FRES-NOTES

PLAYOFF HOPES DWINDLE VS. THE PORTS: The Fresno Grizzlies (21-28, 59-55) tripped over the Stockton Ports (16-33, 42-71) 8-3 Tuesday evening from Chukchansi Park. The Grizzlies dropped to 78-31 all-time against the Ports (17-8 record this season) and are still one victory shy of tying the fourth-most wins against an opponent in Grizzlies' single-season history. With the loss, Fresno's playoff hopes dwindle as they now sit eight games back of the San Jose Giants in the California League North Division second half standings with 17 contests left to play (with six against one another). The Grizzlies were shellshocked, falling behind 6-0 after three innings of play. The Ports' five-run third inning ended up being the nail in the coffin. Fresno notched three runs in the bottom of the sixth thanks to Felix Tena. The right fielder smacked a two-RBI single and scampered home on a wild pitch from second. Prior to the Tena hit, Caleb Hobson swiped his 35th base of the season. This placed Hobson on the Grizzlies' Top-10 single-season stolen bases list. He joins Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) with 35 stolen bases. The Ports provided two more insurance runs, one in the seventh and the last one in the eighth. The Grizzlies offense could not muster an extra-base hit for the third straight game, but supplied seven singles (1-for-11 RISP). Kelvin Hidalgo in his Grizzlies debut led the charge with two hits. The Grizzlies used seven pitchers, tied for the most in a game this season. McCade Brown (0-1) took the defeat despite striking out three in one and two-thirds innings. Brown was returning from the injured list as he looks to regain his original form. Brady Hill (0-1) and Justin Loer (1-0) relished scoreless appearances while Nathan Blasick made his professional debut. Tyler Hoffman knotted a career-high with two innings of action and Austin Becker was electric in his outing. Becker chucked two and one-third innings, retiring the final seven batters he faced, which included a pair of 1-2-3 frames.

STOCK-PILING SOME STATS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the last of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the second set in Fresno. The Grizzlies are 78-31 all-time (18-12 last year, fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 43-11 all-time record (13-5 this year) at Banner Island Ballpark. In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

STU MAKES THE START: LHP Stu Flesland III will toe the rubber tonight for the Grizzlies. Flesland III was selected by the Rockies in the 11th round (Pick 322) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Washington. He played three years at Washington, earning all Pac-12 honors in his final season. Flesland III attended Mt. Spokane High School in Spokane, Washington and was teammates with fellow Grizzlies RHP Brady Hill.

EXPRESS LANE, FIVE RUNS OR LESS: Since July 1 (39 games), the losing team between the Grizzlies and their opponent have scored five runs or less. Since July 30 (18 games), the losing team between the Grizzlies and their opponent have scored three runs or less.

TRANSACTION-HEAVY MONTH: Since July 30, the Grizzlies have had 27 transactions. Prior to that date, the Grizzlies had 27 total transactions for the season. Among those 27 transactions, 13 of them have been players added to the Grizzlies' active roster. Six of those other moves have been promotions to upper-levels, three have been Rockies' releases, three have been injury list placements and two have involved MLB rehab players.

THE 2024 DRAFT PICKS HAVE ARRIVED: The Grizzlies have added five 2024 Rockies' Draft Picks to their roster. 2nd-round OF Jared Thomas (Texas), 6th-round LHP Konner Eaton (George Mason), 7th-round RHP Fidel Ulloa (LSU), 13th-round LHP Justin Loer (LSU) and 19th-round RHP Nathan Blasick (New Orleans).

WELCOME KELVIN HIDALGO: The Rockies have added 19-year-old Kelvin Hidalgo to the Grizzlies roster. In 2023, Hidalgo was named the Dominican Summer League MVP and is currently in his first season stateside. He is most likely the Grizzlies' 2025 starting shortstop.

CONGRATULATIONS TO ANDY PEREZ: The Rockies have announced that INF Andy Perez has been promoted to High-A Spokane. Perez, who has been a mainstay in Fresno for two years, has been one of the most reliable players in recent Grizzlies' memory. Being the youngest player for two years, Perez has shown immense development, beating most of his offensive statistics in his second season. In two years, Perez appeared in 228 games, batting .268/.302/.374/.676 with 10 homers, 14 triples, 38 doubles, 117 RBI, 127 runs, 41 walks and 36 stolen bases. He also finished with a Fresno career .951 fielding percentage, which was between second base (1,000), shortstop (.959) and third base (.913). Perez finished tied for seventh all-time in Grizzlies career triples (14) and reached the Top-10 in Single-Season triples twice (7, 2023 & 2024). Congratulations to Andy Perez!

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot (41 games), he has reached base 72 times in 193 plate appearances (37% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 41 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 36 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-33 (27%) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-41, 41% of the time he reaches base in his first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 20 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (35/41 in stolen bases on the season).

RUNNING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has joined the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Record Books with 35 stolen bases (August 20, 6th inning vs. Stockton). He tied Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) for ninth all-time in that stolen base category. Up next for Hobson is Michael Byas (2000), Justin Christian (2011), Gary Brown (2014) and Zac Veen (2021), who are tied for fifth with 36 stolen bases.

TEN OUT OF TEN(A) FOR TRIPLES: Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena is one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Record Books in Top 10 Single-Season Triples. Tena looks to catch former teammate Andy Perez (2023 and 2024), as well as Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999), who each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons.
