On August 6, 2013, the Sounds took a 3-0 win against the Tucson Padres at Greer Stadium. Chris Narveson (7.0 IP, 2 H, 2 BB, 8 K), Michael Olmsted (1.0 IP, 0 H) and Jesus Sanchez (1.0 IP, 1 H) combined for a 3-hitter. Hunter Morris put Nashville up early with a 2-run homer in the first.

200-Plus: Rick Sweet won his 209th game as Nashville's manager Thursday night, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).
