LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn made it four straight wins to open the season with a 7-3 victory over Hudson Valley in a frigid series-opener on Tuesday night...It's the first time the Cyclones have started 4-0 since at least 2005, marking the start of the MiLB Research Portal...All nine Cyclones reached safely, while seven of nine recorded at least one base hit...RF Eli Serrano III clubbed his second home run of the season - a moon shot to right center field, a rarity at Maimonides Park...1B Chris Suero also enjoyed a solid day at the dish, logging a two-run double to put Brooklyn on the board in the first...RHP R.J. Gordon fell just shy of qualifying for the win in his professional debut, throwing 4.1 innings of two run ball...Brooklyn's bullpen combined on 4.2 innings of one run ball...RHP Layonel Ovalles - who gave up the only run out of the four relievers - recorded the win, while RHP Eduardo Herrera notched his second hold of the campaign.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On April 9, 1913, the Brooklyn Dodgers played their first-ever game at Ebbets Field...Brooklyn dropped the first contest at their new ballpark, 1-0, to the Philadelphia Phillies...The contest featured a 3:20 p.m. first pitch and a time of game of only an hour and 30 minutes...Original New York Mets manager Casey Stengel led off for the Dodgers and played center field, going 0-for-4 at the plate...In 2024, the Cyclones defeated Asheville in their home opener, 3-0...18 Ryan Clifford clubbed a solo home run in the 8th inning, while RHPs Brandon Sproat (2.2 Pl.), Jordany Ventura (3.1), and Justin Lawson (3.0) combined on a 5-hit shutout with 14 strikeouts.

SOARIN' SERRANO: OF Eli Serrano III has impressed to begin his High-A career...The 2024 Mets 4th round selection is 6-for-13 at the plate...Three of his six hits have gone for extra bases, including two home runs - one of which was a mammoth blast to right center field, no small feat at Maimonides Park...The N.C. State product has also displayed a keen eye at the plate, drawing six walks through four games...Serrano III is tied for the league lead in both home runs and walks entering play on Wednesday...The North Carolina native appeared in 17 games at the tail end of last year with Single-A St. Lucie, and collected a .778 OPS

'PEN = NAILS: Brooklyn's bullpen has been outstanding amidst the Cyclones 4-0 start... Through four games, the Cyclones bullpen has surrendered only 4 runs over 19.0 innings of relief work...In addition to boasting an outstanding 30:5 K:BB ratio, the 1.89 bullpen ERA is tops in the South Atlantic League, and second in all of High-A, behind only Fort Wayne...The series oopening win on Tuesday night had four Brooklyn arms combine on 4.2 innings of one run ball...The quartet of RHPs Layonel Ovalles, Eduardo Herrera, Ryan Lambert and Saul Garcia did not allow a single hit, while striking out seven and walking four...Sunday's win over Wilmington saw the trio of RHPs Jace Beck, Austin Troesser and Anthony Nunez record four shutout innings, during which, they faced the minimum 12 batters...Eight of the 12 outs recorded were strikeouts...On Saturday, RHPs Ben Simon, Joel Diaz and Dylan Ross combined for 6.1 frames of scoreless relief work...Simon picked up with win, while Diaz logged the save...The quartet struck out a combined 15 Wilmington batters throughout the course of the day...It's been a similar native for Brooklyn starters as well, who have compiled a 1.42 ERA through the first three games. first three games

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** is off to a scorching start in 2025...The Bronx native is one of two players on the Cyclones with multiple home runs through the first four games...Suero is a blistering 7-for-17 at the dish, with five extra-base hits, eight runs batted in, and boasts an impressive .941 slugging percentage...Suero is one of only seven players to have already belted multiple home runs in the SA...The 2022 international free agent signee is coming off an impressive 2024, that saw him play in 87 games at the High-A level, with seven home runs and 45 RBI, while also swiping 15 stolen bases

REIM TIME!: It's difficult to get out to much of a hotter start than Cyclones INF **Jacob Reimer** through the first four games of the season...Through four games, the California native is an impressive 7-for-17 at the plate with eight RBI, five runs scored, two doubles and a triple...Reimer is towards the top of the SAL in numerous offensive stats despite the small sample size...The 2022 draftee is tied for second in the circuit in RBI (8), tied for fourth in the league in doubles (2), tied for eighth in hits (6), and is top 10 in the SAL in runs scored (4)...Reimer collected more RBI through his first two games played this season than he logged all of last year through 25 games scattered across three different levels.

