THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 2010, Mat Gamel went 4-for-5 with 2 home runs as the Sounds outlasted Albuquerque 11-8 at Isotopes Park. Batting 3rd in the lineup, Gamel hit a 3-run shot in the 4th inning and a solo homer in the 8th. LaTroy Hawkins recorded his only save for the Sounds in the victory (2.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 K).

Tonight's Game: The Sounds take on the Louisville Bats in game two of the three game series tonight at Louisville Slugger Field. Nashville scored nine runs over the final three frames to take a 12-6 win in the series opener. Right-hander Dylan File gets the start for the Sounds, going against rehabbing pitcher Justin Dunn.

Dylan File: 26-year-old Dylan File starts for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 4-5 with a 4.65 ERA (81.1 IP/42 ER) in 18 appearances (14 starts) this season with Nashville. His last appearance came in relief on July 16 vs. Memphis, pitching an inning in the Sounds' 10-0 loss (5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 3 K). He had an abbreviated start on July 12 vs. Memphis, lasting only 2.0 innings before exiting in the loss (4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 1 K). Tabbed as the No. 24 prospect in the Brewers system, File went 2-4 with a 5.27 ERA in 9 starts with Nashville in 2021. In his fifth professional season, the Phoenix, Ariz. resident was selected by the Brewers in the 21st Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Dixie State University (now Utah Tech).

Justin Dunn: 26-year-old Justin Dunn makes his fifth rehab start for the Bats in game two of the series. The right-hander is 0-2 with a 5.93 ERA (13.2 IP/9 ER) with Louisville this season. He also pitched once for High-A Dayton (2.0 IP/1 ER). Dunn took the loss in his last start on July 17 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, allowing eight runs (3 ER) on nine hits and two walks in 4.0 innings. It was his second loss of that series, also taking the defeat on July 12. Dunn was traded to Cincinnati along with CF Jake Fraley and LHP Brandon Williamson in the deal that sent LF Jesse Winker and 3B Eugenio Suarez to Seattle. He went 1-3 with a 3.75 ERA in 11 starts for the Mariners last season. The Boston College product was originally selected by the Mets in the First Round (19th Pick) of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Superlatives: Sunday's win by Nashville improved their record to 9-7 in series openers...25-17 on the road...39-9 when scoring first...48-12 when scoring 4 or more runs...24-6 when hitting multiple homers...23-5 when recording 10+ hits and 40-4 when outhitting their opponent.

Long Ball x 4 (Again): Nashville matched its season-high with four home runs (Jon Singleton - 2, Pablo Reyes - 1, Jackson Reetz - 1) in last night's win. The Sounds have hit four home runs in six games this season and in both of their last two games.

Comeback Kids: The Sounds pulled off another comeback win last night. Trailing 6-3 entering the seventh, a five-run frame put the Sounds ahead by the seventh inning stretch. Nashville put together a seven-run comeback in their last game on Sunday vs. Memphis, erasing an 8-1 deficit in the sixth inning.

Slugging Singleton: Jon Singleton had his first multi-homer game for the Sounds this season. He hit two go-ahead two-run shots, with the latter putting the Sounds up for good. His last multi-home run game came with Fresno in 2016. It was also his first five RBI game since 2017 with Corpus Christi.

Almonte Makes it Four: Abraham Almonte had a night to remember, clubbing four hits in the win. The switch hitter became the seventh Sound to have 4+ hits in a game this season. It was his first four hit contest since August 8, 2015 while playing with Cleveland.

Pablo Power: Infielder/Outfielder Pablo Reyes has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games with six multi-hit contests over the span. During the 10-game stretch, Reyes is hitting .421 (16-for-38) with 7 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 7 RBI and 3 stolen bases.

Run Machine: In 15 games in the month of July, shortstop Brice Turang has scored 17 runs, the most in the International League. Turang is hitting .305 (18-for-59) with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 9 RBI, 9 walks and 5 stolen bases. He has a .391 OBP and .849 OPS during July.

Rinse, Repeat: Reliever Peter Strzelecki has not allowed a run over his last eight outings for the Sounds (since June 29). The right-hander has allowed just one hit in the last 9.1 innings, holding batters to a .038 average (1-for-26) with a 0.32 WHIP in that span.

What Can Brown Do For You: Reliever Zack Brown has thrown 7.1 scoreless innings in the month of July. In his six July appearances, Brown has allowed only two hits and has not walked a batter. He has seven strikeouts and has not allowed a run since June 26 vs. Gwinnett.

200 and Counting: Rick Sweet won his 202nd game as Nashville's manager last night, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).

LAST OUTING: File last pitched in a relief role against Memphis on the Sunday prior to the All-Star break. He worked 1.0 inning and allowed two runs (both earned) on five hits. He did not walk a batter, struck out three, and threw 24 of his 32 pitches for strikes in Nashville's 10-8 win.

AGAINST OPPONENT: File is facing Louisville for the fourth time in his career. The last time he pitched against the Bats was May 19 at First Horizon Park (ND, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 K). He faced the Bats in Kentucky on August 13, 2021 and allowed seven runs on 12 hits in 5.2 innings. He was tagged with another loss against Louisville on September 1, 2021 and he went 6.0 innings and allowed four runs (three earned) on seven hits.
