LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn saw its four game winning streak halted by the Renegades, 16-3, on Thursday night...The contest aired on SNY, the New York Mets' TV home...Despite an audience on cable television, Brooklyn was playing from behind all night...RHP Jordany Ventura was tagged with the loss, logging 2.1 innings while allowing six runs (five earned)...All nine Renegades starters recorded at least one hit, headlined by the minor-league rehabbing INF Jorbit Vivas, who enjoyed a 5-for-5 day at the dish, adding a walk to reach base in all six trips...Hudson Valley put up a five spot in the first - their largest output in a frame...Despite the loss, 3B Nick Lorusso launched his fifth and sixth homers of the season...The former Maryland Terrapin now has two multi-HR games this season.

NICK DIGS THE LONG BALL: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old launched two more home runs in Thursday's loss to Hudson Valley... The 2023 draftee tied for third in extra-base hits (17), fifth in slugging (.537) and OPS (.912), tied for sixth in RBI (24), and tied for ninth in total base (66)...His 155 wRC+ is also fifth in the circuit...Among Mets' minor leaguers, Lorusso is tied for second in extra-base hits (17), tied for third in doubles (9), fourth in slugging (.537), fifth in OPS (.912), and tied for fifth in home runs (6).

KADE YOU DIG IT: RHP Kade Morris put on a show in his High-A debut on Wednesday afternoon against Hudson Valley...The 2023 third-round selection by the Mets tossed 6.0 innings, giving up only one run on four hits, while striking out seven and walking only one batter, all en route to earning his first career win...RHP Jonah Tong tossed 6.2 innings in a win vs. Hudson Valley on Tuesday, marking the first time Brooklyn has received quality starts in consecutive days since RHP Tyler Stuart (6.0 IP) and RHP Blade Tidwell (6.0) accomplished the feat on July 5 and 6, 2023, at Wilmington...Among Mets' farmhands with 30.0+ innings pitched, Morris is third in innings pitched (40.2), fifth in strikeouts (45), and seventh in ERA (3.32).

MORABITO FUEL: OF Nick Morabito has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old is tied for third in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.484), seventh in stolen bases (23), ninth in batting average (.359) and 16th in wRC+(177)...Morabito stole three bases last Wednesday and did it again last Saturday...That mark is tied for the most by a Cyclone in the previous 23 years...The McLean, Va. native enters the day tied for 10th in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (12) despite playing just 13 games.

ORELLANA'S OVERWHELMING START: RHP Douglas Orellana set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome and continued his impressive start to 2024 on Friday night...Among arms with 29.0+ innings of work, Orellana is second in the league in ERA (1.23), third in opposing OPS (.475), and fifth in batting average against (.165) and WHIP (0.99)...Orellana's 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 29.1 IP) is the sixth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 29.0+ innings of work... The 22-year-old whiffed 10 in his start against the Emperors, the second double-digit strikeout game of his career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a double-header for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP Robert Collina punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: RHP Jonah Tong earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP Jordany Ventura tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.95 ERA (4 ER in 38.0 IP)...Tong is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.95)...Only Arizona's LHP Spencer Giesting (0.66) at High-A Hillsboro has a lower mark...The Markham, Ont. native is fifth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.6%) is eighth...Tong's 59 strikeouts are the 10th-most in the minors.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.87, even after Thursday's 16-3 loss to Hudson Valley...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.43 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.30)...That ERA is also third at the High-A level and eighth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.16).

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to play a six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades possess six of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP Kyle Carr (11), INF Roc Riggio (18), INF Jared Serna (19), and OF Jace Avina (28)...INF Jorbit Vivas (15) and INF Tyler Hardman (25) have also joined the team this week on Minor League rehab assignments... The Cyclones went 14-10 against Hudson Valley in 2023, including a 6-6 record at Maimonides Park and a 8-4 mark at Heritage Financial Park in Wappingers Falls...Since 2001, Brooklyn is 142-145 all-time (.495) against Hudson Valley in 287 matchups.