THOR'S HAMMER: LHP **Zach Thornton** picked up right where he left off in 2024 in his season debut on Sunday...The Grand Canyon University product collected his first win of the year, behind five shutout innings against Wilmington...Thornton allowed only two base hits and one walk, while striking out a career-high eight Blue Rocks batters... In 2024, Thornton pitched in four games with Brooklyn down the stretch, starting four games to the tune of a 3.67 ERA

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT: In Saturday's lopsided victory over Wilmington, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn put a 20-piece on the board on May 27, 2022 against Bowling Green...The 'Clones had 19 hits that day, spearheaded by RF Joe Suozzi, who went 3-for-5 with four runs and 5 RBI...Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday are the most hits the 'Clones have had at Maimonides Park since July 21, 2011, in a 13-0 victory over Bowling Green...3B Richard Lucas went 5-for-6 at the dish, while CF Travis Taijeron was a perfect 4-for-4 with 5 RBI...Also, Brooklyn's 16 runs scored on Saturday were the most in a home game since a 16-5 win over Hudson Valley on June 24, 2010...That game featured a four hit, four RBI day from 1B Jeff Flagg.

THE LONG HALL: RHP Noah Hall spun his best career pro outing on Opening Day for Brooklyn...The 2023 draftee picked up the win, thanks to five innings of one run ball... Hall surrendered only three hits, and gave up just one run...The righty also punched out three batters and walked four...The University of South Carolina product became not only the first player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the first player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days...Last year, was placed on the IL on April 26th and did not pitch again until September 7th with Single-A St. Lucie.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones welcome in the Hudson Valley Renegades for the first installment of the SAL Subway Series of 2025... The Yankees High-A affiliate went 2-1 against Jersey Shore to start the new year, including an 8-7 walk-off victory on Saturday...Hudson Valley boasts 8 top 30 Yankees prospects including INF George Lombard Jr. (2), RHP Ben Hess (4), RHP Bryce Cunningham (6), RHP Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz (8), RHP Cade Smith (16), RHP Carlos Lagrange (19), LHP Kyle Carr (20) and INF Roc Riggio (27) and INF Roc Riggio (27).

BOARDWALK BENGE: OF Carson Benge started his 2025 on the right foot thanks to a keen eye at the plate...Prior to a 1-for-4 performance on Tuesday with a run scored and an RBI, the 2024 first round draftee by the Mets made Wilmington pitchers work over the weekend, drawing three free passes, while going 2-for-6 at the plate in the first weekend of the season...The Oklahoma State product laced a double to left field on Friday for the first High-A hit of his career, and then went 1-for-4 on Sunday...Five of Benge's 15 hits with Single-A St. Lucie went for extra base hits at the tail end of last year...The Yukon, OK native clubbed 2 home runs and 3 doubles in the Florida State league during his time in PSL.

2024 IN REVIEW: Although the Cyclones did not qualify for the postseason last year, 2024 saw a bevy of achievements on the boardwalk...Numerous franchise records were set, including the all time games played, hits and stolen base records, in addition to the single season hits and stolen base records being set...The 2024 'Clones tossed the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history thanks to a combined effort, and six players appeared in Brooklyn on big league rehab assignments.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After four former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, three alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C Hayden Senger ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF Jake Mangum ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B Ty France for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK: Cyclones manager Gilbert Gómez embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33 year old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since Edgardo Alfonzo (2017-2019)...Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls... Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League.

FAMILIAR FACES: 21 players on the Cyclones break camp roster have previous playing experience in Brooklyn...Notables include: INF Boston Baro, who played in 11 games with Brooklyn towards the end of last season...INF Jacob Reimer, who suited up in 39 games for the 'Clones over the last two years...RHP Dakota Hawkins had a hand in the first nine inning no-hitter in franchise history last year...RHP Ben Simon logged 22 appearances, the most amongst any returning pitcher outside of Hawkins.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Seven members of the Mets' 2024 draft class will begin the 2025 campaign with the Cyclones...RHP Ryan Lambert is the lone '24 draftee that returns to the Brooklyn roster, while 1st round selection OF Carson Benge, 2nd round pick LHP Jonathan Santucci and 4th rounder OF Eli Serrano III all will make their High-A debuts... RHP Brendan Girton, RHP R.J. Gordon & INF Nick Roselli round out the class.

