#### STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

NEW FRIENDS, FAMILIAR FACES HELP 'CAPS RALLY, 7-5: The West Michigan Whitecaps enjoyed a big night from one of their newest players and another from a familiar returnee as part of a 7-5, come-from-behind win over the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond on Wednesday night. The night began with the first of four hits for outfielder Cole Turney – the first four-hit performance for West Michigan this year – with a solo home run en route to finishing just a triple shy of hitting for the cycle. While Turney enjoys his first season with the Whitecaps; Austin Murr, who joined the 'Caps in 2021, collected a single, double, and pair of walks in his 2024 West Michigan debut. The Whitecaps built a 4-1 lead with consistent offense throughout their first seven innings at the plate. Turney's big night began with a bang as the outfielder blasted his first Whitecaps homer on an opposite-field shot to take a 1-0 lead. Later in the frame, Murr ripped a run-scoring double to extend the lead to 2-0. Kyle Nevin's solo homer in the fourth sliced the 'Caps advantage to 2-1, but Izaac Pacheco's double plated Turney to bring West Michigan's lead to 3-1. In the seventh, Turney's two-out single scored a run to increase the 'Caps' edge to 4-1, but the Loons rallied with four to take the lead in the bottom of the frame. A run-scoring single by Luis Rodriguez preceded a game-tying two-run double from Sam Mongelli to even the score before he crossed the plate on a fielder's choice later in the frame to give the Loons a 5-4 lead. In the eighth, Seth Stephenson tied the game at five with a two-out single, and in the ninth, a bases-loaded walk to Danny Serretti with an Austin Murr sacrifice fly put West Michigan back in front, 7-5, to conclude the scoring. 'Caps reliever Cleiverth Perez (1-0) also made his Whitecaps debut, tossing 1.2 scoreless frames in picking up his first win with the team, while Livan Reinoso (0-1) allowed a pair of unearned runs in suffering his first Great Lakes loss of the year. Righty Matt Merrill tossed a perfect ninth inning to record his first save the club. The Whitecaps record jumps to 5-6, while the Loons fall to 6-5. Turney and Murr each reached base four times in a pair of outstanding performances to lead the 'Caps to victory.

**GETTING BLANKED:** The Whitecaps pitching staff collected a Midwest League-best 15 shutouts of their opponents this season, with the last one occuring on August 20 in a 5-0 win over the South Bend Cubs at LMCU Ballpark. The 'Caps also hold the Midwest League record for shutouts in a season with 27 back in 2017. They also began the 2024 season with a 2-0 blanking of the Lake County Captains at Classic Park in the first game of a doubleheader on April 7.

SWING FOR THE FENCES: The Whitecaps totaled 109 home runs last season - breaking the franchise record of 101 set in 2022.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold five of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects, and are mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

#### More from Baseball America:

At Middle Tennessee State, Hamm showed solid stuff but only fringy strikes. After turning pro, he's also turning heads. The righthander was the buzz of the Lakeland backfields, leaving scouts overwhelmed by what they saw. So, what did they see? For starters, Hamm works with a 93-96 mph fastball with well over 20 inches of induced vertical break and a downer curveball that grades as another potentially plus weapon. His changeup flashed plus as well, and he had a slider that rounded out his arsenal but stands as a clear fourth pitch in his mix. The Tigers already have one of the best pitching prospects in the sport in Jackson Jobe, and now they might have the fastest rising arm as well.

Born: September 5, 2002 Resides: Columbia, TN

Acquired: Drafted by the Tigers in the 5th of the 2023 MLB Draft out

of Middle Tennessee State.

Hamm dominated in a small sample size during the 2023 season, but it was enough to put him on the radar heading into 2024. The 21-year-old's a popular sleeper breakout pick among Tigers Minor Leaguers in advance of the season. Despite having thrown only 12 innings of pro ball, Hamm began the 2024 season in High-A.

LAST TIME OUT: Hamm continued the hot start to his professional career, posting seven strikeouts through four innings while allowing just one run, but the offense couldn't pick him up, falling to the Quad Cities River Bandits 2-1 on April 13th in game-one of a doubleheader at LMCU Ballpark on April 13.

2023: Hamm started the season in college and struggled (especially in the second half), posting a 5.31 ERA in 17 games. Despite the college struggles, Hamm shined in limited pro ball work, totaling 12 scoreless innings and giving up just one unearned run on three hits while walking only one and striking out 12.

**2022:** Hamm put himself on the draft radar with a solid junior season at Middle Tennessee State, posting a 3.34 ERA in 16 games (5 starts). In 59.1 innings, the righty with the big curveball struck out 65 batters and allowed just 46 hits in that timespan.

#### 2023 First-Team Conference USA

Named to Geoff Pontes (Baseball America) 2024 All-Breakout Tm:

From BA: Hamm was one of the names with the most helium during minor league spring training. The Tigers' fifth-round pick in 2023 from Middle Tennessee State, Hamm dominated on the backfields. He struck out nine of 10 batters in one notable performance. Hamm mixes four pitches in a cut-ride fastball at 92-94 mph that averages around 20 inches of induced vertical break, a changeup at 83-86 with tumble and fade, a low-80s curveball with depth and a newly developed baby sweeper. It's an interesting pitch mix and Hamm shows the ability to command his arsenal. He debuted last season following the draft and didn't allow an earned run over 12 innings of work.

From MLB Pipeline: Hard-throwing Eriq Swan was the main attraction at Middle Tennessee State's scout day last fall, but evaluators also stumbled upon Hamm, who touched 97 mph and showed a big-breaking curveball. A hot start to the season that included a one-hit shutout with 11 strikeouts against Evansville built up momentum that could have carried him into the top three rounds, but he struggled in the second half. He surpassed big leaguer Zac Curtis (sixth round, 2014) as the third-highest drafted pitcher in school history, behind only Dewon Brazelton (No. 3 overall, 2001), and Swan, who was taken just 6 picks before Hamm in 2023.

Hamm's best pitch is a 78-82 mph curveball with good depth, though there are days when he struggles to land it for strikes. His fastball sat at 91-93 mph and peaked at 96 this spring, showing good carry at times but getting hammered when he worked lower in the zone. His low-80s changeup lacks consistency as well.

Hamm's control and command fluctuated throughout his junior season, and he struggles to locate his pitches when he gets under the ball in his delivery. Though he's mostly a finished product, he looks like a three-pitch starter with a solid fastball and a plus curveball when he's on. His curve and competitiveness could make him a useful bullpen piece if he can't stick in the rotation.
