THE JESÚS MADE GAME™

SS JESÚS MADE (5-for-5, 2 HR, 7 RBI) tied the Shuckers single-game franchise record on Friday with 5 hits, including 7 RBI and a grand slam... Made became the 6th Shucker to record a 5-hit game and the 1st since **OF LAMAR SPARKS** on July 4, 2024, at Mississippi... The performance marked Made's team-leading 30th multi-hit game of the season and his 2nd career multi-home run game.

- ☞ Made joined **SS LEO DE VRIES** (4/22/25, A+, FW) as the 2nd teenager since 2005 in Minor League to record 5+ hits, 2+ home runs and 7+ RBI in a game... Made is the only player to achieve the feat in Double-A or Triple-A.
- ☞ Made enters today with 74 RBI, tied with **OF COREY RAY** for the 4th-most in a season in franchise history.

RAKE BURKE

On Saturday night, **1B BLAKE BURKE** joined **3B ANDREW FISCHER** as the second Brewers minor league player since 2001 with a 30-home-run season... Burke became the 17th player to achieve the feat in Brewers minor league history.

- ☞ Burke became the 1st Southern League player to record a 30 home run season since **OF ADAM BRETT WALKER** (CHA) in 2015... Burke is the fastest Double-A player since at least 2005 to reach 30 home runs, needing 88 games to reach the mark.
- ☞ Across 20 games in July, Burke hit .351 (27-for-77) with 9 doubles, 12 home runs, 32 RBI, a .447 on-base percentage and a 1.382 OPS.
- ☞ Burke enters today with 86 RBI, the 2nd-most in a single season in franchise history... Burke is 3 RBI from tying the Shuckers single-season record of 89, set by **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** in 2023.

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

With 3 home runs on Saturday night, the Shuckers have hit 30 in their last 8 games... Across 31 games in the second half, the Shuckers have hit 66 home runs, the most in Minor League Baseball.

- ☞ The single-season franchise record for home runs is 154, set in 2022... The Shuckers need 22 home runs over the final 37 games of the season to break the record.

GONE FISCH-ING

3B ANDREW FISCHER recorded his 34th home run of the season on Friday, tied with **C BILL FOLEY** (1978) and **OF SIXTO LEZCANO** (1974) for the 4th-most by a Brewers Minor League player in franchise history (since 1970)... His 34 home runs mark the most by a Brewers Minor League hitter since 1985.

- ☞ Fischer needs 6 home runs over the final 40 games of the season to become the 2nd Brewers Minor League player with a 40 home run season... He would become the first since **CF GORMAN THOMAS** (51) in 1974.

Across the 1st 5 games of this week's series between the Shuckers and Biscuits, the teams have combined for a ballpark record 96 runs, 20 doubles, 36 home runs, a .342 average and a 1.100 OPS.

- ☞ Across 14 games at Keesler Federal Park in the second half, teams have combined for a .311/.403/.582 slash line, a .985 OPS, 54 doubles, 70 home runs and 16.5 runs per game... Keesler Federal Park is averaging a home run every 14.20 at bats in the half, the 2nd-lowest mark out of any ballpark in Major League and Minor League Baseball.
