YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their season opener to the Patriots, 5-4. In the bottom of the first, Ben Rice and Agustin Ramirez hit back-to-back solo homers to lead off the inning. Grant Richardson added an RBI single later in the inning to open a 3-0 lead for Somerset. The Flying Squirrels responded with a four-run fourth inning. **Will Wilson** brought in a run with a ground out and **Vaun Brown** clubbed a three-run homer to move Richmond ahead, 4-3. In the bottom of the fourth, Jared Wegner singled home a run to tie game, 4-4. Max Burt gave the Patriots a 5-4 lead with an RBI double in the bottom of the eighth, Somerset loaded the bases with no outs on walks, but **Evan Gates** struck out Rice before getting Ruiz to bounce into a double play turned by **Christian Koss** and **Jimmy Glowenke** to escape the jam without allowing a run. In the top of the ninth, **Andy Thomas** worked a pinch-hit walk to put the potential tying run on base, but Patriots reliever Jack Neely worked a groundout from the next batter to close out the game and the save.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second game the 2024 season and the second of this three-game series on the road against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. This series marks Richmond's first trip to Somerset since 2021. The series marks the only meetings between the two clubs this season. The two teams last faced off at The Diamond in July 2022, with the Patriots winning four-of-five.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS reached the postseason for the second consecutive season in 2022 and the fourth time in franchise history, winning the Southwest Division Second-Half title. They were eliminated by the Erie SeaWolves in the Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished 33-36, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a 41-28 record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556).

THE PATRIOTS posted the Eastern League's best record last season, going 83-53. They were swept in the Northeast Division Series by Binghamton. Somerset has hosted the New York Yankees' Double-A affiliation since the 2021 season. Somerset's roster includes four of Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects, including OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), C Ben Rice (No. 12), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 14) and C Agustin Ramirez (No. 20). Nine players are rated in MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects, including Jones (No. 2), Selvidge (No. 11), Rice (No. 13), Ramirez (No. 22), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 23), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 24), RHP Jack Neely (No. 26), INF Tyler Hardman (No. 27) and RHP Danny Watson (No. 29). Since joining the Eastern League in 2021, the Patriots have the Eastern League's best record (240-153).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Ragsdale makes his Double-A debut. Last season, he made seven starts for High-A Eugene, going 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA. His season ended in May with an oblique injury. At the time of the injury, he was leading the Northwest League in strikeouts (42) and ranked third in innings pitched (27.2). In 2022, he made five appearances in the Arizona Complex League but missed most of the year after having Thoracic Outlet Syndrome surgery in the spring. Ragsdale was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida. Before making his professional debut, he was traded to the San Francisco Giants on January 9, 2021 for pitcher Sam Coonrod. For more on Ragsdale, see page two.

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Zach Messinger makes his second regular-season start at Double-A. Last year, he was the Opening Day starter for the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades and allowed one run over five innings in a no-decision. He spent most of the season with Hudson Valley, going 1-10 with a 4.36 ERA in 21 outings. He was promoted to Somerset and made his Double-A debut on September 14, allowing two runs over 4.1 innings at New Hampshire. Messinger also started Game 1 of the Northeast Division Series at Binghamton and allowed three runs over four innings. Today marks his first start at TD Bank Ballpark. Messinger was selected in the 13th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Yankees out of the University of Virginia. He is rated by MLB.com as the No. 23 Yankees prospect.

STARTING OFF: The Flying Squirrels are 6-7 all-time on Opening Day, including a 1-5 mark on the road. They picked up their first road win to begin a season in their most recent opener on the road, which was a 7-5 victory at Bowie in 2022. Last season, the Flying Squirrels scheduled opener was rained out, but the team swept a double-header on April 8 against Reading en route to a 4-0 start, the best beginning to a season in team history. The Flying Squirrels are 4-6 all-time when opening against opponents from the Northeast Division. They have opened a season against a Yankees affiliate one other time, which was at Trenton in 2018, a 5-2 loss. Richmond is 3-5 all-time when opening against American League affiliates.

FAMILIAR FACES: Seventeen players return from last year's Flying Squirrels team, including Brett Auerbach, Victor Bericoto, John Michael Bertrand, Hayden Birdsong, Vaun Brown, Matt Frisbee, Evan Gates, Jimmy Glowenke, Clay Helvey, Wil Jensen, Ryan Murphy, Tyler Myrick, Mat Olsen, Nick Swiney, Andy Thomas, Will Wilson and Logan Wyatt. Of those players, six are beginning their third season with Richmond, including Auerbach, Brown, Gates, Helvey, Jensen and Murphy. Two players, Frisbee and Wilson, are with the Flying Squirrels for a fourth season.

HOW THEY GOT HERE: Of the 28 players on the active roster to begin the season, 23 of them were originally signed or drafted by the San Francisco Giants. Fourteen players were selected in the draft, five signed as non-drafted free agents and three were signed as international free agents. Four players, Will Wilson, Christian Koss, Carson Ragsdale and Andy Thomas, were acquired in trades. Tanner Kiest was signed as a minor-league free agent last year from independent baseball and Nick Garcia was selected in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft last December. There are 25 players who were born in the United States, including seven from California, four from North Carolina and three from Florida. Three players were born outside the United States, including Luis Toribio (Dominican Republic), Adrián Sugastey (Panama) and Victor Bericoto (Venezuela).

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: Dennis Pelfrey returns for a third season, tying Dave Machemer for the longest tenure by a Flying Squirrels manager in franchise history. He is 76 wins shy of matching Machemer's record for the most victories by a Flying Squirrels manager in team history. He is already the first manager in franchise history to lead the club to multiple postseason appearances with the team reaching the playoffs in back-to-back years for the time in 2022 and 2023.

PROSPECT WATCH: Six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25) and Ryan Murphy (No. 28). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Five players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 7), McCray (No. 14), Brown (No. 16), Victor Bericoto (No. 21) and Sugastey (No. 25).

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2017, the Flying Squirrels opened their season at The Diamond in front of a sellout crowd of 9,560 with an 11-1 win over the Hartford Yard Goats. Chris Shaw hit a two-run homer in the first to jump-start the offense. Miguel Gomez, Ryan Lollis and T.J. Bennett each also had two RBIs in the game. Dan Slania started and set an Opening Day franchise record with eight strikeouts over six innings and allowed one run.
