LAST OUTING: Gasser pitched his first complete game in his professional career in game two of a doubleheader on June 7 at Jacksonville. He gave up four runs (all earned) on two homers. The left-hander struck out seven on 96 pitches and 63 strikes in Nashville's 11-4 win.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Gasser's second start against Gwinnett. He went 5.0 innings in a no decision on May 13 in his only previous appearance.
