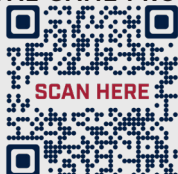

TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Albuquerque face off on Thursday with a 7:05 p.m. first pitch at Dell Diamond for game three of the series. Express RHP Tyson Miller is set for the start on the mound up against Isotopes RHP Zach Neal.

RECAPING YESTERDAY

Round Rock jumped ahead of Albuquerque on Wednesday afternoon and never looked back as the team won 14-1. The Express started early with a four-run first inning. CF Bubba Thompson and 3B Josh Smith both scored as LF Leody Taveras cleared the bases with a three-run dinger. C Sam Huff scored the fourth run after being hit by a pitch, moving to third on back-to-back singles from 1B Matt Carpenter and SS Davis Wendzel then scoring on a Meibrys Vilorio single. Round Rock plated five in the second inning thanks to a combination of three doubles, two singles and another hit-by-pitch for Huff as the E-Train extended their lead to 9-0. Albuquerque avoided the shutout with a run in the fourth when RF Scott Schebler scored. Smith knocked a home run in the fifth inning as he scored himself and 2B Ryan Dorow. Round Rock kept it going in the sixth, increasing their advantage to 12-1 when Huff hit a solo home run. The Express added two more in the eighth inning for a 14-1 score when Wendzel blasted a home run.

TIME FOR A MILLER

Round Rock RHP Tyson Miller is scheduled to make his first start of the season on Wednesday after having made three relief appearances to start the year. The righty holds a 1-0 record and 1.29 ERA (1 ER/7.0 IP) and has thrown 11 strikeouts. Miller made nine starts for the E-Train during 2021.

HOME RUN DERBY

Wednesday afternoon's win saw the Express hit four home runs en route to the massive 14-1 final score. The home run total of four marks the most in a contest for Round Rock during the 2022 campaign. Per TrackMan, LF Leody Taveras' hit went 408 feet, 3B Josh Smith's was 398, C Sam Huff's was 500 and SS Davis Wendzel's was 430. Huff's tracked distance is the longest recorded at Dell Diamond this season.

EXPRESS ON THE BUMP

Round Rock relievers RHP Jason Bahr and RHP Dan Winkler combined for 4.0 hitless innings on Wednesday as each fanned three batters during their outings and Bahr allowed only one Albuquerque baserunner with a walk. Starter RHP Cole Winn earned his first decision of the season after tossing a 5.0-inning start that saw one run on three hits and two walks with two strikeouts.

JUST HITTING AROUND

The Express recorded 16 hits on Wednesday for the third time this season as every starter except for one knocked at least one hit during the afternoon's contest. Six batters tallied multiple hits with 1B Matt Carpenter and SS Davis Wendzel leading the way with three apiece. Half of the game's hits found multiple bases as Round Rock hit four doubles to go along with their four home runs.

THOMPSON ON TOP

Express CF Bubba Thompson increased his active hitting streak to 10 games on Wednesday after knocking a leadoff single in the first inning. The streak is tied for the longest in all of Triple-A and the hit brought his season total to 20, which is the third most in the Pacific Coast League.

MORE NEW RECORDS

Round Rock tallied a new single-game high on Wednesday as the team totaled 14 RBI. The season's previous team high was six. LF Leody Taveras and SS Davis Wendzel contributed four each while 3B Josh Smith added two. Four other E-Train hitters batted one run in during the team's 14-1 victory.

Alexy, RHP Justin Anderson, INF Sherten Apostel, RHP Kohei Arihara, RHP Jason Bahr, INF Ryan Dorow, OF Elier Hernandez, INF Yonny Hernandez, C Sam Huff, C Jack Kruger, LHP Jake Latz, RHP Tyson Miller, C Yohel Pozo, RHP Yerry Rodriguez, RHP Ryder Ryan, RHP Nick Snyder, OF Leody Taveras, INF Davis Wendzel and RHP Cole Winn. RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
