Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play the final game of their 27th season in the Midwest League, the finale of a six-game series against the Lake County Captains, the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, the 227th all-time meeting between the two teams. The Lugnuts are 9-14 vs. the Captains this season and 2-8 in games played at Classic Auto Group Park, losing four of five games in Eastlake in April before winning four of seven games in Lansing in May, splitting a six-game series in July, and dropping four of the first five games in the current series.

Yesterday: Captains 5, Lugnuts 1. Jake Fox broke a fifth-inning tie with an RBI triple and added a three-run homer two innings later, driving Lake County to the Saturday night victory. Gunnar Hoglund fired four scoreless innings in the defeat, with Euriel Angeles belting his seventh home run of the season for the Lugnuts' sole run.

Starting Matchup: Pitt Panther Mitch Myers makes his 21st start of the year for Lansing, four outs away from reaching the 100-inning plateau, while Lake County counters with southpaw Ryan Webb, making his 17th High-A start and his second start of the series.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler calls the action on StreamGuys while Logan Potosky has the call on Bally Live and MiLB.TV.

LUG•NOTES

Sizzling at the Plate: SS Euriel Angeles is batting .429 in September with 15 hits in his last 35 at-bats, while 1B Brennan Milone has 15 hits in his last 31 at-bats and has reached base 12 times in 19 plate appearances in this series.

Finishing the Year, Recent History:

2022: The Lugnuts' scheduled finale was rained out vs. September 11. On September 10, the final game of the year, a pair of future Major Leaguers starred. Mason Miller struck out seven batters in three shutout innings and Lawrence Butler went 4-for-4 with two home runs in a 9-5 victory over Dayton.

2021: The regular season went all the way until September 19th, when the Lugnuts were shellacked by West Michigan, 19-4. The Whitecaps hit five home runs in the win, the last off catcher Will Simoneit. The game lasted three hours and 20 minutes.

2019: On September 2, Lansing wrapped things up at Fort Wayne with a 3-1 victory behind a complete game from Sean Wymer and solo home runs from Yorman Rodriguez, Otto Lopez and Griffin Conine.

2018: On September 3, the Nuts closed out the regular season in Lake County with a 3-2 loss, the runs supplied from solo homers from Brandon Grudzielanek and Samad Taylor. Lansing then opened the postseason (a two-game sweep at the hands of Bowling Green) two days later.

2017: Lansing lost September 4 at home, 10-1, to the Dayton Dragons. A day later, the Lugnuts played Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown.

2016: On September 5, the Nuts closed things out at Lake County with a 4-3 walkoff loss on an Angel Miguel game-winning single. Carl Wise had forced a bottom of the ninth with a home run in the ninth. Teenagers Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. had informally joined the Nuts in Eastlake to take batting practice.

2015: On September 7, the Dragons scored six runs in the fifth inning to beat the Lugnuts in Dayton, 7-2. Two days later, the Nuts entered the postseason and went on to sweep out Great Lakes before losing to eventual champion West Michigan in three games in the second round.

2014: On September 1, the Lugnuts lost at home to South Bend, 5-4, in a game shortened to six innings due to rain. Rowdy Tellez went 3-for-3 with a home run in the loss.

2013: On September 2, the Nuts scored eight runs in the sixth inning at home against West Michigan, romping to a 9-4 victory behind starter Kendall Graveman.

2012: On September 3, Lansing scored six runs in the third inning only to allow 15 unanswered runs at home to Lake County, capped by a nine-run seventh inning, in a 15-6 loss that included 28 total hits in front of 7,517.

2011: On September 5, playing at Dayton in a precursor to the Lugnuts playing at the Dragons in a postseason series (that the Nuts won, 2 games to 1), Billy Hamilton stole his 101st, 102nd and 103rd bases of the year in a 3-2 victory over Lansing.

2010: On September 6, Jake Marisnick and Brad McElroy each collected four hits and the Lugnuts destroyed the Captains at Classic Park, 11-0.

