#### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox suffered a second-consecutive 10th inning walk-off defeat at the hands of the Harrisburg Senators on Saturday night. Bowie took a 4-0 lead by the top of the third on home runs from Jud Fabian and Dylan Beavers, along with an RBI single from Collin Burns. Harrisburg bounced back to tie the game by the sixth, walking it off on a bunt base hit in the tenth. Bowie left a season-high 15 runners on base in its fourth-straight defeat.

#### TELL THE WHOLE PHAM

RHP Alex Pham is coming off the best outing of his Double-A career. The No. 24 O's prospect tossed six shutout innings for the first time in his professional career Tuesday in Harrisburg. Pham struck out six in just the second six-inning start from a Bowie arm this season. Pham is tied with Trace Bright for the team lead with 62 strikeouts on the season. The Baysox staff leads the Eastern League in that category (620). Pham has struggled a bit with the long ball this season. Allowing 9 in 60.1 IP after just 5 across 60.2 IP in Double-A last season.

#### TERRY TWO BAGS

Baysox RF/1B **TT Bowens** hit his team-leading 15th double of the season on Saturday night - tying him for the third-most in the Eastern League this season. Bowens has been a clutch bat for Bowie, leading the team with 34 RBI this season.

#### ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B Dylan Beavers has reached base in 45 of 52 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.368) and leads the team in walks (32), the sixth-most in the Eastern League. Saturday was the tenth time Beavers reached base at least three times in a game this season.

#### THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

Bowie's Jud Fabian hit his 12th home run of the season on Saturday night, tying him for the second-most long balls in the Eastern League this season. Fabian hit a leaguehigh six homers in the month of May and has four thus far in June - including three this week. He's hitting .242 through 52 games this season after hitting just .176 in 64 AA games season. His batting average on balls in play has jumped 70 points in that span.

The Baysox have struggled to come up with the big hit so far during their week in Harrisburg. Bowie is hitting .233 this season with runners in scoring position - ninth in the Eastern League. The Baysox are just 6-for-43 (.140) in such scenarios this week, with 47 runners left on base. By comparison, Bowie has plated just three runs when hitting with runners in scoring position this week.

#### BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (296) and strikeouts (342). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.19 WHIP, which is good for fourth-lowest in Double-A

#### SCOUTING THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators sit at 32-25 on the season - tied for second in the Eastern League Southwest division and just a game out of first place. Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators are led by second-year manager and former Baysox player (1999) Delino DeShields. Harrisburg's roster includes four of the Nationals' top 8 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF Dylan Crews (WSH No. 2/MLB. No. 6), IF Brady House (WSH No. 3/MLB No. 36), IF Yohandy Morales (WSH No. 4/MLB No. 88), and OF Robert Hassell III (WSH No. 8).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Michael Cuevas is set to take the ball in the series finale for Harrisburg. No stranger to the Baysox, Cuevas will be making his sixth start against Bowie and 18th start of his professional career against an Orioles farmhand. He got the start on Tuesday, allowing just one run through a season-high six and two-thirds, scattering eight hits. Cuevas was a 23rd round pick of the Nationals in 2019 out of Brennan High School in San Antonio, Texas

2024: Threw first scoreless start of season by matching career-high 6.0 IP and gave up just 2 H and 0 BB over 6 K to record win in most recent start on 6/11 @ HBG. Owns a 1.29 ERA in 14 IP against HBG in his career. Baysox have won seven of last eight games that Pham has started in. Has struck out 5+ batters in eight of 12 starts. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Allowed just two runs or less in four of his five starts in May. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX**

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



#### **COACHING STAFF**

## ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticus He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assist ant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2023 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

## AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1.363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

### CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

### BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facteau first served in the Orioles' organization as a technology intern.
