**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels split a doubleheader with the Senators. Richmond won Game 1, 3-2. Yohandy Morales hit an RBI single in the third inning to give Harrisburg a 1-0 lead. In the fourth, **Matt Higgins** scored on a passed ball to tie the score. Jairo Pomares gave the Flying Squirrels a 2-1 lead with a sac fly in the fifth. The Senators evened the score with a solo homer by Morales in the sixth inning. In the top of the seventh, **Carter Howell** scored on an error to put the Flying Squirrels ahead, 3-2. **Nick Sinacola** allowed one run over four innings. **Trent Harris** did not allow a run in his 1.2 innings. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels to the Senators back ahead, 2-1, with a sac fly in the fourth. The Flying Squirrels stranded seven runners on base over the final three innings, including leaving the bases loaded in the fifth and two runners in scoring position in the seventh.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of six games in their first road series of 2025, facing the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Richmond needs a win to work a series split.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** went 64-74 last season, missing the postseason for the first time since 2021. For the year, Richmond hitters ranked fifth in the Eastern League in batting average (.238), fourth in hits (592), third in doubles (230), fourth in triples (26), 11th in homers (88) and 11th in stolen bases (123). Flying Squirrels pitchers ranked eighth in the league in ERA (4.22) and fourth in strikeouts (1,281). The 2024 Flying Squirrels used 64 different players, setting a new franchise record.

**THE SENATORS** The Senators dropped all three games of their season-opening series at Erie over the weekend. They were outscored, 20-4, in the three games. Last year, the Senators went 68-70 and finished in third place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division. They were 38-31 in the first half and finished a game behind Erie from clinching the division's first postseason spot. Harrisburg's roster includes four of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including RHP Jarlin Susana (No. 3), 3B Cayden Wallace (No. 9), OF Daylen Lile (No. 10) and INF Yohandy Morales (No. 22). Five Senators players are ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including Susana (No. 2), Lile (No. 9), Wallace (No. 10), Morales (No. 12) and RHP Marquis Grissom Jr. (No. 23).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Jack Choate** makes his second start of the season and the second of his career against the Senators. In his first start of 2025 last Sunday, he tied his career high with nine strikeouts, throwing 3.2 scoreless, two-hit innings against Akron at The Diamond. He last faced the Senators on August 17, 2024 at FNB Field and allowed three runs (two earned) over 4.2 innings on five hits and five walks. Last year, he spent most of the season with High-A Eugene, going 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in August and made eight starts for the Flying Squirrels, posting a 1-4 record with a 5.82 ERA to close the season. Choate finished 2024 ranked first among qualified, full-season Giants minor-league pitchers in BAA (.231) and WHIP (1.21) while ranking second in ERA (3.79). Choate was selected by the Giants in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Assumption University. He entered 2025 ranked by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. *For more on Choate, see page two.* 

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Seth Shuman makes his second start of the season and the sixth of his Double-A career. He pitched the Senators' home opener on Tuesday, surrendering one run over five innings in a loss. Shuman reached the Senators for his final four starts in 2024, going 1-2 with a 3.78 ERA. He split last season across four levels in the Washington system. Shuman was originally selected by the Oakland Athletics in the sixth round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Georgia Southern. He was traded to the Nationals along with pitcher Richard Guasch and catcher Drew Millas on July 30, 2021 for catcher Yan Gomes and infielder Josh Harrison. Shuman missed all of the 2023 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery that spring.

**HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell** was named the 2024 Flying Squirrels Player of the Year in his first Double-A season. He spent all of last year in Richmond. For the season, he led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7). He also led the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), on-base percentage (.347), slugging percentage (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), walks (47), extra-base hits (40), total bases (174), runs (64) and stolen bases (15). Through his first eight games of 2025, Howell has reached base 15 times.

**PLAY THE HITS:** The Flying Squirrels have collected 56 hits through their first eight games this season, which is the third-most in the Eastern League. The team is batting .226 (56-for-248), which is fourth-highest in the league. However, the Richmond offense is batting .149 (10-for-67) with runners in scoring position, which is second-lowest in the league, trailing only Harrisburg.

**PINCH MEI:** In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, **Jairo Pomares** hit a single while pinch-hitting in the top of the seventh inning. It was the Flying Squirrels' first pinch hit since 2023. During the 2024 season, Richmond pinch-hitters went 0-for-36 on the year with three walks and 18 strikeouts. The 36 pinch-hit at-bats ranked third in the minors on the season, trailing only Buffalo (10-for-40) and Las Vegas (13-for-38). No MiLB team in the digitized-stats era, which dates back to 2005, has more pinch-hit at-bats without a hit than last year's Richmond team.

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's season-opening Flying Squirrels roster includes 22 players who have previously played for the Flying Squirrels. There are six players who have made their team debuts, including **Aeverson Arteaga**, **Sabin Ceballos**, **Manuel Mercedes**, **Rodolfo Nolasco**, **Braxton Roxby** and **Joe Whitman**. Roxby, acquired from the Reds in a trade earlier this year, is the only newcomer with previous Double-A experience.

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster, including the United States (20 players), Venezuela (3), the Dominican Republic (2), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 20 American-born players, 11 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (2), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Kentucky (1), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1) and Texas (1). There are 11 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, six were signed as non-drafted free agents, six as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades and one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft. For 23 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and five have played with other major-league organizations.

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: Last season, 14 former Flying Squirrels players reached the majors for the first time. That was the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors last season were Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023), Grant McCray (2024), Sandro Fabian (2021) and Trevor McDonald (2024). Christian Koss (2024) made his debut for the Giants earlier this week as the first new former Flying Squirrel in the majors this year. Dating back to 2022, 23-of-the-last-26 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Grabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. The 2023 season saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Jairo Pomares is tied for second in homers (2), tied for fifth in total bases (15), tied for sixth in hits (8) and 10th in SLG (.556). Carter Howell is tied for second in walks (8) and ninth in OBP (.444). Sabin Ceballos is tied for sixth in hits (8). Victor Bericoto is tied for fifth in walks (7). Nick Garcia is tied for first in games pitched (4).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes six players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also six players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

### THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

**1958:** The Richmond Virginians beat the Boston Red Sox, 5-1, at Parker Field, capping a sweep of a two-game exhibition series. The only Red Sox run of the game scored on a pinch-hit, solo homer by Ted Williams in the eighth inning. He had also hit a pinch-hit, eighth-inning homer the previous day. Deron Johnson hit a three-run homer off Bob Porterfield in the bottom of the eighth. Jim Coates started on the mound for the Virginians and threw five scoreless innings, striking out five. **1986:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 7-6, at The Diamond. Trailing 6-2 in the eighth, Gerald Perry hit an RBI single to close within three. John Rabb and Lee Graham brought home two runs to start the bottom of the ninth and pull Richmond within a run. Later in the inning, Albert Hall hit a walk-off, two-run homer to end the game. It was just his 15th homer in his 10 professional seasons at the time. **2018:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 3-1, in their home opener at The Diamond. The sellout crowd of 9,845 set a new record as the largest in franchise history. Jordan Johnson started and threw six scoreless innings. He also hit a solo homer in the fifth. **2022:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat Reading Fightin Phils, 3-1, in their home opener at The Diamond. The belawed the Altoona Curve, 10-6, at The Diamond. Richmond scored eight runs in the fourth inning fueled by a single-inning franchise-record four homers by Sean Roby, Jacob Heyward, Shane Matheny and Brandon Matroano. Roby also homered in the second, one of a then-team-record five in the game.
