### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

Nashville has not played on June 3 since the 2018 season. Even on that date, they weren't the Sounds. The Nashville Honky Tonks beat the Round Rock Dance Halls, 3-2, at Dell Diamond in Round Rock, Texas.

**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Charlotte Knights play game three of a six-game series tonight in Charlotte. Nashville has won the first two games of the set, including a 7-4 win last night. Tonight, right-hander Josh Lindblom gets the ball for the Sounds against right-hander Felix Paulino for the Knights.

**Josh Lindblom:** 33-year-old Josh Lindblom gets the ball for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is making his third appearance with Nashville and 11th overall in 2021. Lindblom has made eight of those appearances with Milwaukee where he was 0-0 with a 9.72 ERA prior to being designated for assignment on May 26. He was then sent outright to Nashville on May 28. The last time Lindblom pitched for Nashville was on May 8 in Toledo when he was on a Major League rehab assignment. Lindblom was signed a three-year deal with the Brewers on December 16, 2019.

**Félix Paulino:** 26-year-old Félix Paulino starts for Charlotte in game three of the set tonight. The right-hander is 1-1 with a 9.00 ERA in four games (all starts) with the Knights in 2021. In 13.0 innings, Paulino has allowed 13 runs on 17 hits and 7 walks to go along with 12 strikeouts. He last pitched on May 27 in Norfolk and allowed 4 runs on 4 hits in 2.0 innings. He did not factor into the decision. Paulino did not pitch in 2020 and was acquired by the White Sox organization in a trade with Philadelphia on August 22, 2018.

**2021 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 9, Second: 5, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

**A Chance at History:** The Sounds attempt to match a franchise-record 15-game winning streak tonight in Charlotte. If they succeed, they'll match the 1999 Sounds and 2018 Sounds with 15-game streaks. The 1999 team had a 15-game winning streak from June 2-10 when their record went from 31-22 to 46-22. That team lost in Tucson, Arizona on June 22 in an 8-7, 13-inning affair. In 2018, the Sounds won 15 consecutive games from July 29-August 14. Their record went from 51-55 to 66-55. The 2018 streak ended on August 15 in a 3-1 loss to Round Rock at First Horizon Park.

**On a Roll:** Nashville's 14-game winning streak is the longest the club has had in nearly three years and is the longest winning streak in Minor League Baseball during the 2021 season. Low-A Bradenton has the second-longest active streak in MiLB at eight games. The last time a Sounds team won 14 or more games was the 15-game winning streak that matched a franchise record from July 29-August 14, 2018.

**Inside the Streak:** During Nashville's current 14-game winning streak, the team is hitting .261 (123-for-471) with 35 doubles, 28 home runs and 67 walks. The team has scored 91 runs and is averaging 6.5 runs per game. The pitching staff has compiled a 2.76 ERA (39 ER/127.0 IP) and has allowed only 82 hits and 48 walks to go along with 139 strikeouts. Nashville pitchers have a 1.02 WHIP and has limited opponents to a .181 batting average.

**Dustin Peterson for Six:** Nashville outfielder Dustin Peterson has hit safely in six consecutive games, the second time in 2021 he has compiled a hitting streak of at least six games. He's hitting .296 (8-for-27) with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBI and 2 walks during the streak.

**Walk This Way:** Last night was the third time this year Sounds hitters have drawn 10 walks in a game. They also drew 10 on May 27 at Columbus and May 15 vs. Memphis.

**10+ Hits = A Winning Formula:** In last night's 7-4 win, Nashville collected 11 hits. It was the ninth time the Sounds have had at least 10 hits in a game in 2021. They are now 9-0 when recording 10+ hits.

**In The History Book:** The Sounds have the club's best record through the first 25 games of the season at 20-5. The 2003 and 2006 Nashville Sounds' teams each started 17-8 through the first 25 contests.

**Grass Is Always Greener:** Sounds infielder Zach Green is among Triple-A East League leaders in several offensive categories, including home runs (1st, 9), RBI (1st, 26, extra-base hits (T-5th, 13), slugging percentage (5th, .650) and total bases (7th, 52).

**Road Warriors:** The Sounds have won 11 straight games on the road and are averaging 7.66 runs per game during that span.

**How Sweet It Is:** Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,047-1,926. The 2,047 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

**The Milwaukee Era:** A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

**LAST OUTING:** Lindblom's last outing was on May 25 with the Brewers. He pitched in relief against the San Diego Padres and went 2.0 innings in Nashville's 7-1 loss. He didn't allow a hit but walked a batter and allowed 1 earned run. He struck out four and threw 33 pitches / 18 strikes.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Lindblom is facing Charlotte for the first time in 2021. He has one career appearance against Charlotte which happened on June 17, 2017 when he was with Triple-A Indianapolis. He tossed 2.0 scoreless innings and earned a hold.

- Has made 8 appearances with Milwaukee - all out of the bullpen
- Was placed on the 10-day injured list on 4/24 with right knee effusion
