

Shipping Up to Boston's (Affiliate) Portland

R-Phils.

Today, Reading plays the first of six games on the road at the Portland Sea Dogs. This is the first of 21 matchups between the teams this season. Portland comes to Reading July 14-16 and again from September 5-10. The R-Phils return to Portland from June 20-25. Last season, Reading won the season series over the Sea Dogs 10-8. The tean's split the one series at Hadlock Field in 2022.

Home Cookin'

Reading, wearing its famous Hot Dogs uniforms, cooked up a dominant 7-1 win over the Hartford Yard Goats. It was the R-Phils best all-around game of the season. The bats collected 11 hits, including three from Johan Rojas. Rojas and Carlos De La Cruz both also hit home runs in the win. The R-Phils bullpen, which has struggled this season, razzle dazzled with 4.2 innings of no-hit baseball to close the game.

Wacky Numbers

When looking at Reading's early-season results, there are a lot of numbers that stand out. The R-Phils lead the entire Eastern League in hitting at .270 (35 points ahead of number two), but ranks 8th in runs scored with 37, which is good for 4.1 per game. The R-Phils early-season achilles heal has been its pitching. Reading ranks in the bottom-half of the league in all major pitching categories through nine games.

Early Game Success

One part of the game the R-Phils have found success in has been the first inning. In the first inning of games, Reading is outscoring opponents by seven runs. But, over the rest of the game, opponents are out scoring the R-Phils by 13 runs. Additionally, the R-Phils have scored first in six of their nine games so far, but hold just a 1-5 record in those contests.

Around the Organization

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies were rained out last night, but open a series today at the Chicago White Sox. On Sunday, the Phillies beat the Reds 14-3. Bryson Stott led off the game with a home run and now has hits in 16-straight games. The rest of the organization had off on Monday and opens up series tonight.

Carlos De La Crushed

Sunday, Carlos De La Cruz hit his team-leading third home run of the season. De La Cruz has started every game this season for the R-Phils and is third on the team amongst qualifiers in hitting with a .343 average. The Phillies ninth-ranked prospect also is moving to first base from the outfield this season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 18, 2015: At Reading, Brock Stassi drives in Gabriel Lino with an RBI single in the 10th inning, giving the Fightin Phils a 6-5 win over Richmond. Stassi, who did not start the game, had already delivered a game-tying 2-run single in the 8th in his first at-bat. It is his 4th game with 3 RBI or more in the season's first 8 contests and would set the stage for his leading the league in runs batted in at season's end.

Got That Dog in Them

Reading's opponent, the Portland Sea Dogs, enter tonight's matchup with a 7-2 record which leads the Eastern League Northeast Division. This past week, Portland took four of six games on the road at New Hampshire. The Sea Dogs did drop the finale of the series on Sunday.

Throw a Dog a Ball

Getting the ball for Portland tonight is righty Sterling Sharp. He is making his second start of the season after six-strong innings last Wednesday at New Hampshire. Sharp allowed just three hits, one run and struck out four Fisher Cats. He spent 2022 between Nationals triple-A Rochester and Portland. Sharp also had a brief stint in the major with the Marlins in 2020, where he appeared in four games with a 10.13 ERA.
