TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Salt Lake Bees face off for the second time at Smith's Ballpark on Friday night. Express RHP Sam Gaviglio is scheduled to start against Los Angeles RHP Chris Rodriguez, who is making his first MLB rehab appearance. First pitch is set for 7:35 p.m. CT.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

Round Rock got the win in Thursday night's series opener in Salt Lake with a 4-2 final. 3B Charles Leblanc tallied a season-high three RBI, driving in three of the four Express runs in the contest. The Express put the first run on the board in the second inning when 1B Andy Ibanez hit a double before scoring on a single from Leblanc. Round Rock increased its lead to 3-0 with two runs in the fourth, starting with a leadoff home run from DH Yohei Pozo. Ibanez scored his second run, hitting a single, advancing to second on a hit from RF Eli White and finishing his trip around the bases thanks to a double from Leblanc. The Bees scored both of their runs in the fifth. Consecutive doubles from CF Brandon Marsh and SS Luis Rengifo scored a run, then a Matt Thaiss single brought Rengifo in for Salt Lake, trimming the Round Rock lead to 3-2. The E-Train added an insurance run in the eighth when Leblanc tallied his third hit of the night, scoring 1B Curtis Terry, who had reached on a Salt Lake error and settled at second on a White single.

SAM GETS THE START

Express RHP Sam Gaviglio is scheduled to get the start tonight against the Bees. In his last start, the righty allowed seven runs on 11 hits in 4.0 innings of action on May 22 at Tacoma. He struck out three and walked one in the contest. Gaviglio holds a 1-1 record on the year with a 7.04 ERA (12 ER/15.1 IP).

TOP OF THE LIST

After striking out a season-high nine batters to earn the win in Thursday night's contest against Salt Lake, RHP Drew Anderson finds himself tied atop the Triple-A West League in total strikeouts. His 24 K's is currently tied with former Round Rock and current Sugar Land LHP Ryan Hartman. Anderson has thrown 16.1 innings in four appearances, including three starts, so far this season, allowing only four runs on 13 hits.

POZO'S PRESENCE

E-Train C Yohei Pozo blasted his third home run of the season in Salt Lake on Thursday night, upping his season RBI total to 11. The catcher holds a .325 batting average (13-40) in his first season playing Triple-A ball, a mark that ranks fifth among all Express hitters. Pozo came to Triple-A for the 2021 season after spending 2019 at High-A Down East.

BATTLIN' BARLOW

Express RHP Joe Barlow currently ranks second in the Triple-A West League after earning his fourth save of the season on Thursday versus the Bees. He worked around two Salt Lake baserunners in the ninth inning to secure the 4-2 final, which snapped Round Rock's five-game losing streak.

PATTON STILL SCORELESS

Throughout his 7.0 innings of action this season, RHP Spencer Patton has yet to allow a run. He has appeared in seven games, giving up only four hits while walking five and striking out six. Patton is the only member of the Express pitching staff to hold a 0.00 ERA and has earned two wins and a save during the beginning of the 2021 campaign.

OH, CANADA!

Round Rock INF Charles Leblanc posted a night to remember on Thursday, finishing 3-4 with three RBI, setting new season highs in both hits and RBI. The Quebec native is hitting a red-hot .370 (17-46) on the year, a mark that ranks fourth in the Triple-A West League among all hitters with at least 50 plate appearances. Leblanc has reached base in 12 of his 13 games in 2021, including hits in 10 contests.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twelve members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021, RHP Jason Bahr, OF Carl Chester, RHP Demarcus Evans, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, RHP Ryder Ryan, INF Anderson Tejada, INF Curtis Terry, OF Leody Taveras and RHP Collin Wiles. C Blake Grant-Parks is also seeking his Triple-A debut with the Express. Interestingly enough, Evans, Tejada and Taveras all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels in 2021 before making his Triple-A debut with Round Rock in May.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 14 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Nevada, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, South Carolina, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 21 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Andy Ibañez was born in Cuba, INF Anderson Tejada and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
