### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain on the road and continue a six-game series at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is the eighth-of-18 games between the teams this season and second-of-six at Mirabito Stadium. The Rumble Ponies took four-of-six games at Reading from Apr. 15-20 and return to FirstEnergy Stadium from July 22-27. Binghamton leads the season-series 5-2.

### Game 26 Recap

The Fightin Phils raced out to a 6-0 lead by the end of the fourth inning, thanks to a run in the first, three in the third and one in the fourth. Moises Chace kept the Rumble Ponies bat quiet over his 3.2 innings of work, without allowing a run. Two doubles and a homer from Keaton Anthony and two doubles from Robert Moore helped Reading in the early going. The Rumble Ponies began to mount a comeback with two runs off Andrew Baker in the bottom of the sixth inning. The game entered the eighth inning with Reading up 7-2, but Binghamton scored four runs thanks in large part to two costly R-Phils' errors. In the bottom of the ninth, it was 7-6 and after two quick outs from Nelson Alvarez, Binghamton had back-to-back singles, then William Lugo ended the game with a three-run walk-off home run to left field, giving the Rumble Ponies a 9-7 victory.

### Keaton Crushing It

Keaton Anthony turned in the best game of his professional career on Wednesday night. He had four hits, one run, two doubles, a home run and a five RBI. The four hits matched a career high for the second time, with the last time being Sept. 5, 2024, at Aberdeen. The two doubles also matched a career best for the second time (8/11/24 at Wilmington). His five RBI in the game were a career-high and the second time this season a Fightin Phil had five RBI in a game (Robert Moore 4/15 vs Binghamton). Anthony's four hit game was the first time a R-Phil had four hits in a game since Carson Taylor on June 21, 2024, at New Hampshire. Anthony is currently on an 11-game hitting streak and 16-game on-base streak, which both rank as the longest active streaks in the Eastern League. Entering play today, Anthony holds the following Eastern League ranks: T-8th RBI (17), 7th SLG (.524), 9th OPS (.892), T-1st 2B (10) and T-3rd XBH (13).

### Moore Please

Robert Moore turned in another excellent game against Binghamton on Wednesday night. He had two hits, along with a season-high two doubles and career-high three runs scored. In six games against the Rumble Ponies this season, Moore is slashing .389/.455/.889 (1.344 OPS), along with seven runs, three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and two stolen bases.

### Rolling Reyes

Felix Reyes continued his hot start to his time in Reading with another double, RBI and run scored on Wednesday night. Reyes is on a five-game on-base streak, dating back to Apr. 30. Over the streak, he's slashing .368/.333/.684 (1.017 OPS), with three runs, three doubles, one home run and six RBI. Since his Double-A debut on Apr. 17, Reyes is tied for fifth in the Eastern League in doubles with five. He's also tied with Keaton Anthony with five doubles in that timeframe.

### Double Double

The Fightin Phils turned in seven doubles and eight extra-base hits in Wednesday night's game, both of which are season highs. The eight extra-base hits are Reading's most in a game since having eight on June 28, of last season, against Bowie. It was the first time the R-Phils had seven doubles in a game since hitting eight on June 29, 2018, against Hartford.

### Some Numbers

Following Wednesday night's loss, the Fightin Phils are now 3-9 when scoring first in games. It was also their fifth loss this season when leading after the seventh inning. Last season, the Fightin Phils dropped eight games when leading after seven innings. The six-run blown lead on Wednesday night was also the largest lead surrendered by the R-Phils this season.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**May 8, 1955:** At Reading, Roger Maris makes his Baseballtown debut, dropping down a bunt single in his first at-bat. He would add a double and a triple while scoring a pair of runs in the Indians' 13-7 loss to Williamsport. The Indians commit five errors, all in a three-run 3rd inning. Grays catcher Sam Miley (4-for-5) knocks in six runs without an extra-base hit while future Hall of Famer Bill Mazeroski is 2-for-4 with a triple, two runs and two RBIs for Williamsport.

### Rumbling into Binghamton

Binghamton enters tonight with a 16-11 record, sitting tied for second in the Northeast Division. In 2024, the Rumble Ponies finished with a 69-67 record. Binghamton was in Erie last week and went 3-3, having to play two doubleheaders due to two games being rained out. After this week, the Rumble Ponies are back on the road and face Hartford in a seven-game series at Dunkin' Park. Six of the Mets' top-30 prospects are on Binghamton's roster: Jett Williams (2), Ryan Clifford (4), Jonah Tong (6), Nick Morabito (17), Jonathan Pintaro (23) and Jack Wenninger (28).

### Ponies Pitcher

Righty, and Mets' No. 28 prospect, Jack Wenninger makes the start tonight for Binghamton. This season, Wenninger is 4-1, with a 2.92 ERA over five starts (24.2 IP, 18 H, 7 BB, 34 SO). Wenninger last pitched on Apr. 29 at Erie and took the loss, as he allowed six runs on seven hits over 4.2 innings pitched, with two strikeouts. He faced Reading on Apr. 17 and took the win, allowing one run on three hits over five innings, with six strikeouts. Wenninger split last season between St. Lucie (A) and Brooklyn (A+), combining to go 4-6, with a 4.30 ERA over 25 games and 19 starts. The 23-year old was drafted by the Mets in the sixth round in 2023 out of Illinois. He began his college career at Murray State in 2021, then pitched for Illinois in 2022 and '23.

The Fightin' Phils beat Harrisburg, 5-4, at FirstEnergy Stadium. Despite allowing a season-high five walks, Cabrera surrendered just two runs on two hits over five-plus innings. Cabrera kept Harrisburg off the board through the first five innings, which included inducing an inning-ending double play in the top of the fifth to get him out of a jam. Cabrera came back out for the sixth and walked the first two batters he faced and was lifted from the game. The two runners allowed by Cabrera scored later in the inning on a home run. Cabrera was relieved by Braeden Fausnaught in the top of the sixth inning.

### 2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft
- The Phillies optioned Cabrera to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Cabrera pitched in two spring training games for the Phillies, allowing one run over three innings and also earning a win on Feb. 28 vs Boston
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opens the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Named the Fightin' Phils Opening Day starter and allowed 1 ER over 4.2 IP in a no-decision on Apr. 4 vs Portland
- Suffered first loss of season over 4.1 IP at Somerset on Apr. 10
- Earned first victory of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton, posting season-highs in IP (5.0) and strikeouts (7)
- Threw season-high in innings (6.0), pitches (89) and runs (4) on Apr. 22 at Portland
- Leads team with 19 walks allowed; matched career-high with five May 1 vs HBG

### 2024 Season:

- Began season with Jersey Shore (A+), where he made 14 starts prior to promotion to Reading (AA) on July 9
- Limited LHH to a .190/.261/.286 (.547 OPS) slash line
- Fanned a career-high 14 batters on July 12 vs Wilmington, which was the second-most strikeouts in BlueClaws history
- Collected first Double-A win on Aug. 23 at Binghamton, in his final start of the season
- Over five April starts, posted a 2.25 ERA (7 ER, 28.0 IP)
