YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Hartford Yard Goats, 10-9, in a back-and-forth game. **Frankie Tostado** gave the Flying Squirrels at 10-9 lead with a two-run homer in the top of the ninth with two outs. The Flying Squirrels opened a 7-0 lead through the first two innings. **Sandro Fabian**, **Andres Angulo** and **Shane Matheny** each drove in runs with singles in the first to open a 4-0 lead. In the second, Fabian added another RBI single and Tostado brought in two runs with a double to extend the advantage to 7-0. Hartford broke into the scoring with a two-run homer by Willie Abreu in the second and Sean Bouchard added a solo homer in the third. The Yard Goats closed within three runs in the fourth with an RBI single by Abreu. In the fifth, Tostado hit his first homer of the night, a solo shot to left, to open an 8-4 lead. Hartford tied the game with four runs in the sixth. Abreu and Javier Guevara hit RBI singles. Matt McLaughlin popped out to second, but Angulo was charged with catchers interference for touching the baseball with his helmet, allowing another run to score. Abreu scored on a wild pitch by **Jose Marte** to tie the score, 8-8. The Yard Goats took the lead in the seventh with a ground-rule double by **Montes**. **Joey Marciano** picked up his first win of the year after working through four outs. **R.J. Dabovich** picked up his first Double-A save, recording the final two outs.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks Richmond's only trip to Dunkin Donuts Park this season and the final series between the two teams. The Flying Squirrels opened the season against the Yard Goats at The Diamond from May 4-9. In that series, the Yard Goats took a victory in the season opener on May 4, but the Flying Squirrels won the next five games by a combined score of 33-17.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won four of the last six games and three of four in the current series. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 3.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .233 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked fourth in the league with a 3.71 ERA for the season.

THE YARD GOATS have lost six of the last seven games. They currently sit tied for fifth place in the Double-A Northeast's Northeast Division, 16.5 games behind first-place Somerset. The Yard Goats batters are ranked tenth in the Double-A Northeast with a .223 batting average. The Hartford pitching staff is ranked last in the circuit with a 5.79 ERA. Hartford's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects, including 3B Elehuis Montero (9), OF Jameson Hannah (13), RHP Karl Kauffmann (17), RHP Tommy Doyle (21) and RHP Ryan Feltner (22).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Michael Plassmeyer** makes third Richmond start and his first against Hartford. He last pitched on Sunday in the series finale at Somerset, allowing two runs over 5.0 innings in a shutout loss. Both of his first two starts with Richmond came in Somerset, and he combined to go 0-2 with an 8.38 ERA. Plassmeyer was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the San Francisco Giants on June 11 in exchange for right-handed pitcher Matt Wisler. He began the season with Double-A Montgomery in the Double-A South. In his first four outings of the year, he went 0-1 with a 7.36 ERA (12 ER/14.2 IP). In his last three outings before the trade, all in relief, he combined for a 2-0 record over 15.0 scoreless innings with 18 strikeouts and two walks. Plassmeyer was originally drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round in 2018 out of the University of Missouri, but he was traded to Tampa Bay after one professional season along with catcher Mike Zunino and outfielder Guillermo Heredia for outfielders Mallex Smith and Jake Fraley. In his first season with the Rays organization in 2019, his first full professional season, Plassmeyer posted a 1.91 overall ERA, which was the third-lowest for a pitcher in Tampa Bay's minor league system in the history of the franchise, trailing only a 1.41 ERA by Blake Snell in 2015 and a 1.77 ERA by Dylan Floro in 2013. **For more on Plassmeyer, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Garrett Schilling makes his ninth start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Sunday at New Hampshire and allowed season highs in hits (10) and runs (5) over 4.1 innings in a loss. In his previous 7 starts to open the season, he allowed either two or three runs in each outing. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels in his season debut on May 5 at The Diamond and worked 4.2 innings, allowing three runs, in a no-decision. Schilling was drafted by the Rockies in the 19th round in 2017 out of Xavier University in Cincinnati. This year is his first season at the Double-A level.

GETTING THEIR GOAT: The Flying Squirrels won seven consecutive games against the Yard Goats from May 5 to June 23. That stretch was the longest win streak the Flying Squirrels have ever posted against the Yard Goats, topping a four-game win streak from Aug. 18, 2018-April 6, 2019. It was also the longest win streak for either team in the history of their head-to-head matchups. For the season, Richmond has outscored Hartford, 60-40.

TOASTY: Over his last 16 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .322 (19-for-63) with three homers, four doubles and 17 RBIs. He is now first on the team this season with 27 RBIs. He is also first among qualified Richmond batters with a .276 batting average on the year. On Friday, Tostado recorded a season-high four hits and became the first Richmond player this year to record five RBIs in a single game.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over his last 18 games since June 1, **Sando Fabian** is batting .357 (20-for-56) with two homers, six doubles and 14 RBIs while scoring seven runs. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .276.

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, **David Villar** has hit .412 (14-for-34) with three homers and seven RBIs over his last nine games since June 16. He picked up three hits last Wednesday night, tying a season high, and added a solo homer June 17. He went deep again on Friday. In the series opener at Hartford on Tuesday, Villar hit his team-leading eighth home run of the season, extended his team-best RBI total to 23 and collected three hits for the third time in 2021.

SETTLING IN: Connecticut native **Simon Whiteman** started his Double-A career 0-for-17 in his first four games from June 15-18 after being promoted from High-A Richmond. In his last six games since June 19, Whiteman is batting .375 (9-for-24) with nine singles. In that stretch, he has collected multiple hits in four games, including a Double-A-high three singles on Friday night. Since joining the Flying Squirrels, Whiteman has picked up six stolen bases, which is tied for the team lead this season.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 25-21 record is tied for the best start in team history through 456 games, even with the start in the franchise's inaugural season in 2010. That year, the team posted a 26-21 mark through 47 games.

LAW OF AVERAGES: The 12 teams in the Double-A Northeast have combined to hit .242 this season. In 2019, the Eastern League combined for a .238 batting average, which was the lowest for the circuit since a .234 mark in 1971 and the sixth-lowest since the league was first classified as "Double-A" in 1963.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with six RBIs and four runs scored by pitchers at the plate. Flying Squirrels pitchers have eight hits this year, which is tied for first in the league with Reading. Over the year, Richmond has gone 22-12 (.647) against National League affiliates, but have gone 3-9 (.333) against affiliates of American League clubs. After not using the designated hitter for last week's series against Somerset, pitchers return to the batter's box for the next two sets against Hartford and Binghamton. After July 4, the Flying Squirrels will return to using the DH for the remaining four series in July.

GOING FOR GOLD: Flying Squirrels manager **José Alguacil** is currently away from the team for a second time this season to manage his home country, Venezuela, in the final WBSC Olympic Qualifier in Puebla, Mexico. Venezuela lost to the Dominican Republic in its first game of the tournament on Tuesday, 10-7. The team rebounded for a 9-3 win over the Netherlands on Wednesday night. In an elimination game on Friday night, Venezuela beat the Netherlands, 10-0, to advance to the finals against the Dominican Republic. The winner of that game will secure a spot in the Olympics later this summer in Tokyo, Japan. Flying Squirrels fundamentals coach **Gary Davenport** is handling the Flying Squirrels' managerial duties during Alguacil's absence.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