MAIMONIDES MAGIC: The Cyclones enter play on Friday with a 14-7 record at Maimonides Park, but an 8-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn holds the 10th-best home ERA (2.66) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (1.92) has the lowest mark in MiLB...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.70..They also maintain a .685 opposing OPS and a .245 batting average against on the road.

WALK ON THE WIDE SIDE: The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in last Saturday's win over Bowling Green...Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 at Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington...Saturday's 12 free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record... Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont...Individually, INF William Lugo has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 32 free passes are the second most in the league...Lugo's 22.2% walk rate is also second in the league and third in Minor League Baseball.

RUNNING WILD AND FREE: Brooklyn swiped a season-high seven bases in last Saturday's triumph at Bowling Green...LF Omar De Los Santos and RF Nick Morabito each stole three bases, while CF Stanley Consuegra added a single swipe...The Cyclones' previous season-best was four on three occasions, most recently on May 8 at Rome...Brooklyn fell one stolen bag shy of matching the franchise record of eight set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...DH Walter Rasquin and RF José Miguel Medina each stole three bases in that affair, while 2B Edgardo Fermín and CF Quinn Brodey snatched the other two...The seven steals were the most in a game for the Cyclones since they also stole seven bases on August 15, 2018, vs. Vermont...During last week's series against Bowling Green, the Cyclones stole 18 bases to the Hot Rods' 15.

KING STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 71 extra-base hits, 31 home runs, and 103 RBI...The 23-year-old is also three hits away (161) from matching OF Alex Ramfrez's (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramfrez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has record a mark of 1,004-848 (.542) in 1,852 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 206-217 (.487) in 423 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with Hunter Parsons (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 53 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.57 ERA (24 ER in 84.0 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 21 and striking out 72.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list... Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

Only run allowed came on a solo home run by 3B **Ryan Spikes** in the bottom of the fifth...Threw a season-high 73 pitches and 51 strikes (69.86%)...Relieved by RHP **Jimmy Loper** to start the bottom of the sixth with the game tied at one...Cyclones carried a 5-3 lead into the bottom of the ninth...However, the Hot Rods walked-off with a 6-5 win thanks to a bases-loaded hit-by-pitch and a pair of walks.

pouble-digit double-digit strikeouts on May 11 at Rome....It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP Robert Colina punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with 29.0+ innings of work, Orellana ranks second in ERA (1.23) and fifth in WHIP (0.99) and batting average against (1.65)...His 1.23 ERA is sixth-lowest in MiLB among pitchers with 29.0+ innings pitched.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Orellana had his season-high 12.0-inning scoreless streak come to a close on May 5 vs. Aberdeen...During the stretch, he surrendered just three hits and fours walk, adding 13 strikeouts...The 22-year-old started the season by tossing a bevvy of zeroes too...The right-hander did not allow a run over his first two appearances and 8.1 innings...Orellana yielded only four hits and three walks in that span, while striking out eight.

DOOGIE HOWSER: The Caraças, Venezuela native was untouchable out of the bullpen on April 24 vs. Wilmington...The 22-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced — striking out six — in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito García** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP **Nelson Pereira** (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

2023: Orellana spent the entire 2023 season with current Brooklyn manager **Gilbert Gómez** and pitching coach **Dan McKinney** at Single-A St. Lucie...In his age 21 campaign, the right-hander made 23 appearances and 18 starts, tallying a 4-4 record and a 4.53 ERA (45 ER in 89.1 IP) with one save...Orellana issued 50 walks, but struck out 112 hitters...He finished fifth in the Florida State League in strikeouts and second on St. Lucie's roster behind LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (114)...Orellana finished the season by being named the FSL's Pitcher of the Month for September...He permitted only two runs (one earned) on five hits in 10.2 innings, accruing two walks and 16 K's.
