FROM THE CROWS NEST

DUNEDIN DOMINATES IN GAME ONE: – Despite early production, the Marauders fell 11-3 to the Dunedin Blue Jays on Tuesday night. The Blue Jays dominated on both sides of the ball, as they collected 13 hits, including six for extra bases, while fanning 19 Bradenton hitters. The victory earned them their sixth in a row. **Konnor Griffin** and **Jhonny Severino** both launched homers, providing all of the night's damage for Bradenton. Trey Yesavage was stellar on the hill for Dunedin, fanning a career-high 12 batters over five frames. Gage Stanifer was dominant in relief, striking out seven hitters over four frames of one-run ball. Bradenton struck out 19 times at the plate (4/16 at FTM), allowed 13 hits as a staff (4/10 vs PLM) and committed three errors defensively (5th time) - all matching season birds. matching season highs.

KG SAYS HELLO: 2024 first-round pick Konnor Griffin has led off in all of his 29 games played in 2025. In the first inning this year, he is slashing, 321/.345/.607 with two home runs and four extra-base hits. Over his last three games, he has homered on the first pitch of the game's first frame twice, including last night versus No.71 overall prospect Trey Yesavage. Moreover, while jumping on the first pitch in general this year, he is 9-for-15, with five of those hits coming in the first inniing (5-for-7).

AGER TOES THE RUBBER: Right hander Peyton Stumbo will make the start for the Marauders tonight, marking his sixth start of AGEN TO THE RUBERS Hight hander Peyton Stumbo will make the start for the Maradder's tonight, individing in Start Start of the season and seventh overall appearance. Last Wednesday versus Lakeland, Stumbo's curveball was a plus offering that night, as he threw 19 of the 22 for strikes while generating whiffs on 5 of the pitch's ten induced swings. His fastball sat at 91-92 and topped out at 94.1 miles per hour. Over 19.1 innings this season, he has walked just three hitters. He enters the night with 10.2 consecutive innings without allowing a free pass.

SCOUTING THE D-JAYS: The Dunedin Blue Jays enter the week on a torrid run, having won five straight and eight of their last ten games to begin May Entering play, they lead the Florida State League in runs scored (218), home runs (32), OPS (.788) and third in walks (174). Their 3.51 team ERA also leads the league. Last week they took five of six at Fort Myers. Throughout the series, they slashed .272/.344/.451 with nine homers. On the mound, they allowed just 14 earned runs over 55.1 innings. The Mussels batted just .204 and fanned 73 times.

ROUND OF A.PLAZ: While Pirates No. 28 prospect **Axiel Plaz** leads Bradenton in hitting (.298), RBI (20) and average exit velocity (93.3 mph), his increase in contact at the plate has turned heads. Through 27 games, his whilf rate is down four percent (28.4%) and his strikeout rate has dropped by 12 percent (17.2%) while maintaing elite batted-ball quality. This year he is batting .348 and slugging .659 on pitches in the zone

MARAUDERS MASHERS: Bradenton's starting lineup features some of the highest ranked batted-ball quality in all of the Single-A level. Axiel Plaz's 58% Hard-Hit Rate (percent of batted balls with exit velocity of 95 mph+) ranks second among players to see at least 250 pitches in Single-A this season. Braylon Bishop ranks 7th (52.9%), Konnor Griffin ranks 13th, (46.6%), and Derek Berg slots in at 15th (45.9%). Moreover, Griffin's 114.2 mph single on April 8 vs PLM is the second hardest batted ball in Single-A this year. He's recorded 26 batted balls of 100 mph or harder.

MAKING HISTORY: Pirates No. 30 ranked prospect David Matoma was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on 4/26, and made his team debut tossing 1.1 innings while allowing one earned run with one punchout. The 19-year-old right hander was born in Kasana, Uganda. If he makes it to the big leagues, he would become the first player from Uganda and second from Africa (Gift Ngoepe). On Saturday, he featured a fastball that sat between 96-98 miles per hour and touched 99 multiple times. Last year, he reached 101 mph in an FCL game. In 24 prior outings before 2025, Matoma allowed just two earned runs over 38.2 innings. Over that stretch, he fanned 42 and walked 17.
