LAST OUTING: Walden made his Sounds debut on June 26 vs. Gwinnett. He pitched 3.0 innings in relief, allowing a run on three hits and two walks. Striking out a couple of Stripers, Walden threw 35 of 58 pitches for strikes in Nashville's 9-8 win last Sunday.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Walden's second start and sixth outing against Indianapolis in his career. He is 1-0 with a 2.38 ERA (11.1 IP/3 ER). Walden's only start against the Indians was a 7.0 inning shutout in game one of a double-header on July 28, 2017 while pitching for Pawtucket. He last faced Indianapolis on September 2, 2021 while with Iowa (1.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 0 ER).