ROSELLI RAKES: INF Nick Roselli grew up 34 miles northeast of Maimonides Park in Long Island's Levittown...The 11th round pick played his college ball at Binghamton University, where he was a career 349 hitter for the Bearcats...The Division High School product grew up a huge Mets fan, and was considered to have the "Best Pro Debut" of any member of the 2024 Mets draft class by Baseball America...Roselli hit the ground running last year in the Florida State League, notching an .869 OPS across 18 games with Single-A year in the St. Lucie.

KEEP IT IN THE BALLPARK!: With so much of Brooklyn's pitching staff returning from last year, it's worth noting that Cyclones pitchers led the South Atlantic League by a wide margin in home runs allowed (59)...Hudson Valley was the next closest (78)...Of the 59 long balls permitted, only 20 of them came at Maimonides Park...Over the last two seasons, Brooklyn arms have surrendered just 55 home runs in 132 home games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's Opening Day Roster features no shortage of talent... According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 7 of the Mets Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), LHP Jonathan Santucci (13), INF Boston Baro (14), INF Jacob Reimer (21), C Chris Suero (22), OF Eli Serrano III (23) and C Ronald Hernandez (27)...Of those 7, 4 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), LHP Jonathan Santucci (13), INF Boston Baro (14), INF Jacob Reimer (21), C Chris Suero (22), OF Eli Serrano III (23) and C Ronald Hernandez (27)...Of those 7, 4 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn. have previous experience playing in Brooklyn.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2025 season, Santucci was ranked as the New York Mets' No. 13 prospect by MLB Pipeline and No. 16 by *Baseball America...* Deemed to have the "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2024 draft class by *Baseball America* for his slider.

SPRING BREAKOUT: Santucci was a member of the Mets' 2025 Spring Breakout roster...While still awaiting his official professional debut, the southpaw entered in relief of RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** in the bottom of the 5th inning...Santucci tossed a scoreless inning of work, facing one over the minimum, allowing one hit and one walk, and inducing a double play.

MAIDEN VOYAGE: Santucci is making his professional debut on Wednesday afternoon...The 22-year-old did not pitch after signing with the Mets on 7/22/24 for \$2.03 million...Santucci is the second player to make his professional debut for the Cyclones in 2025...RHP **R.J. Gordon** made his pro debut for Brooklyn on Tuesday night, tossing 4.1 innings of 2-run ball.

DEVILISHLY GOOD: Santucci spent his three-year collegiate career at Duke University...As a junior in 2024, the 22-year-old compiled a 6-1 record with a 3.41 ERA (22 ER in 58.0 IP), 36 walks, and 90 strikeouts in 13 starts for the Blue Devils...Santucci was named to the All-ACC First Team and recognized on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list...Missed three weeks during the 2024 season with a rib injury...Punched out a career-high 14 batters against Akron on 3/1...Was the second of back-to-back 10+ strikeout performances, whiffing 11 against Northwestern on 2/23...Limited to only 7 starts as a sophomore due to elbow surgery to remove bone chips...During his career at Duke, Santucci accrued a 10-6 mark with a 3.86 ERA (55 ER in 128.1 IP), 72 walks, and 198 strikeouts in 40 appearances (27 starts).

DUAL THREAT: During his high school career, Santucci was a two-way player at Phillips Academy (Andover, Mass.)...The left-hander registered a .322 batting average in high school, adding six doubles, two triples, three home runs, and 29 RBI...Santucci also received opportunities at the plate during his time at Duke...At the plate in college, the Leominster, Mass. native posted a .217 average (5-23) with two doubles, a home run, and 5 RBI in 24 plate appearances...Santucci played four games in the outfield at Duke, with three in right field and one in center field.

FAMILY TIES: Jonathan is not the only athlete in the Santucci family...Dad, **Steven**, played baseball at Assumption University (Worcester, Mass.) from 1991-93...Cousin, **Nick**, also played collegiate baseball at Rollins College (Winter Park, Fla.).
