Luke Ritters scored the Ponies only run after he singled, stole second and third, and scored on a wild pitch in the second inning. New Hampshire responded with two runs in the home half of the second and added one more in the fourth. Binghamton out-hit New Hampshire 6-3 with six different Ponies hitters tallying a hit (Rudick, Jordan, McIlwain, Gomez, Ritter, Mena).

Like Mike: RHP **Mike Vasil** currently ranks in the top five in the Eastern League in three different categories. The 23-year-old ranks first in opponent batting average (.159) and WHIP (0.70), while ranking fourth in strikeouts (41).

Ponies Run Wild in Queens: The New York Mets came-from-behind three separate times against the Tampa Bay Rays at Citi Field on Wednesday night. Former Binghamton Rumble Ponies first baseman **Pete Alonso** (2017-18) slugged a walk-off three-run homer in the 10th inning to win 8-7.

The Kid Line: The New York Mets recalled former Binghamton Rumble Ponies infielder **Mark Vientos** (2021) from Triple-A Syracuse yesterday ahead of last night's game. Vientos batted eighth and played third base for the big club in his 2023 season debut. He ripped a game-tying two-run homer on a line drive to center in the seventh inning to make it a 2-2 ballgame.

With the Rays leading 5-2 in the bottom of the ninth, former Rumble Ponies catcher **Francisco Álvarez** (2022) came up to the plate as the tying-run with runners on first and second and two outs. He crushed a game-tying three-run homer on a 1-0 count with the Mets down to their final out, to make it 5-5 and force extra innings.

Former Binghamton Rumble Ponies infielder **Brett Baty** (2021-22) will start at third base and bat fifth for the Mets this afternoon against Tampa Bay.

Last Start: Vasil is coming off one of the most dominant starts of his professional career. He pitched a career-high eight innings against Hartford last week at home. He allowed just one run on four hits, which was a solo homer, and struckout seven without issuing a walk. Vasil left the start leading 3-1, but Hartford tied it in the ninth to force extra innings. He has seven strikeouts in four-straight starts.

2022: Went 4-2 with a 3.53 ERA in 18 appearances and 17 starts across three levels. Made eight starts for both St. Lucie (A) and Brooklyn (A+). Went 3-1 with a 2.19 ERA for St. Lucie and 1-1 with a 5.13 ERA for the Cyclones. With St. Lucie, he allowed opponents to bat .193 against him. With Brooklyn, opponents hit .197 against him. He totaled 85 strikeouts in 71.1 innings across the three levels.

BACKGROUND: Begins the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' No. 4 pitching prospect and the No. 11 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. Pitched for the Peoria Javelinas in the 2022 Arizona Fall League, alongside teammate Brandon McIlwain with Ried Brignac as a coach on the staff. He was drafted by the Mets in the eighth round of the 2021 draft out of Virginia. Helped lead UVA to the College World Series in his final season as a junior in 2021, while ranking in the top 10 in the ACC in strikeouts looking (33), wins (7), and innings pitched (81.2). Was the 2017 Massachussetts Player of the Year and Perfect Game's No. 1 overall player out of Mass. and the No. 7 pitcher in the country out of high school.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins.
