RIDERS SNAP FOUR-GAME SKID WITH SLIM WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders gained a lead in the third inning after **Evan Carter**'s triple and held on for a 3-2 win over the Tulsa Drillers on Thursday at Riders Field. Carter tripled on the first pitch of the third inning and scored on the next delivery due to a wild pitch. Frisco (23-19, 54-56) took its first lead at 2-1. Tulsa (15-27, 56-55) took the lead on a solo home run in the second inning but did not score again until the ninth. **Frainyer Chavez** had the game-tying RBI on a groundout the previous inning and then added an RBI single in the eighth to make it 3-1. Chavez was the third batter to single in the eighth, joining Liam Hicks and Kellen Strahm, to provide an insurance run. **Antoine Kelly** used that insurance when he allowed one run in the ninth. He struck out two and still collected the save. Hicks reached all four plate appearances on Thursday with a double, a single, a walk and a hit by pitch. He has reached base in all 28 home games this year and 24 of his last 26 games overall. **Dane Acker** pitched into the fifth inning in his start for Frisco. He allowed one run on three hits in 4.1 innings. **Grant Wolfram** (8-0) collected the win, taking care of 1.2 innings without a run. **Justin Slaten** added two hitless innings for Frisco. Kendall Williams (1-1) was tagged with the loss, giving up two runs over 4.2 innings. Strahm went 2-for-4 in the ballgame as Frisco got its first win of the series. The Riders wasted little time turning their league-leading 99th and 100th double plays on Thursday. After a leadoff walk to open the ballgame, Acker induced a ground ball that Chavez, **Keyber Rodriguez** and **Trevor Hauver** turned for two outs. In the fifth, Wolfram exited a jam with another twin killing from Chavez to Rodriguez to Hauver.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 15 games in August, (8-7 record) the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 3.09 ERA while allowing a league-low 12 home runs and .214 BAA. The bullpen has allowed just 21 earned runs over 72.0 innings, a 2.63 ERA with 97 strikeouts to 25 walks. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday in Corpus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is last in the Texas League with a .702 OPS and runs per game with 4.3 per contest.

WINS AND LOSSES WITH RISIP:

The RoughRiders won four in a row in Corpus Christi before losing their last four of their last five entering Friday's game. Over the four wins in a row, the Riders allowed just three runs on the pitching side (0.75 ERA) while scoring 4.8 runs per game and hitting .250 (8-for-32) with runners in scoring position. Over the last five games, Frisco has allowed 27 runs (5.23 ERA) while scoring 3.2 runs per game and hitting .172 (10-for-58) with runners in scoring position.

THE ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season. In the second half, Frisco is a league-best 12-9 on the road and they have the second-best road record overall in the Texas League at 30-27. Away from Riders Field, Frisco is averaging a league-best 5.8 runs per game and they have a league-high 107 doubles on the road as well. At home, the Riders are just 23-29 on the season, only trailing Wichita for the worst home record in the Texas League.

HAU YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 44 games since, he is batting .287/.407/.482/.889 with 12 doubles, six home runs, 27 RBIs and 34 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 33 points and his OPS 91 points.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 68 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 16.5 percent walk rate this year is fourth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 18 times in his last 17 games. His .413 OBP on the season is eighth in all of Double-A and among all 12 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 26 games, Hicks is batting .333 (30-for-90)/.444/.456/.900 with six doubles, a triple, a home run, 13 RBIs, 16 walks and 13 runs scored. In his last 13 games, he is batting .364 (16-for-44) with a .972 OPS.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on Thursday in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all nine save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Gagesse** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT SETH

-Seth went to Mountain View High School in Arizona, which has produced four MLB players. Scott Lydy (MLB in 1993), Brian Banks (1996-2003), Shea Hillenbrand (2001-2007) and Brad Mills (2009-2015) all were Mountain View Toros.

-Nordlin was the highest-drafted pitcher alumni (13th round in 2017) from of Mountain View since Spencer Moran was drafted in the 11th round in 2014 out of Concordia.

-In his sophomore season at GateWay Community College, Nordlin went 4-3 with a 1.91 ERA before being drafted by the Rangers. That season, he had 123 strikeouts to 17 walks in 85.0 innings for Geckos.

2023 SEASON

-Selected in the Minor League Rule 5 draft by the Minnesota Twins in December of 2022 and assigned to Double-A Wichita.

-Released by the Twins on June 4th and signed by the Rangers on June 6th.

2022 SEASON

-Designated as one of two "long relief" pitchers for Frisco, along with Tai Tiedemann at the beginning of the year.

-Promoted to Triple-A Round Rock for spot start on July 14th at El Paso, throwing 3.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits while striking out three and walking one.

-Made first Double-A start on July 27th at Springfield, throwing four shutout innings in a 5-2 win.

2021 SEASON

-Pitched in 20 games with 11 starts for High-A Hickory.

-Struggled as a starter, going 0-5 with a 6.48 ERA, but pitched well in relief: 3-0, 3.27 ERA.

-Nordlin's 83.0 innings were the second-most on the Crawdads, just trailing Avery Weems (85.1).

2019-2020 SEASON

-Missed entire 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Was one of team's most-used relievers in Arizona Fall League in 2020, (16.0 IP, 14 H, 9 R, 5 BB, 20 K).

2018 SEASON

-Playing with Short-Season Low-A Spokane, he led the Northwest League in strikeouts with 79 while being fourth in innings (68.1) and tied for fifth in ERA (3.82).
