FIVE-RUN KNIGHTS SIXTH SINKS SHRIMP

A five-run Charlotte sixth inning on Friday led the Knights to a 7-1 victory over the Jumbo Shrimp. Thanks to **Jacob Amaya's** RBI double in the fourth, Jacksonville led 1-0 until the sixth. The Knights plated five in the frame and scored two more times in the eighth inning to grab a 7-1 advantage. **Jeff Lindgren** struck out a season-high nine batters and surrendered just one run on three hits in 5.1 innings. **Jordan Groshans** reached base three times in the effort.

PEN DAIS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 25 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 52 runs, 45 earned, on 93 hits (6.6 H/9) in 126.1 innings for a 3.21 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 140 strikeouts (10.0 K/9) against 72 walks (5.1 BB/9) during this recent run.

THROUGH THE GOOD TIMES AND THE BAD

Jacksonville's 7-1 loss on Friday was the Jumbo Shrimp's 12th in the last 16 games, as well as the club's eighth in the last 10 contests. Since this stretch began on May 9, Jacksonville has hit just .237/.326/.368/.694 with just 57 runs scored, tied for the fewest in Triple-A. The club has surrendered 100 runs, tied for the 10th-most in Triple-A, during this stretch. Jacksonville's 6.29 ERA is the seventh-highest at the level over this 16-game stretch. As a result, the Jumbo Shrimp are five games under .500 for the first time since beginning the 2022 campaign 2-7. They have not been six games below .500 since 2019.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 17 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 19-for-58 (.328/.409/.724/1.133) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, eight walks and 12 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances in 2022, Allen has whiffed just 18.3% of the time this season. His .173 BABIP is the second-lowest of the 178 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on Saturday, Jacksonville outfielder **Brian Miller** has reached base in 14 consecutive games, tied for the third-longest such streak this season for a Jumbo Shrimp. During this stretch, the Durham, N.C., native is 19-for-51 (.373/.468/.529/.997) with four doubles, two triples, six RBIs and six runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 12.2 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.9 percent.

THE MAYOR OF STARKVILLE

An offseason trade acquisition from the New York Mets, Jacksonville outfielder Jake Mangum has had an outstanding start to the 2023 season. The former Mississippi State Bulldog is 46-for-146 (.315/.348/.459/.807) with 10 doubles, four triples, one home run, 18 RBIs, six walks and 13 runs scored to start the campaign. Among the 130 qualified players in the IL, Mangum is tied for the third-highest line drive rate (32.2 percent) and seventh-highest opposite-field rate (41.9 percent). Those figures were at 28.2 and 32.2 percent, respectively, while playing for Triple-A Syracuse in 2022.

NOT THIS WAY

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled mightly of late. Over their last 19 games, they've combined to surrender 74 runs, 71 earned, on 91 hits (12.6 H/9) in 65.0 innings for a 9.83 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters have walked 47 (6.5 BB/9) against only 50 strikeouts (6.9 K/9).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has lost four games in a row, matching the club's longest skid of the season. The Jumbo Shrimp have not lost five in a row since a six-game skid from July 3-9, 2021... Jacksonville is just 3-7 against Charlotte this season, but the Knights have only outscored the Jumbo Shrimp by a 52-44 margin. Five of Charlotte's seven wins have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville has won only one game determined by three runs or fewer.