Among the League Leaders, Individual: The promoted Daniel Susac leads the Midwest League in qualified batting average with a .303 average and is tied for 7th in hits (111), 8th in OPS (.810) and 9th in OBP (.373). Danny Bautista, Jr. is 2nd in base hits (118) and 6th in batting average (.273). Junior Pérez is tied for 3rd in stolen bases (41), tied for 6th in doubles (26), 9th in total bases (168) and 10th in extra-base hits (40).

Record-Setter, Individual: Reliever Brock Whittlesey owns the career appearances record at 103 games pitched. Whittlesey appeared in 32 games in 2021, 33 games in 2022 and 38 games thus far in 2023. Of those 103, one – in 2021 – was a spot start. Whittlesey has allowed just two earned runs in his last 17 innings.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has two current first-rounders: shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, and the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, 19th overall, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade in March 2022 for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, and 2022 first-round selection, catcher Daniel Susac, are both currently excelling with the Double-A Midland RockHounds in the Texas League.

Big League Nuts: Nine former Lugnuts have reached the Majors this year, totaling 182 all-time Nuts to go from Lansing to The Show. Those nine: Ryan Noda on March 30; Hogan Harris on April 14; Mason Miller on April 19; Garrett Acton on May 14; Samad Taylor on June 18; Tyler Soderstrom on July 14; both Lawrence Butler and Hagen Danner on August 11; and Drew Millas on August 28. (Davis Schneider, who debuted on August 4, only played for the Nuts in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown.)

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2003: Game 2 of the Midwest League Championship Series. The Lugnuts defeated the Snappers, 3-2, moving within one victory of the title. Right fielder J.J. Johnson left the game with an injured shoulder after running into the right-field wall making a threat-squashing catch in the seventh inning, stranding two runners aboard.

2015: It was the Lugnuts' first walk-off win all year, and it came on a Ryan McBroom sac fly in the bottom of the 9th, helping the Nuts sweep the Great Lakes Loons out of the playoffs with a 5-4 win. The Loons had scored two runs with two outs in the top of the ninth to take the lead, only to see the Nuts rally behind back-to-back one-out doubles from Danny Jansen and Chris Carlson, followed by walks to Richard Ureña and Jason Leblebjian from Tommy Bergians. The Nuts advanced to face West Michigan (who would subsequently eliminate Lansing, 2 games to 1, on their way to winning the MWL title).

2022: In his third and final Lugnuts appearance, Mason Miller struck out seven Dayton Dragons in three hitless innings and Lawrence Butler went 4-for-4 with a walk, single, double and two home runs in a 9-5 win on Fan Appreciation Night.

In a Nutshell: The last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers this year was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9.

International Respect: Mitch is ranked No. 3 in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball*... he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.

July 10	-	Vlad Guerrero, Jr. wins the 2023 Home Run Derby, outslugging Julio Rodriguez in the final.
July 14	-	Tyler Soderstrom becomes the 179th Lugnut to reach MLB, debuting for Oakland.
July 17	-	Kumar Nambiar took part in a panel of new labor unions held at the White House with President Biden and Vice President Harris. Nambiar, a product of Yale, spoke on behalf of the Minor League Baseball Players Union, with whom he had played a key role during the historic offseason negotiations with Major League Baseball.
August 1	-	2023 sixth overall pick Jacob Wilson joins the Lugnuts in Cedar Rapids.
August 10	-	The world's no. 1 eater, Joey Chestnut, came to Jackson Field to set the olive burger eating record on Lansing Facts Night (13 in five minutes), and Euribiel Ángeles hit the first grand slam of the season in a 7-4 victory over Fort Wayne.
August 11	-	Lawrence Butler (Oakland) and Hagen Danner (Toronto) became the 180th and 181st Lugnuts to reach MLB.
August 26	-	Gunnar Hoglund came a third-inning Trey Faltine HBP away from firing five perfect innings in his Lugnuts debut, striking out seven Dayton Dragons. Jack Rogers' one-out single in the bottom of the eighth broke up the no-hitter in a 3-2 Lugnuts win.
August 28	-	C Drew Millas becomes the 182nd Lugnut to reach MLB, debuting for Washington.
Sept. 3	-	The Lugnuts score 10 runs in the 3rd inning en route to a 19-9 rout of West Michigan.
