#25 Jhonkensy Noel #30 Xzavion Curry YESTERDAY: Dayton starter Eduardo Salazar pitched a seven-inning complete game shutout, as the Captains lost, 2-0. Salazar struck out 10 Captains, walked one and scattered just three hits (all singles). Captains starter Hunter Gaddis pitched all six innings, allowing just two runs on four hits with three strikeouts and no walks. Dayton's runs came on a second-inning solo homer by Victor Ruiz and a sixth-inning sacrifice fly by Juan Martinez.

**TOP OF THE HEAP:** The Captains enter today tied with the Dayton Dragons for first place in the High-A Central League East Division. They have held at least a share of first place since their win on Sunday, but had previously not been in first since May 26. That date is also the last time the Captains held a share of a playoff position, but that was before Major League Baseball's July 1 announcement that there would be postseason baseball in the minors this season.

**PLAYOFF PICTURE:** The Captains enter today 3.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 4.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 10.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

NINE INNINGS? WHAT'S THAT?: Only two of the last eight Captains games have ended after nine innings. Lake County has played five seven-inning games and one 12-inning game in that span.

**NO TRAFFIC:** In the month of August, the Captains' pitching staff owns the league's lowest WHIP (1.09), has allowed the fewest hits (108) and has the second-lowest batting average against (.207). Their hit total and WHIP are both the lowest in all of High-A, while their batting average against is third-lowest.

SIT 'EM DOWN: The Captains' starting staff is enjoying its best strikeout month of the season. Lake County starters are averaging a season-high 11.6 K/9 in August (105 K, 81.1 IP). Their 4.04 K/BB rate is also a season-best (26 BB). Three of the Captains' five 10-strikeout games have come in August. The other two were on July 24 and 30.

LEADING THE PACK: George Valera does not yet have enough plate appearances to qualify for the league leaderboards. Among hitters with 250+ plate appearances, however, Valera leads the High-A Central League in wRC+ (157). He is also second in OPS (.950), second in isolated slugging (.284), second in BB% (19.5), third in on-base percentage (.414) and fourth in slugging percentage (.536).

NO REST, NO PROBLEM: George Valera has played 24 consecutive games. Since his last game off (July 23), Valera is slashing .250/.450/.583 (1.033 OPS). Valera has seven homers and more walks (26) than strikeouts (22). José Tena has played 22 straight games, all of which have been at shortstop. Since his last game off (July 25), he is slashing .277/.348/.566 (.914 OPS) with seven homers.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 26-16 at home, compared to 24-28 on the road.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains LHP Francisco Perez became the 103rd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on August 12. A record 11 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and RHP Justin Garza and Perez. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Espino tallied his third consecutive 10-K performance in arguably his most complete start as a Captain last Saturday at Classic Park. The right-hander struck out 11 Whitecaps over five innings and held West Michigan to just one run on one hit and one walk. West Michigan's only hit against Espino came on a third-inning solo homer by Rey Rivera. Espino took a hard-luck loss, as the Captains dropped game one of a doubleheader, 2-0.

PROSPECTING: Espino ranks as Cleveland's #2 prospect according to *FanGraphs*, #3 by *Baseball America* and #5 by *MLB.com*.

SIT DOWN: Espino has struck out 10+ in each of his last three starts. In those starts, Espino has 33 strikeouts and four walks across 14 innings. That is a 21.2 K/9 rate and an 8.25 K/BB rate.

**TOP PICK:** Cleveland drafted Espino with their first round pick (24th overall) in the 2019 MLB Draft. The right-hander earned a \$2.5 million signing bonus. He was committed to play at Louisiana State University before signing with Cleveland.

**SCOUTING REPORT:** "Espino works at 94-97 mph and can touch triple digits with his fastball, imparting running life on his four-seamer and heavy sink on his two-seamer. He backs up his heat with a pair of batmissing breaking balls, with his low-80s slider sharper and grading better than his high-70s curveball. His changeup is more of a work in progress that gets too firm at times but also features some promising sink." (Source: *MLB.com*)

SCOUTING GRADES: Fastball – 70; Slider – 60; Curveball – 55; Changeup – 50; Control – 50; Overall – 50 (Source: *MLB.com*)

PANAMA → GEORGIA: Espino was born and grew up in Panama, but moved to the United States when he was a sophomore in high school and pitched for Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, GA. As Mandy Bell wrote in her <u>MLB.com</u> article on <u>Espino</u>, Espino spent time in the U.S. for baseball when he was 10 and decided then that he wanted to move there. When Daniel was 15, he went to his parents and told them needed to move to the United States to pursue his baseball dreams. When asked about his decision to move to the U.S., Espino said "My mom and dad wanted me to finish high school first and then worry about the next, but I love playing baseball. I had the opportunity to [visit America] when I was 10 years old and I loved it. Now, the sacrifice is paying off (Source: <u>The Record-Courier</u>).

PANAMANIAN ROLE MODEL: Espino idolized Panamanian star and Hall of Fame closer Mariano Rivera as a child

**FIRST SINCE FRANCISCO:** When he advanced to Mahoning Valley in 2019, Espino became the first high schooler promoted by Cleveland to the Short Season level since Francisco Lindor in 2011.

**2020:** Pitched at Classic Park, which was Cleveland's alternate training site, before doing remote development prior to the fall instructional league. Espino did not pitch at instructs due to a minor shoulder injury (Source: *FanGraphs*).

**2019:** Made his professional debut in the Rookie Level Arizona League and posted a 1.98 ERA before being bumped up to Short Season Mahoning Valley. Espino posted a 6.30 ERA with the Scrappers over three starts. Though he made nine starts and did not make any relief appearances, Espino never pitched more than four innings in a single professional game during his debut season.
