SUNDAY: Mason Hickman hurled a career high 6.1 innings on the mound, allowing just one run on six hits against Lansing. Lake County took the lead in the top of the fourth inning. Bryan Lavastida led off with a walk, then went to third on a José Tena double. With two outs, a pitch bounced away from Lugnuts' catcher Drew Millas a few feet in front of home plate. Lavastida raced home and just beat the tag to put the Captains on top 1-0. In the sixth inning Lavastida scored again on a **Joe Naranjo** groundout before Lansing added a run on a Jordan Diaz RBI-double in the bottom half of the inning. Lavastida impacted the game in the seventh with an RBI-double that plated Victor Nova and Will Brennan. With the Captains up 4-1, Nathan Ocker allowed one run in the eighth but Jerson Ramirez tossed a scoreless ninth to seal the 4-2 win.

VALERA GOES DEEP: George Valera has hit four home runs in his last eight games. He has gone deep in every other game he has played since last Friday.

OUCH: The Captains got hit by 12 pitches in the series against Lansing, including a High-A Central League/Midwest League record seven on Wednesday. Brayan Rocchio has been hit by three pitches and Joe Donovan was hit three times in Wednesday's game alone.

ROCCHIO ON A ROLL: Brayan Rocchio snapped an 11-game on-base streak on Sunday, during which he hit 340 (17-for-50) with one home run, two doubles and he has been hit by four pitches. Rocchio had five multi-hit games during the streak, including a four-hit game on July 13 at Lansing. In the month of July, Rocchio is hitting .300/.391/.383 (.775 OPS).

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .389/.489/.861 (1.350 OPS) in July with four home runs in 11 games. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games.

LEADERBOARD: Captains OF Will Brennan and INF José Tena are neck-and-neck on the High-A Central League leaderboards. Brennan is seventh in the league in batting average (.290) and tied for second in doubles (20). Tena is fourth in batting average (.294) and tied for fourth in doubles (16).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 18-6 at home, compared to 18-24 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.01 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.83 ERA on the road.

HOT LAVA: Bryan Lavastida is riding a 19-game on-base streak. Over the last 19 games (since June 24). Lavastida is hitting .426/.488/.750 (1.238 OPS) with four homers and 10 doubles. Lavastida has eight multi-hit games during that span, including four three-hit performances.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year - OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Coulter came out of the bullpen for the first time since June 18th against Lansing on Thursday. He entered the game in relief of Daniel Espino who was making his Captains debut. Coulter began his outing by allowing three consecutive hits, all with two strikes, and two runs came across before he recorded an out. From their Coulter settled in, retiring eight Lugnuts in a row before giving up back to back hits and leaving the game with two runners on base in the eighth inning. The Captains offense was stifled on the evening, collecting just five hits and getting shut out in the 4-0 loss.

**2019:** Across 18 appearances Coulter compiled 36.1 innings out of the bullpen in the Arizona league and finished the season with a 2.23 ERA. After allowing at least one earned run in his first four appearances Coulter found his rhythm in July, only giving up one earned run eight appearances and 14.1 innings in the month. He began to stretch his arm out in August finishing the season with three straight appearances in which he threw three or more innings.

**BEAR DOWN:** Coulter had an up and down career at Mercer where he finished with a career 4.74 ERA. He bounced back and forth between a starting role and the bullpen where he accumulated five saves across his four-year career, including three as a senior in the first three games of the Bears season. His best season came as a senior. After starting the year in the bullpen he was moved to the rotation where he made 11 consecutive starts before bouncing back to the 'pen to finish the season. He completed the 2019 season with a career best 3.90 ERA.

**THREE SPORT STAR:** While at Buford High School Coulter starred as a basketball player and runner on the cross country team as well as the diamond. In 2015 he led the Wolves to a state championship his senior season.
