Osvaldo Bido: Right-hander Osvaldo Bido will make his seventh appearance of the season tonight against St. Paul at 7:37 PM ET. He made a team-leading 25 starts with Indianapolis last season, he went 3-8 with a 4.53 ERA (56er/111.1ip) and a team-high 122 strikeouts.

Last Outing: On May 6 at Toledo, he allowed only one run in 5.0 innings with six punchouts.

Against the Saints: Bido has allowed only one earned run in 9.0 innings between two starts this season against St. Paul.

Vs. Righties: Right-handed batters are 8-for-57 against Bido to start the season with 20 strikeouts.

Miscellaneous: Signed by PIT as a non-drafted free agent on 3/14/17 ... Is one of seven players from Los Hidalgos, D.R. to play professional baseball in American and the first reach Double-A ... Rated by Baseball America as the No. 26 prospect in the Pirates organization following the 2019 season.
