INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Despite allowing four first inning runs, the Indianapolis Indians countered with early offense to snap a four-game losing streak against the Rochester Red Wings on Saturday night at Innovative Field, 13-4. Trailing 4-0 after one inning, the Indians jumped on Rochester starter Jackson Rutledge for six runs in the top of the third, highlighted by a pair of two-run doubles from Ji Hwan Bae and Matt Gorski. An inning later, the Indians continued their offensive onslaught on the Red Wings with a five-run fourth, headlined by a grand slam from Malcom Nuñez. All of the scoring in the fourth inning came with nobody out, and it marked the second inning in a row that the Indians lineup hit around. Indianapolis tacked on two more in the top of the ninth thanks to an RBI double from Seth Beer and a run-producing single from Gilberto Celestino.

COMEBACK CITY: Down by four runs following the bottom of the first inning, the Indians offense strung together 13 runs on as many hits to defeat the Red Wings in comeback fashion. It was their largest comeback victory since overcoming a four-run deficit after the third inning vs. lowa on Aug. 24, 2023, at Victory Field. It is their largest comeback effort on the road since overcoming a six-run deficit after six innings with a five-run seventh, one-run eighth and six-run ninth on July 1, 2023, at Louisville Slugger Field.

GRAND SLAM (MALCOM'S VERSION): Malcom Nuñez swung the Indians to victory last night, launching the team's second home run this season (also: Mike Jarvis, May 26 at lowa) in the third inning to extend the lead even further beyond Rochester's reach. In total, he went 3-for-5 with three runs and a season-high four RBI, his most since Aug. 4, 2023, with High-A Greensboro vs. Asheville. Nuñez tied his career-high in runs scored in the contest, and his grand salami was the fourth of his career and first since launching one on April 16, 2023, with Indianapolis vs. St. Paul. The long ball was his eighth of the season and second since last Saturday vs. Iowa.

GORSKI GOES FOR EXTRA BASES: With last night's go-ahead double, Matt Gorski now is tied for the fourth-most extra-base hits in the International League with 33. He also ranks sixth among IL qualifiers with a .568 slugging percentage. His double in the third inning put the Indians over Rochester's early 4-0 lead and was his second of three consecutive plate appearances reaching base safely.

BAE'S BACK: Ji Hwan Bae logged his second consecutive multi-hit game and fourth in seven June games last night, going 2-for-5 with two runs, a double and two RBI. Down by four runs, he plated the Indians first two runs on a one-out double to center field in the third inning. The two-bagger was his first extra-base hit of the month, his previous eight hits coming as singles. Bae continues to own International League pitching not only this year, but in his career. In 34 games with the Indians this season, he is hitting .362 (46-for-127). In 151 games of his Triple-A career, he is hitting .308 (178-for-578) with 31 doubles, seven triples, 13 home runs and 40 stolen bases.

PEGUERO POPS: Liover Peguero extended his hitting streak to four games - the latter three of which have each been two-hit performances - last night with a pair of hits, runs and RBI in last night's victory. With two runs already in and Ji Hwan Bae on second base, he singled home the speedy utilityman in the third inning to cut the early four-run deficit down to one. Since Game 1 in Thursday's doubleheader, he is 7-for-15 with five runs, two extra-base hits and five RBI.

TWO BEERS, PLEASE: Seth Beer continued his hot streak of late at Rochester, going 2-for-5 with two runs, doubling home Malcom Nuñez as the Indians penultimate run in the top of the ninth inning. It was his third consecutive game with a hit, and since Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader he is 5-for-12 with two runs, two doubles and five RBI. After not driving in an RBI in his first five games with Indianapolis, he has driven in at least one in each of his last three.

HELLERBALL: Ben Heller put up another 2.0 perfect frames on his impressive stretch of dominance in the International League out of the bullpen last night. He has not allowed a run across his last nine outings (9.2ip) since May 21 at lowa, recording a 0.72 WHIP and .094 batting average against (3-for-32). His ninegame shutout streak is currently tied with Durham's Manuel Rodríguez for the second-longest active such streak by appearances in the International League, trailing Charlotte's Sammy Peralta and Iowa's Ethan Roberts (10 appearances).

GERMÁN'S GEM: Domingo Germán settled in after allowing four runs on three hits in the first inning, spinning 4.0 shutout innings to follow as the Indians mounted a comeback effort. After allowing a two-out single in the second inning, he retired nine batters in a row through the beginning of the fifth inning. It was his third consecutive win after losing four of his first five starts with the Indians. Since June 18 vs. lowa, he has allowed seven earned runs in 16.0 innings with 15 strikeouts.

TODAY: The Indians close out their six-game road trip at Innovative Field, home of the Rochester Red Wings, this afternoon at 1:05 PM ET. It is their first road trip to Rochester since 2019 after going 8-4 vs. the Red Wings at Victory Field from 2022-23. On Sept. 19, 2023, the Indians defeated Rochester 19-1 for their largest margin of victory again the opponent in the all-time head-to-head series. Taking the mound for the Indians today is RHP Isaac Mattson, making his third start with the Indians this season and second appearance against Rochester this week. Countering for the Red Wings is major league rehabber RHP Josiah Gray (0-0, 1.50), who allowed one run over 6.0 innings during a pitchers' duel with RHP Braxton Ashcraft in Tuesday's series opener.

THIS DATE IN 1990: The Indians prevailed at Iowa in 14 innings, 5-4, behind an 18-hit attack. Indianapolis sent the game to extras by scoring one in the ninth to make it 3-3, and both teams traded single runs in the 12th to extend the game further. Indy left 19 runners on base to lowa's eight in the triumph. Center fielder Steve Hecht finished 3-for-8 with a double, RBI, two runs scored and a stolen base atop Indy's lineup.
