YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the RubberDucks, 9-4. Kody Huff gave the RubberDucks a 1-0 lead with a sac fly in the bottom of the first inning. In the top of the second, **Grant McCray** hit a grand slam in the second to give the Flying Squirrels a 4-1 lead. In the bottom of the fourth, Milan Tolentino hit an RBI triple and later scored on a single by Micael Ramirez. Petey Halpin tied the game with a two-run single with two outs. In the bottom of the fifth, Tolentino hit an RBI single to give Akron a 5-4 lead and Ramirez brought in two runs with a single to extend the lead to 7-4. In the eighth, Joe Naranjo and Dayan Frias hit RBI singles to push Akron's lead to 9-4. **Andy Thomas** reached base three times, going 2-for-3 with a walk. **Victor Bericoto** had two hits. The RubberDucks struck out 17 Flying Squirrels batters in the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the finale of a six-game series at Canal Park. The two teams split a series at The Diamond from April 9-14. Along with this series, the Flying Squirrels return to Akron for three games from July 19-21 following the All-Star Break. The RubberDucks return to Richmond from Sept. 3-8 for six games. Akron has already clinched a series win, taking four-of-five this week.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a four-game win streak with their win on Friday night. It was their second shutout of the year and the second straight start by **John Michael Bertrand** to end in a shutout. Last week, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox. The Flying Squirrels have gone 7-6 in their last 13 games since April 20, including winning four straight from April 20-24, but they are 1-5 since last Sunday.

THE RUBBERDUCKS had won 10 consecutive games, the longest win streak by an Eastern League team this year, prior to falling to the Flying Squirrels on Friday night. It was the longest win streak for Akron since winning 11 in a row in August 2016 en route to winning the Eastern League championship. Last week, they picked up their first six-game sweep in franchise history, taking the entire series at Altoona. For the season, Akron's pitching staff leads the Eastern League in ERA (2.44), shutouts (5) and WHIP (1.18). Akron's roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including OF Chase DeLauter (No. 1), OF Petey Halpin (No. 14), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 18), 3B Dayan Frias (No. 19) and SS Kahlil Watson (No. 22). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects is includes five Akron players, including DeLauters (No. 1), Watson (No. 14), Halpin (No. 15), Walters (No. 25) and Frias (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his sixth start of 2024 and the seventh of his career against the Rubber-Ducks. In the first game of the series on Tuesday, Murphy was charged with a loss after allowing three runs over five innings. In his six previous career starts against the RubberDucks, Murphy is 1-2 with a 2.42 ERA (7 ER/26.0 IP). Murphy spent all of last season with the Flying Squirrels, going 2-9 with a 4.36 ERA in 29 outings. His 27 starts were tied for the most in the Eastern League. Murphy struck out 107 batters last year, sixth-most in the Giants organization. He had a 5.21 ERA (28 ER/48.1 IP) in his first 14 outings through June 22, but over his next 14 outings from June 28-September 10, he posted a 2.77 ERA (17 ER/55.1 IP) with 61 strikeouts. Murphy made his Double-A debut in June of 2022, one of two starts with Richmond that year before he was shut down with an injury. In his first professional season in 2021, he pitched for Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene and struck out 164 batters, which was the third-most in the minors for the year. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College in New York, which was then an NCAA DII program. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect. *For more on Murphy, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Doug Nikhazy makes his third start of the year and his second against the RubberDucks. He last pitched on April 11 at The Diamond and pitched five scoreless innings, allowing one hit with eight strikeouts. After that start, he was placed on the 7-day injured list with a left oblique strain. In his only other start this season, he was the Opening Day starter for the RubberDucks on April 5 against the Curve and pitched five hitless, scoreless innings with five strikeouts. Today's outing is his 32nd with Akron and his 28th start at Double-A. He first joined the RubberDucks in 2022 for three starts to close the year. Nikhazy spent the entire 2023 season with Akron and went 4-8 with a 4.94 ERA in 26 games (22 starts). In his career, he has made four starts against the Flying Squirrels, going 2-0 with a 2.37 ERA (5 ER/19.0 IP). Nikhazy was selected by Cleveland in the second round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the Ole Miss.

AWESOME APRIL: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,926) and Worcester (7,418).

RISPY BUSINESS: In their last nine games since April 25, the Flying Squirrels have hit .143 (8-for-56) with runners in scoring position, averaging 2.6 runs per game (23 total runs). In this week's series in Akron, Richmond is batting .111 (4-for-36) with runners in scoring position and averaging 2.6 runs per game (13 total runs). After being shut out on Tuesday, the Flying Squirrels scored their only two runs on Tuesday on a pair of solo homers. Their only runs on Saturday came on a second-inning grand slam by Grant McCray.

GRANT SLAM: In the last two games, **Grant McCray** has hit his third and fourth homers of the season, which leads the Flying Squirrels. His four homers are also tied for seventh-most in the Eastern League. On Friday, he hit a solo home run on the second pitch of the game. On Saturday, he hit a grand slam, the fourth of his professional career, in the second inning. In his last two games, McCray is batting .333 (3-for-9) with two homers and five RBIs.

BISHOP BASHING: In his five-game hit streak dating back to last Saturday, **Hunter Bishop** is batting .368 (7-for-19) with a homer, three doubles, four runs scored and one RBI. He has picked up two hits in each of his last two games at Akron. On Wednesday night, he hit a solo homer for his second Double-A home run. Bishop is playing his first Double-A season and his first season overall since 2022 after missing all of last year with an injury.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson saw his 11-game on-base streak end on Thursday night. That streak is tied for the longest by a Richmond batter this season. Over his last 13 games since April 17, Wilson is batting .333 (16-for-48) with a homer, three doubles, eight walks, six RBIs and five runs scored. Dating back to 2021, Wilson has played 159 games for the Flying Squirrels over parts of four seasons.

PITCH PERFECT: John Michael Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for April 22-28. On Saturday, he pitched seven perfect innings against the Baysox at The Diamond, retiring all 21 batters he faced in order on 68 pitches. He is the first player on Richmond's roster to win one of the Eastern League weekly awards this season.

STRONG ARMS: The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 249 strikeouts this season, third-most in the Eastern League, and is ranked fourth with a 3.33 ERA. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.61 ERA this year, which is fifth-best in the league. The Richmond bullpen has the third-lowest ERA (3.06) in the league, trailing only Akron (2.40) and Harrisburg (2.91).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are four relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 10 IP), four Richmond pitchers rank in the top 15 in ERA. **Tanner Kiest** is sixth with a 0.68 ERA (1 ER/13.1 IP), **Evan Gates** is fifth with a 0.73 ERA (1 ER/12.2 IP), **Wil Jensen** is 11th with a 1.06 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP), which is the lowest in the league for any pitcher who has worked at least 15.0 innings, and **Nick Garcia** is 14th with a 1.50 ERA (2 ER/12.0 IP).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, John Michael Bertrand is fourth in ERA (1.71), second in innings pitched (31.2) and eighth in WHIP (1.07). Carson Ragsdale is tied for fourth in strikeouts (32). Hayden Birdsong is tied for eighth in strikeouts (29). Nick Garcia is tied for fourth in games pitched (9).

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Reggie Crawford (No. 9), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Seven players landed on MLB. com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).
