JACKSONVILLE LOSES THIRD-STRAIGHT

After falling behind early for the fourth time this series, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp lost to the Gwinnett Stripers 3-1 Saturday night at Coolray Field. The Stripers needed just three runs, which they tallied between the second and third innings. Jacksonville's offense continued to struggle, being held without a hit until the fifth inning but they couldn't scratch any runs across until the eighth. Paul McIntosh's solo shot in the eighth was the only run for the Jumbo Shrimp as they wrapped up their quickest nine-inning game of the year in two hours and five minutes. The club's three hits last night was the second-fewest in a game since they tallied two against the Lehigh Valley IronPigs back on April

GONE FISHIN'

Since 2021, Jacksonville's first year back in Triple-A, they are an extraordinary 27-15 (.643) against the Gwinnett Stripers. Perhaps most dominantly, in 2022, the clubs matched up 23 times, with Jacksonville winning 17 of those contests (.739). Since 2021, Jacksonville has outscored Gwinnett 196 to 177 or an average of 4.7 to 4.2 runs per game. In four different series last year, the Jumbo Shrimp had a clean sweep, going 4-0 against the Stripers.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 26 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 31 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 31 home runs are tied for 19th-most in Triple-A over the last 26 games.

YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 31-42 record is 20th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-three of the club's 73 games, or 72.6 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is by far the most in the league with Gwinnett sitting second with 48 games against teams with a winning record, Jacksonville is 23-30 (.434) against teams who have posted a record of at least .500.

APRIL SHOWERS HAVEN'T BROUGHT FLOWERS

Jacksonville finds themselves in the cellar of the International League. After finishing the first month of the season with a 13-12 record, the Jumbo Shrimp haven't found a spark, going 18-29 since May 1. The club posted the sixth-best ERA through the first month of the season at 4.47 in 227.1 innings. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 252 earned runs in 401.0 innings for a 5.66 ERA that ranks 15th in the IL. Through those 48 games, opponents have posted a .270 batting average against Jacksonville pitching which ranks as the fourth-highest batting average against in the league. Through 72 games in 2022, Jacksonville owned a 38-34 record with a posted 4.49 ERA.

FOUR SCORE AND ONE MONTH AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 12 of their last 17 games, going 7-10 in that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 89 to 80 during this run. After going 0-6 to close out May and open the month of June, Jacksonville has won five of their last 11. The Jumbo Shrimp's longest stretch of scoring at least four runs stands at 10 (April 27-May 7). During that run, Jacksonville went 7-3 and outscored their opponents 65 to 49.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, Brian Miller had posted just a .217/.318/.315/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 25 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 28-for-87 (.322/.388/.437/.825) with six doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and 12 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 10.6 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.5 percent.

SHRIMP BITES

Prior to this week, Jacksonville split their previous two series against Nashville and Memphis at home...The club hasn't won a series since May 2-7 on the road against the Redbirds. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have gone 0-4-3 including a series loss to Gwinnett this week. With only one win in this series, Jacksonville pitching has struggled this week, posting a 7.05 ERA in 37.0 innings which is the second-highest ERA in the IL.
