

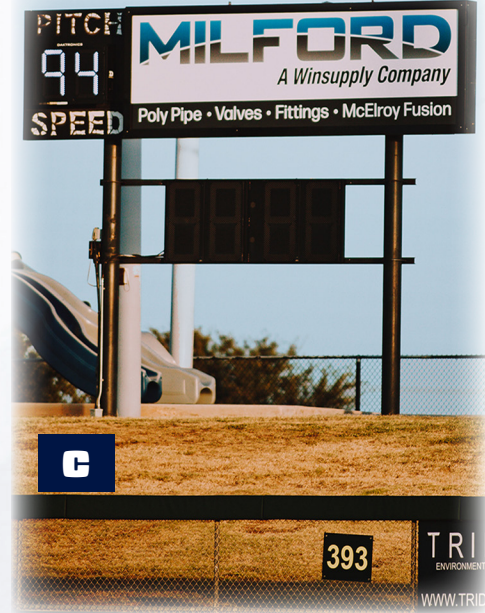
Three of the ballpark's premier sign locations are unlike any other:

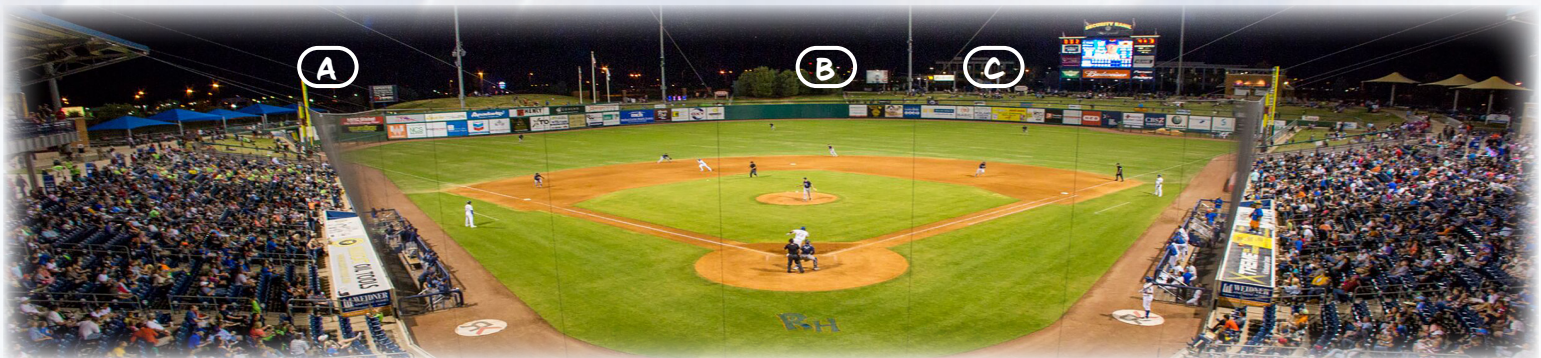

Stand-Alone Signs

- One in left field and one in right-center (see "A" and "B" in the photo, below).
- Both offer exceptional size & visibility.
- Their size and placement allow visibility from all sections of the main seating bowl and the ballpark's "360" walkway (which circles the interior of the stadium).
- In addition, the sign in left field (position "A" in the photo, below) is two-sided and is also visible from the stadium's parking areas and the Sports Complex Auxiliary Fields.

Pitch Speed / Game Clock

- Is positioned on the right-center field berm (position "C" in the photo, below).
- Has two digital readouts:
The pitch velocity and the "game clock."
- The pitch velocity readout is one of the most visible elements in the ballpark.
It attracts the attention of both "serious" and casual fans.
- The game clock serves multiple functions.
One of those is the "pitch clock," which has become a primary focal point in every game all across baseball.
The "game clock" also counts down time between innings.
