TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes ended their five-game losing streak last night with a 10-9 walk-off win, third of the year ... Today's contest is the final game between Oklahoma City and Albuquerque in the Duke City in 2024 ... Karl Kauffmann is expected to take the hill for the Isotopes while Oklahoma City will have a bullpen game

ATTENDANCE: The Isotopes have tallied the highest total attendance in all of MiLB with 209, 135 fans over 32 openings.

NOW WALK IT OFF: Three of Albuquerque's eight victories at home have come via the walk-off (also: Jordan Beck double, April 14 vs. Sugar Land; Jameson Hannah single, May 2 vs. Round Rock). In each, the Isotopes have allowed the tying or go-ahead runs to score in the top of the ninth inning, before rallying in the bottom half.

COMEBACK: Last night the Isotopes overcame their largest deficit (four runs) to win a contest since July 30, 2023, when they trailed Sacramento by eight before rallying for a 17-16 victory.

DOUBLE-DINGERS: Michael Toglia's two-homer game last night was the fourth by an Isotope this year (also: Hunter Goodman, April 17 at El Paso; Toglia, May 8 at El Paso and Sean Bouchard, May 22 at Salt Lake).

ENDING ON AN ERROR: Last night night was the ninth time the Isotopes have recorded a walk-off victory that ended on an error, first since Aug. 8, 2019 vs. San Antonio ... Second vs. Oklahoma City (also: May 24, 2017, pitcher Brandon Morrow throwing error, allowing the tying and winning runs to score with two outs.

ONE RUN GAME: Albuquerque improved to 5-10 in contests decided by one run (4-5 at home), earning their first victory since a 10-9 triumph over Round Rock on May 2. The club had dropped their last four one-run games.

BIG INNING: The Isotopes equaled a season-high with seven runs in the fifth last night (also: April 20 at El Paso, T1).

TEAM DINGERS: Last night was the fifth time in 2024 the Isotopes homered at least four times in a contest (last: May 19 vs. Sugar Land, four). Additionally, Albuquerque belted three clouts in an inning for the first time since May 27, 2023 vs. Round Rock (Yonathan Daza, Coco Montes, Brian Serven).

AGAINST OKC: Albuquerque is 4-13 against Oklahoma City on the year. The 13 losses are the most in a season against the Oklahoma City franchise (previous high: 12, 2022) with seven games to go in the 2024.

BIG MIKE: Michael Toglia connected on his second multi-homer game this season (also: May 8 at El Paso, homered from both sides of the plate) and fourth in an Isotopes uniform, since 2022. Toglia is the 17th Isotope to record four-plus multi-homer games ... Has a hit in 12 of his last 13 games, slashing .308/.390/.615 with two doubles, one triple, four homers, 10 RBI and six walks.

HE'S BACK: Greg Jones stole two bases in his first game off the Injured List last night, his fifth contest with multiple swipes this season (last: April 21 at El Paso before being sidelined).

WAY BACK: Jones' blast in the fifth last night traveled 467 feet, the longest by any Albuquerque hitter in 2024 (previous: Hunter Goodman, April 20 at El Paso, 464). It was the ninth-longest home run for a Triple-A player this season.

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo finished 3-for-5, his 17th multi-hit performance of the season and first since May 18 vs. Sugar Land ... Seventh game with three-plus knocks in a contest.

COOLIN' OFF?: From April 21-May 18, Romo slashed .450/.459/.725 with eight doubles, four homers, 20 RBI ... Last 10 games, hitting .220 (9x41) with a double, triple, three homers.

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes mashed his team-leading 23rd multi-hit game of the year last night, his second in last 10 games.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk went hitless last night for the fourth time in his last seven games ... He draw a walk for the first time since May 21 at Salt Lake.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard is 3-for-25 in last six games (four hitless).

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall was 2-for-4, recording his fifth multi-hit outing with Albuquerque in 2024. He snapped a 3-for-24 drought (dating back to May 22) with tonight's showing.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 2nd in average (.343), 6th in slugging (.558), 9th in hits (59) and 10th in OPS (.919) ... Aaron Schunk is T-3rd in doubles (17) ... Coco Montes is 3rd in average (.342) and hits (66), 5th in OBP (.423), 6th in OPS (.967), 8th in total bases (105) and slugging (.544) ... Sam Hilliard is 2nd in runs (44), 4th in total bases (112) and walks (33), 5th in XBH (26), T-6th in homers (11), 7th in slugging (.549), T-7th in hits (61), 8th in OPS (.941), T-9th in triples (3) ... Julio Carreras is 5th in stolen bases (16).

TEAM STATS: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 1st in total bases (964), triples (27), hits (564) and slugging (.484), 2nd in average (.283), OPS (.848) and doubles (124), 5th in runs (338).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.

- Appeared in 48 games (34 starts) for the Wolverines from 2017-19, compiling a 19-10 record and 2.99 ERA
- His 12 wins in 2019 tied him for the program record in a single season with Rich Stoll (1982-83) and Tommy Henry (2019)
- Came within one out of a nine-inning complete game shutout on May 31, 2019 against Creighton in an NCAA Tournament game

Spun 7.0 innings and permitted just three runs on three hits, a homer and three walks while fanning four ...
