and Omaha is the only Triple-A team with a fielding percentage above .990.

#### RELIABLE RELIEVERS

The Storm Chasers bullpen is still of the best in the International League as Omaha's relievers have combined for a 3.65 ERA through the team's first 11 games. A 3.65 ERA (20 ER in 49.1 IP) ranks 8th among the 30 Triple-A teams, while a .180 opponents' batting average (31-for-172) ranks 2nd at the Triple-A level. The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .188 average (28-for-149), which is the second-best mark among Triple-A teams, trailing only Nashville (.145 average). Three relievers have yet to allow a run this year: Walter Pennington (7.0 IP), Sam Long (6.2 IP) and Will Klein (5.0 IP) ... Pennington and Long have the most scoreless innings of any International League reliever, the 3rd and 4th-most scoreless innings pitched without allowing a run of any arm in the league, respectively.

#### THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the team got off to a slow start on the basepaths, Omaha's stolen base has picked up as the year has gone on, with 18 steals in 21 tries. 18 steals ranks 3rd in the International League and 4th among all Triple-A teams. The Storm Chasers have 2+ steals in 4 straight games and 5 of the last 6 games ... the Chasers are 11 for their last 11 in steals.
