#24 José Tena #26 Bryan Lavastida SUNDAY: The Captains snapped a four-game losing streak with a 7-6 win over the Great Lakes Loons at Classic Park. A two-run home run by Brayan Rocchio in the seventh proved to be the difference. At the time, Rocchio's homer gave the Captains a 7-3 lead, but Great Lakes' Zac Ching hit a three-run homer with two outs in the ninth. Ching's blast pulled the Loons within one run and made Rocchio's long ball the critical blow in the game. Captains outfielder Micah Pries hit a solo homer in the third for his first High-A hit. Lake County starter Mason Hickman struck out seven and held the Loons to three runs over six innings to earn the win.

LAST SERIES: The Captains lost four of six games against the Great Lakes Loons at Classic Park. The Loons outscored the Captains, 49-20 (-29 run differential). Lake County won on Tuesday, 7-5, and on Sunday, 7-6. Great Lakes won the four middle games, 5-0, 8-5, 14-0 (no-hitter) and 11-1.

COORS FIELD EAST: The Captains and Loons combined for 28 home runs last week. Great Lakes hit 20, while the Captains hit eight. Great Lakes' Brandon Lewis (4 HR), Ryan Ward (4 HR) and Carson Taylor (3 HR) did the most damage. Brayan Rocchio and George Valera each homered twice for the Captains.

YOU GET NOTHING: Great Lakes pitched a no-hitter on Friday for the first no-no in Loons history (14th season). Clayton Beeter (2 IP), Bobby Miller (5 IP), Jake Cantleberry (1 IP) and Cameron Gibbens (1 IP) combined to no-hit the Captains with three walks and 13 strikeouts. The Loons won, 14-0. It was the first time the Captains were no-hit since July 8, 2011 against the Bowling Green Hot Rods.

VALERA GOES DEEP: George Valera has hit six home runs in his last 13 games.

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .308/.413/.635 (1.047 OPS) in the month of July. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games. Nova, however, is currently in the midst of a home run drought. After hitting four homers in the first six games of July, Nova has not homered since July 10 at Fort Wayne.

LEADERBOARD: Captains OF Will Brennan and INF José Tena are neck-and-neck on the High-A Central League leaderboards. Brennan and Tena are tied for seventh in batting average (.290). Brennan is second in the league in doubles (22) and Tena is tied for sixth (16).

TAKE YOUR BASE: George Valera ranks sixth in the High-A Central League (minimum 150 PA) with a 16.4 BB%.

CONTACT HITTERS: Bryan Lavastida has the eighth-lowest K% (15.1) and Will Brennan has the eight-lowest SwStr% in the High-A Central League (minimum 150 PA).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 20-10 at home, compared to 18-24 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.79 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.83 ERA on the road.

HOT LAVA: Bryan Lavastida saw his 22-game on-base streak end on Saturday night. From June 24 to July 24, Lavastida hit .395/.479/.684 (1.163 OPS) with four homers and 10 doubles. Lavastida had eight multi-hit games during that span, including four three-hit performances.

LAST TIME OUT: Coulter surrendered just two runs, on a pair of solo home runs, across four innings last Tuesday against Great Lakes. Brandon Lewis hit a solo homer with one out in the second and Ryan Ward led off the fourth with a home run. Coulter only allowed four other baserunners on three singles and a walk. He induced two double plays and struck out five. Though Coulter did not last long enough to qualify for the win, Lake County beat the Loons, 7-5.

2019: Across 18 appearances Coulter compiled 36.1 innings out of the bullpen in the Arizona league and finished the season with a 2.23 ERA. After allowing at least one earned run in his first four appearances Coulter found his rhythm in July, only giving up one earned run eight appearances and 14.1 innings in the month. He began to stretch his arm out in August finishing the season with three straight appearances in which he threw three or more innings.

BEAR DOWN: Coulter had an up and down career at Mercer where he finished with a career 4.74 ERA. He bounced back and forth between a starting role and the bullpen where he accumulated five saves across his four-year career, including three as a senior in the first three games of the Bears season. His best season came as a senior. After starting the year in the bullpen he was moved to the rotation where he made 11 consecutive starts before bouncing back to the 'pen to finish the season. He completed the 2019 season with a career best 3.90 ERA.

THREE SPORT STAR: While at Buford High School Coulter starred as a basketball player and runner on the cross country team as well as the diamond. In 2015 he led the Wolves to a state championship his senior season.
