**TODAY'S GAME:** The M-Braves start a six-game road series against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at Blue Wahoos Stadium. This is the fourth of five series between the two teams. The final series will be August 16-21 at Trustmark Park.

**LAST SERIES:** The M-Braves dropped the final two games of a three-game series to the Biscuits. In game one, Justin Dean lined a two-run single into center in the ninth, ultimately winning the game 2-1. The hit came after an 80-minute rain delay with two outs in the ninth. In game two, RHP Darius Vines spun a six-inning shutout with 10 strikeouts, but the M-Braves lost 2-1 in 10 innings. In game three, the Biscuits dominated in a 15-1 win, scoring five runs in the first and three or more runs in three different innings. The loss was the M-Braves worst defeat of the season.

**LAST TIME AGAINST THE BLUE WAHOOS:** The M-Braves took four out of six from July 6-10. The club came back for three games in a row from July 7-9, including back-to-back walk-offs from Yariel Gonzalez and Drew Luggbauer.

- The M-Braves took five of six from May 24-29 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. The offense put up 55 runs, smashing nine homers and 17 doubles, slugging .486 in the series. The M-Braves won the final four games, outscoring Pensacola 48-18 in the those games.

**SECOND-HALF STUDS:** The M-Braves are a league-best 15-6 in the second-half, leading the SL South by two games over Montgomery, out-scoring the opposition, 107-73 (+34). The 15 wins are T-1st in Double-A and T-3rd in MiLB.

**MILB-BEST START TO JULY:** The M-Braves are T-1st in the MiLB at 14-4 in July. Including the sweep over Rocket City, the M-Braves have won 15 of 19. The pitching staff is the 2nd in Double-A with a 3.01 ERA.

**THE FUTURE GETS CALLED UP:** Starter **Jared Shuster** was called up to Triple-A Gwinnett on Tuesday, July 26. Atlanta's No. 7 prospect has a 2.78 ERA through 17 outings, which ranks third in the Southern League. The New Bedford, MA native is among the league leaders in ERA (2nd, 2.87, strikeouts (106, 2nd), opponent's batting average, (.198, 2nd), WHIP (0.96, 2nd) and innings (90.2, 2nd).

- Shuster pitched in the MLB Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on July 16 before the MLB All-Star break, giving up one run (HR to former teammate Shea Langeliers) on two hits with no walks, and two strikeouts in 1.1 innings pitched.

**OTHER TUESDAY MOVES:** INF **Yariel Gonzalez** has returned to Triple-A Gwinnett along with Shuster on Tuesday. RHP **Allan Winans** was activated from his rehab assignment with the FCL Braves, and Gwinnett 7-day IL, and transferred to Mississippi (will start Thursday). Also, RHP **Jason Creasy** was transferred to the M-Braves roster from the FCL Braves.

**THE COMEBACK KIDS:** The M-Braves came from behind for the seventh time in the final inning, or later, Friday, July 22 at Montgomery. The M-Braves had just two comeback wins in the final inning or later last season. Four of those comebacks have come at Riverwalk Stadium. The M-Braves have walked off five times at Trustmark Park, including back-to-back walk offs on July 7-8.

**SWEEPING INTO HISTORY:** The M-Braves swept the Rocket City Trash Pandas from July 12-17 at Trustmark Park, completing the first six-game sweep in club history. The M-Braves outscored Rocket City 34-12 in the sweep.

**RELIEVERS TO THE RESCUE:** The relief core for the M-Braves leads the Southern League and ranks 3rd in Double-A with a 3.86 ERA this season. RHP **Odalvi Javier** has not allowed an earned run over his last 17 games, and 20.1 innings, with 23 strikeouts to eight walks.

**CAN'T MISS THE NEW GUYS:** In in his first week in Double-A, INF **Vaughn Grissom** hit .462 (12-for-26) with a triple, home run, five RBI, three runs, and three stolen bases. The Oviedo, FL native posted a 1.154 OPS, hitting in all six games, and logged two three-hit games and a pair of two-hit games. Grissom has hit in eight of nine M-Braves games, and just lost an on-base streak of 45-straight games for Rome and Mississippi since May 27. Grissom is ranked as Atlanta's No. 5 prospect.

- Justyn-Henry Malloy** has a homer and six RBI in eight games. Malloy blasted a three-run walk-off home run on Friday, July 15. Malloy hit .304/10 HR/44 RBI/.888 OPS in 71 games for Rome. He is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 28 prospect.

- LHP **Dylan Dodd** went six shutout innings in his Double-A debut with seven strikeouts on Sunday, July 17. Dodd went 9-5 with a 3.44 ERA in 89.0 innings over 15 starts for Rome. He is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 20 prospect.

- LHP **Lisandro Santos** has 4.0 scoreless innings in three relief appearances. Santos posted a 3.40 ERA in 20 appearances, four starts, over 47.2 innings for Rome.

**THE SLUGBAUER MAKING MISSISSIPPI HISTORY:** 1B **Drew Luggbauer** set club record with seven RBI on Saturday, July 2 at Biloxi, including his team-leading 16th home run. Luggbauer has hit a club-record 38 career M-Braves home runs over two seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021. He homered twice on May 27 at Pensacola where he matched the previous club-record with six RBI.

- Luggbauer hit a walk-off three-run homer on Friday, July 8 vs PNS and a walk-off single on Friday, June 3 vs MTG. He is in league's top 10 in...home runs (20, 2nd), RBI (50, 7th), XBH (39, 2nd), runs scored (49, T-8th), walks (49, T-5th), doubles (19, T-6th), and total bases (150, 1st).

**VINES SHINES AGAIN:** RHP **Darius Vines** has a 1.53 ERA over his last six starts (6 ER/35.2 IP), 31 strikeouts, eight walks, matching career highs with 7.0 shutout innings on June 25 at MTG, and July 1 at BLX. He leads the league with 114 strikeouts and 94.0 innings pitched while also ranking among the leaders in starts (18, T-1st), ERA (4.31, 6th) and WHIP (1.27, 5th).

- With his seven shutout innings at Biloxi on July 1, Vines was the first M-Brave to earn Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 28-July 3.

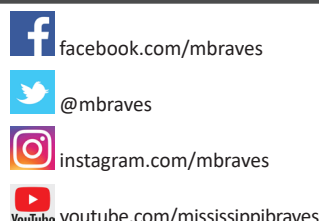
