Home Field Advantage... The Bowling Green Hot Rods have won all four of their home series in 2026 season. The Hot Rods hold a 16-5 record at Bowling Green Ballpark and lead the South Atlantic League with a 76.2 win% in home games this year. Bowling Green launched 10 home runs and recorded three walk-off wins in their last home series against the Brooklyn Cyclones.

Piping Hot Pitre... Returning Hot Rods infielder Emilien Pitre dominated the Greenville Drive at Fluor Field last week. Pitre hit .556 (10-for-19) with two home runs, seven RBI and nine walks drawn across the six-game series. Pitre leads active Hot Rods with 23 walks drawn in 2026. The former Kentucky Wildcat led the 2025 SAL with 120 hits a season ago.

On-Base Operator.... Tampa Bay Rays' No. 1 prospect Theo Gillen enters Tuesday night on a 21-game on-base streak since April 21 st, the longest streak by any Hot Rods player in 2026. The run stands as the third-longest active on-base streak in the SAL, Asheville Tourists' outfielder Justin Thomas Jr. leads the way. Last season, Gillen led Single-A with a 43-game on-base streak for the Charleston RiverDogs, the longest streak by a Charleston player since 2012.

Hujsak Attack.... Connor Hujsak leads Bowling Green hitters with an 11-game hitting streak dating back to May 3rd. The streak ties the third-longest hit streak by any South Atlantic League player in 2026. The 24-year-old has batted .341 (15-for-44) with three home runs and and 18 RBI in that time span. Hujsak also leads all Hot Rods players with eight doubles, nine home runs and 29 RBI during the 2026 season.

Back for More.... Outfielder Aidan Smith rejoined the Hot Rods on Tuesday morning. The Rays' No. 11 prospect led the Hot Rods with 77 runs scored and three multi-home run games during the 2025 SAL season. Smith was a key part of Bowling Green's 2024 South Atlantic League Championship, blasting a two-run home run in game one against the Hudson Valley Renegades.

Bodine's in BG.... Catcher Caden Bodine is set to make his High-A debut in this week's set against Asheville. Bodine lit up Single-A with a .379 batting average, 27 RBI and 27 runs scored in 33 games for Charleston. The 22-year-old ranks as the Rays' No. 12 prospect per MLB Pipeline.
