OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN: Fireflies skipper David Noworyta returns to the soda city for the 2026 campaign after leading the Fireflies to the Carolina League playoffs in his first season at the helm. Noworyta played in affiliated ball for the Detroit Tigers and climbed the ladder to Lakeland prior to being released in 2020. After that, Noworyta played in independent baseball before signing with the Royals as a coach. The University of Hawaii product spent time in Quad Cities and Omaha as an assistant coach before coming to Columbia to manage in 2025.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Last year, the Fireflies clinched their first playoff berth after finishing the first half 36-30 in order to earn a South Division title. In the first round of the playoffs, Columbia swept Myrtle Beach in a best-of-three series. In the second round of the playoffs, the Fireflies met the Lynchburg Hillcats and fell in the third game of the series, falling one game shy of the club's first championship. This year's roster features 17 returnees from the 2025 roster, including Blake Wolters and Kendry Chourio, who both started one of the three Championship Series games for the Fireflies.

SOME SERIOUS TALENT: The Fireflies have six of the Royals 30 top prospects on their Opening Day roster according to MLB Pipeline. Blake Wolters, Kendry Chourio and Michael Lombardi are the arms in the top 30 nad Yandel Ricardo, Sean Gamble and Josh Hammond are the bats that are representing the list for Columbia. Wolters, Chourio and Ricardo are all returning to Columbia after spending time with the team during the 2025 season.

REPPING THE DRAFT: The Fireflies are welcoming nine members of the 2025 draft to bolster the roster, including each of the Royals' top three selections. Sean Gamble was selected 23rd overall in the first round. Josh Hammond was selected 28th overall as a Prospect Promotion Incentive pick the Royals were granted after Bobby Witt Jr. finished in the top three of AL MVP voting in 2024. Michael Lombardi was selected 61st overall in the second round of the draft. In addition to those three, Brooks Bryan (C, 8th round), Shane Van Dam (RHP, 9th round), Max Martin (RHP, 10th round), J.C. Vanek (INF, 14th round), Connor Rasmussen (INF, 15th round) and Randy Ramnarace (RHP, 16th round) are also joining the team.

HOME TOWN SPIRIT: Connor Rasmussen rejoins the team after finishing the 2025 season in the Carolina League. Rasmussen is familiar with the Midlands. He grew up in Fort Mill and his brother, Cole, was the long snapper for the University of South Carolina Gamecocks last season.

FAMILIAR FACES: The Fireflies have a lot of similarities to the 2025 team that clinched their first playoff berth in franchise history. The coaching staff is nearly identical. The only difference is that bench coach Tripp Keister moved to Omaha and was replaced with an additional hitting coach, Chris Nelson. In addition to the staff, Columbia returns 17 players that were on the 2025 roster at one point. There are nine returning pitchers and eight returning hitters.

HOME OPENER: The Fireflies play their first game at Segra Park Tuesday, April 7 at 7:05 pm against their in-state rival, the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. Each fan in attendance will receive a free 2026 magnet schedule thanks to Service Experts. For tickets and more information, visit FirefliesTickets.com.

MiLB: The 17-year-old advanced from the DSL to Columbia in his first pro season. In a month-stretch in the ACL he dominated opponents in June with a 2.04 ERA and a 22 strikeout to one walk ratio while holding opponents to a .185 batting average... When he was promoted to Columbia, the righty became the youngest stateside player since Julio Urias in 2013... Earned his first professional win August 14 vs The Myrtle Beach Pelicans. He spun five perfect innings with four punchouts to secure a 7-2 victory.

Personal: Although he shares a last name and hometown with Brewer's star Jackson Chourio and his brother Jaison, he has no relation to the two brothers. Signed to a \$245,000 bonus, which was the seventh-largest bonus in The Royals 2025 International signing class.

Allowed one earned run or less in final seven appearances of standout 2023 season. In final season in DSL, the righty decreased his WHIP to 1.12 from 1.38. Went stateside in 2025 and transitioned to a full-time reliever role. He earned his first save in a 3-1 victory over the ACL Brewers June 4. Basora slung 1.1 scoreless frames in the contest.

MiLB: Rolled out the gates with a 1.72 ERA in the month of May, tallying 18 strikeouts and holding opponents to a .224 average... Was promoted to The Fireflies roster July 29 where he tossed 3.1 hitless innings in his debut. Following that start August 2, he was placed on the development list August 12 and did not pitch again during the 2025 season.

