Lansing is currently 4-3 during a 12-game homestand against West Michigan and Dayton, winning four in a row before losing three in a row.

Last Game: Dragons 5, Lugnuts 4. Jose Torres led off with a home run, Alex McGarry hit a two-run homer three batters later, and Dayton held off Lansing to prevail in the series opener. Dragons starter Joe Boyle tossed 4 2/3 hitless innings, walking six and striking out seven, though his scoreless streak to begin the year ended at 21 2/3 innings after reliever Evan Kravetz allowed an inherited runner to score.

Red Hot: C Jared McDonald delivered an RBI double and a solo home run yesterday, giving him 13 hits in his last 28 at-bats (.464). In the process, McDonald has raised his slash line from .111/.158/.111 to .326/.360/.457. He comes into today riding an eight-game hitting streak, as does Euribiel Ángeles. OF Lawrence Butler enters with an 11-game on-base streak (12-40, .300, 5 walks), one away from tying Brett Harris's team-high streak.

Transaction: P Grant Holman was placed on the Injured List yesterday, becoming the seventh Lugnut on the IL (and the fourth starting pitcher).

Happy Birthday: Today is Euribiel Ángeles's 20th birthday! The young infielder was acquired with Adrián Martínez in exchange for Sean Manaea and Aaron Holiday from San Diego on April 2nd.

Among the MWL Leaders: OF Lawrence Butler is fourth in the Midwest League with 19 walks, INF Euribiel Ángeles is fourth with 33 hits, relievers Angello Infante and Kumar Nambiar are tied for second with ten appearances, and Infante is tied for first with five saves

- Triple-A Las Vegas: P Norge Ruiz made four appearances with the Lugnuts last year (5 2/3, 7 R) before going down due to injury. This year, he's struck out 10 while allowing one run in 9 1/3 innings as the Aviators' best reliever (0.96 ERA). He tossed a hitless inning yesterday with two K's.
- Double-A Midland: P David Leal, the first Lugnut to be promoted this season, debuted for the RockHounds with 5 1/3 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 2 BB, 0 K in a 9-4 win over Corpus Christi. Max Schuemann went 3-for-4 with a walk and is now hitting .406 with an absurd .504 OBP in 25 games.
- Single-A Stockton: P James Gonzalez, just transferred from the Nuts to the Ports vesterday, debuted with 3 1/3 hitless innings, striking out six,

165 Major League Nuts...: Infielder Vinny Capra (2018 in Lansing) debuted for the Blue Jays on May 1, becoming the 165th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fourth this year, joining A's relievers Zach Logue and Zach Jackson and Oakland infielder Christian Lopes. Speaking of Logue, he starts tonight for Oakland at the Detroit Tigers.

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in Tyler Soderstrom, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of seven Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager Brayan Buelvas (No. 9) and Euribiel Ángeles (No. 10), starting pitcher Joey Estes (No. 15), first baseman/outfielder Lawrence Butler (No. 17), pitcher Jeff Criswell (No. 18) and pitcher Grant Holman (No. 30).

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bull-pen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

Draft Day: Selected 157th overall in the 5th round, 2020 from the University of Washington (the "Huskies")... scout: Jim Coffman, who also signed Lugnuts catcher Jared McDonald (Western Oregon) and current Oakland A's outfielder Seth Brown... signed for \$400,000... drafted three picks before the end of the draft... one of three of Oakland's five 2020 draft picks on the Lugnuts (1st round - Tyler Soderstrom; 2nd round - Jeff Criswell).

Personal: Born in Seattle... played three years in Little League for, coincidentally, the A's, and still has his old A's baseball cap... younger brother, Josh, is currently a pitcher at Washington, standing 6'3... uncle, Jake, also played baseball for Washington.

Hometown: Bellevue is the third largest city in the Seattle metropolitan area... "belle vue" in French means "beautiful view"; it's situated across Lake Washington from Seattle... Amazon was founded in Bellevue in Jeff Bezos's garage on July 5, 1994... many companies are headquartered in Bellevue, notably T-Mobile USA, the North American headquarters for Pokémon, QFC, Expedia Group, Coinstar and Eddie Bauer... Russell Wilson and Ciara are currently seeking to sell their house in Bellevue (with amazing tree hosue) for \$36 million.

Glory Days: Attended Interlake High School... rated by Baseball Northwest as Washington's No. 1 baseball recruit in the Class of 2017... rated by Perfect Game as Washington's No. 4 right-handed pitcher... Interlake's alumni includes John Olerud, Larry Andersen, Jim Mora Jr., and actor Timothy Omundson.

Life as a Huskie: Ascended from setup man to closer to ace starting pitcher from freshman to junior year at Washington... broke the Washington freshman record with 34 relief appearances, tied for second most in school history for a single season; led all freshmen in the Pac-12 in appearances... also led Washington as a freshman in wins (8-2, 4.37, 45 1/3 IP, 2 HR, 28 BB, 32 K)... followed up a sophomore in 2019 with 31 appearances (2.35 ERA, 6 saves, 53 2/3, 3 HR, 22 BB, 65 K)... made four starts as a junior, including 13-K, 6-IP gem vs. Fresno State, before season was shut down (0.79, 22 2/3 IP, 2 ER, 0 HR, 9 BB, Pac-12 leading 38 K)... 15.1 K/9.0-IP ranked 16th in the country... named a 2020 3rd Team All-American by The Collectiate Baseball.

2021 Professional Debut: Opened season as the Lugnuts' Sunday starter... excelled in pro debut, May 9 vs. Lake County: 4 1/3 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 5 K... followed up five two-hit scoreless innings at Dayton, May 16... season curtailed due to injury, however, after four starts in May and three appearances in June... set Lugnuts franchise single-game record in last appearance, June 20 vs. Great Lakes, allowing four home runs: two apiece by Andy Pages and Deacon Liput in back-to-back innings... made one scoreless appearance in Arizona Complex League before season's end.
