### GONE FISHING

Over the first two games of the series, the Shuckers have outscored the Blue Wahoos 14-5, a +9 run differential.

- The Shuckers have gone 7-for-22 (.318) with a runner in scoring position during the series... The pitching staff has limited the Blue Wahoos to 1-for-18 (.056) with 7 strikeouts in the situation, tied for the 3rd-fewest hits in Double-A since Tuesday.
- Since the start of 2025, the Shuckers are 13-4 against the Blue Wahoos at Keesler Federal Park, the best record against any Southern League opponent over that span... The Shuckers have outscored the Blue Wahoos 85-47, a +38 run differential.

### HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

With a home run on Wednesday, the Shuckers tied the Double-A record with 10 home runs through their first 5 games... The Shuckers are the 9th team in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005) to reach the mark and the 3rd since 2018.

- The Shuckers 8 home runs during the Opening Series are tied for the 5th-most in a Double-A Opening Series since 2005.
- On Sunday, the Shuckers hit back-to-back-to-back home runs for the second time in franchise history, and first time since 2022... The home runs were hit by **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** (102 MPH, 400'), **1B BLAKE BURKE** (97 MPH, 379') and **OF DAMON KEITH** (106 MPH, 431').

### CALLING THE KIDS!

Baseball America released the list of the youngest players by level on Wednesday, including **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** and **RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ** as 2 of the 3 youngest players in the Southern League... Made is the only player under 20 y/o in the Southern League.

- 7 of the 25 youngest Southern League players are on the Shuckers roster, including Made and Rodriguez.
- The median age of the league is 25.0 y/o... 21 of the 26 players on the active roster are under 25 y/o.

### LEADING THE LEAGUE (AND THE LEVEL)

**1B BLAKE BURKE** enters today as the Southern League home run leader, with 4 across his first 5 games of the season... 4 of his 5 hits have been home runs, with all 5 hits driving in a run.

- On Tuesday, Burke became the 6th Double-A player in the Digital Stats Era to record 4 home runs in a team's first 4 games... Burke joined **OF JORGE BURGOS** (ARK) and **1B KEVIN CRON** (JXN) as the 3rd player to achieve the feat since 2012.
- With two home runs on Opening Day, Burke joined **INF JAIME PEDROZA** ('14 at MTG) and **1B PAUL GOLDSCHMIDT** ('11 at CAR) as the 3rd Southern League player to record an Opening Day multi-home run game in the Digital Stats Era.

### I'M JUST A KID AND I MAKE PITCHER'S LIVES A NIGHTMARE

**SS/2B JESÚS MADE** made Double-A history on Sunday, becoming the first player under 19 y/o in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005) to record 4 hits, a home run and stolen base in the same game... He joined **SS LEO DE VRIES** (9/6/25 at FRI) as the only other Double-A hitter under 19 y/o with 4+ hits and a home run in the same game.

- Over the last 3 games, Made is 6-for-10 with a home run, 4 walks and 5 balls in play at 100+ MPH.

### MR. CONSISTENCY

**2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE** (7-for-19) and **OF DAMON KEITH** (8-for-18) enter today as part of a group of 7 Southern League players that have recorded a hit in all 5 games to begin the season.

- It marks O'Rae's longest hit streak since he recorded a hit in 7 consecutive games between July 27 and August 3, 2024.

### MAKING A MARK

**LHP MARK MANFREDI SR.** struck out the side in the 9th inning on Tuesday, extending his strikeout streak to 7 consecutive batters dating back to Friday, April 3... Over his first 2 appearances, Manfredi has struck out 8 of the 9 batters faced.

### MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

**SS/2B JESÚS MADE** enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

- Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (18 AB), Kevin McGonigle (48 AB) and JJ Wetherholt (45 AB) all reach 130 AB.

### BACK IN THE SADDLE

**MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO** returns to the Shuckers dugout for 2026 after 2 seasons as a Roving Infield Instructor with the Brewers organization.

- After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 52 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,448 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

### PROSPECT-PALOOZA

The Shuckers have 4 Top 30 prospects on their roster, including 2 Top-100 prospects and 2 Top-10 prospects.

- The 4 are: **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** (No. 1, No. 3 overall), **RHP BISHOP LETSON** (No. 7, No. 96 overall), **RHP TYSON HARDIN** (No. 13) and **1B BLAKE BURKE** (No. 18).

### TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

**RHP RYAN BIRCHARD** (0-0, 3.00) makes his 1st career Double-A start and 2nd appearance of the season... In his Double-A debut on Opening Day, Birchard struck out 4 and held the Trash Pandas hitless through 3.0 innings.
