



Syracuse Mets News and Notes

Comeback Kids: Since June 2nd, Syracuse is 25-17, which is the second-best record in the International League since that point, one game behind Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. During that stretch the Mets have 13 come-from-behind wins and are second in the league with 236 total runs scored.

Turning It Around: Since May 24th, the Syracuse Mets are fourth in the International League with 272 runs scored in 50 games despite ranking 17th with a .246 batting average. From the beginning of the season to May 23rd, the Mets were last in the league with a .205 batting average and ranked second to last with 154 runs scored in 40 games.

Bullpen Bullseye: Since July 7th, Syracuse's bullpen has a 2.59 ERA (14 ER in 48.2 IP) with 55 strikeouts (10.17 K/9) and only 18 walks (3.33 BB/9) in ten games.

From the beginning of the season to July 6th, Syracuse's bullpen had a 4.59 ERA (195 ER in 382 IP) with 393 strikeouts (9.25 K/9) and 171 walks (4.03 BB/9) in 80 games.

Do the Palka: Since reaching a season-low batting average of .205 on May 28th, **Daniel Palka** has reached base in 26 out of the last 29 games. During this stretch, the 30-year-old is hitting .339 with 23 RBIs, seven home runs, seven doubles, 20 runs scored, ten walks and a .393 on-base percentage. Palka is tied for seventh in the International League with 17 home runs.

The Future Is Here: Francisco Álvarez and Mark Vientos played in the Futures Game at Dodger Stadium last Saturday. Álvarez went 0-for-1 plus a walk while Vientos went 0-for-2 plus a walk. Álvarez, currently the top-ranked prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline, joined Syracuse on July 4th after an electric start to the season with Double-A Binghamton. The 20-year-old smacked 16 doubles and 18 home runs in 67 games with the Rumble Ponies, including 10 home runs in the month of June alone.

Since May 2nd, **Mark Vientos** is hitting .289 with 38 RBIs, 15 home runs, five doubles, 20 walks and a .365 on-base percentage in 456games. Vientos is tied for ninth in the International League with 16 home runs this season.

Heating Up: Since July 1st, Gosuke Katoh is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with ten RBIs, five home runs, three doubles, and a .397 on-base percentage. Katoh was named the International League Player of the Week for his performance from July 4-10 in Buffalo where he hit .435 (10-for-23) with eight RBIs, four home runs, three doubles, and a .519 on-base percentage.

Streaking: Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 41 of his last 47 games, including hits in 37 of 47. During his last 47 games since May 12th, Blankenhorn is hitting .333 with 31 RBIs, eight home runs, 14 doubles, 16 walks, and a .403 on-base percentage.

From the start of the season to May 11th, Blankenhorn hit .167 with 12 RBI, four homers, three doubles, four walks, 28 strikeouts, and a .216 onbase percentage.

Blankenhorn was named the International League's June Player of the Month by Minor League Baseball. In June, Blankenhorn hit .402 with 24 RBIs, five home runs, ten doubles, and a .486 on-base percentage in 25 games, ranking second in the league in batting average, on-base percentage, and RBIs in June while leading the league with a 1.160 onbase plus slugging percentage.