Personal: After being named a Rawlings All-American Second Team pitcher at Wallkill High School, the Royals steered him away from a University of Texas commitment with a \$347,500 bonus, which is slotted for the sixth round.

MiLB: He played two seasons in the DSL before missing the entirety of the 2024 season due to injury. He came back healthy in 2025 in the ACL. He dominated in May with a 0.84 ERA across five appearances where he allowed just one run in 10.2 innings while whiffing 13. In June, he posted a 1.93 ERA with 18 strikeouts in 18.2 innings, to earn a promotion to the Columbia Fireflies. In his last start of the season September 5 at Myrtle Beach, he worked five scoreless innings and allowed five hits and one walk, while keeping the Fireflies in control for a 6-1 victory.

MiLB: Has spent each of the last three seasons in The ACL. He was perfect across three innings in May 2025, posting a 0.00 ERA and held a 1.50 ERA in six innings in June. Even as a lefty, he showed strong splits against right-handed batters, holding them to a .154 average. This winter, he worked 10 games in The Australian Baseball League with the Brisbane Bandits.

Personal: Herbold has pitched with The Neptunis Rotterdam since he was 10. In 2023, he was on The Netherlands U-18 National Team and worked 8.2 innings while punching out 10 batters across two games. He helped lead the club to its best-ever finish in a World Baseball Cup (fifth place)... His dad is The Royal Dutch Baseball Softball Federation President (KNBSB).

MiLB: The righty recorded a 2.84 ERA in the ACL across four appearances (6.1 IP) in June 2024 to earn the call up to Columbia. Improved his ERA by over a point year-over-year in the Carolina League... Finished the campaign with the fourth-most innings pitched (68.1) on the Fireflies roster and the most out of a reliever. Across the Carolina League, he threw the fourth most innings for a pitcher who started fewer than five games.... Leal rushed out of the gates in April 2025. The reliever recorded a 0.69 ERA in seven games (13 IP) where he held opponents to a .143 average and maintained a 0.85 WHIP. Leal also had a strong July where opponent hit .137 against him, his WHIP was 0.78 and he recorded a 1.76 ERA with 18 strikeouts in 15.1 IP.

In 2025 he went 4-1 with a 2.14 ERA and led the American Conference with 11 saves. The righty struck out 73 batters in 42 innings while allowing just 20 hits. May 20, 2025 vs Florida Atlantic, he threw seven innings, allowed two hits and one run, and struck out 11 on 105 pitches. Lombardi was named American Conference Pitcher of the Week April 7, 2025, and earned First Team All American Conference Honors as a relief pitcher.

In four relief appearances over 10 innings, Perez was 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA. On the run, he held opponents to a .160 average and he recorded 16 strikeouts... Got better each month through the 2025 season. He had a 7.00 ERA in May, before notching marks of 4.50 in June, 3.72 in July and 3.12 in August. During that final month of the regular season, Perez had 17 strikeouts in a season-best 17 innings while holding opponents to a .231 average.

MiLB: Moved stateside in 2025 after a pair of seasons in the DSL and then posted career-bests in ERA, strikeouts, innings pitched, walks and WHIP... The 21-year-old had a 38.7% chase rate on pitches out of the zone last year, which was the third best for a pitcher in the ACL who threw at least 25 innings. The high chase-rate is credited to a plus-slider that he uses as a chase pitch. When Reyes is ahead in the count, opponent hit just .105 against him in 2025... His best month of 2025 came in June when the righty worked 12.1 innings without surrendering an earned run. He struck out 15 compared to just three walks and held opponents to a .140 average to compliment a 0.73 WHIP on the run...

In 2024, he tore his UCL May 3 at Florida State that ended his season and limited Van Dam to three games (all in May) in 2025... Van Dam was the quarterback of Cranston High School and also played baseball. The last player drafted that attended Cranston High School was Gordon Graceffo who was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. Graceffo made his MLB debut in 2024 and has pitched in 28 games as a big leaguer.

MiLB: Woods opened 2025 with Columbia after spending the 2024 season in the ACL...Found most success when coming out of the bullpen with a 2.45 ERA compared to his 5.56 ERA as a starter...After a challenging stretch in June with a 5.94 ERA, he turned in his best month in July, going 2-0 with a 1.23 ERA and limiting hitters to a .146 average across 14.2 innings. He carried that momentum into the second half of the season, posting a 1.31 ERA while allowing just nine hits over 20.2 innings...Woods was particularly effective at home where he went 2-2 with a 2.43 across 29.2 innings, compared to a 5.61 ERA on the road.
