Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds can take five out of six against the Omaha Storm Chasers with a win this afternoon. Keston Hiura hit a walk off single for the victory last night. Left-hander Robert Gasser starts for the Sounds, facing Omaha's Jonathan Heasley.

Robert Gasser: 23-year-old Robert Gasser makes his fifth start of the season tonight. He is 1-0 with a 3.50 ERA (18.0 IP/7 ER) to start the year. In his last outing in game one of the series, Gasser earned the win with 5.0 innings, allowing three runs. He is touted as the No. 9 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. Gasser was traded to the Brewers organization from San Diego as part of the Josh Hader trade on August 1, 2022. He was originally drafted by San Diego in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Houston.

Jonathan Heasley: 26-year-old Jonathan Heasley starts for the Storm Chasers tonight. The righty is 1-3 with a 9.12 ERA (25.2 IP/26 ER) through five starts in 2023. Heasley spent the majority of last season with Kansas City, going 4-10 with a 5.28 ERA (104.0 IP/61 ER) across 21 starts. He also went 1-2 with a 4.35 ERA (39.1 IP/19 ER) in nine starts with Omaha in 2022. Heasley made his Major League debut in a start on September 17, 2021 at Seattle (L, 4.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 0 BB, 2 K). The Royals drafted Heasley in the 13th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Oklahoma State University.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 12, Sixth: 2, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Walk Off City: The Sounds recorded their fifth walk off victory with Keston Hiura's RBI single that scored Eddy Alvarez and started another mob scene at first base. Nashville's five walk off wins are the most in a single month in First Horizon Park history (since 2015).

Best in Triple-A: The Nashville pitching staff boasts the lowest ERA in Triple-A with a mark of 3.44 (219.2 IP/84 ER). Though starters have the eighth-best ERA at 4.37, the Sounds bullpen's ERA of 2.79 checks in just behind Memphis at second. Sounds relievers have yet to allow a run this week, stringing together 23 consecutive scoreless innings.

Bull on Parade: Abraham Toro pushed his on-base streak to 19 games and his hitting streak to 14 games last night with a single. His on-base streak is tied for the second longest active streak in the league with Jon Singleton and Tyler Freeman of Columbus and is only trailing Colton Cowser's 20game on-base streak with Norfolk. His hitting streak is the second longest active streak in the IL. Toro is batting .364 (20-for-55) during the hitting streak with five doubles and 10 RBI.

Getting His Steps In: Jon Singleton extended his on-base streak to 19 games with four walks last night. It was the 24th time a Sounds batter walked four times in a game and the first since Singleton did it on August 3, 2022 at Norfolk. It was his third four-walk game of his career. Like Toro, Singleton is tied for the second longest active on-base streak in the IL. He's batting .246 (15-for-61) during the streak with nine RBI and 19 walks.

Hiura is Hot: Keston Hiura is batting .542 (13-for-24) with four runs, three doubles, two homers and 10 RBI over the past seven games. He has hit safely in all seven of them, including last night's walk off single. On the season, Hiura ranks among league leaders in home runs (T-4th, 9), slugging (5th, .700), RBI (T-5th, 23), OPS (6th, 1.082) and total bases (7th, 56).

On the Mend: Milwaukee right-hander Adrian Houser tossed 5.0 innings on Friday, the longest start of his rehab stint. He has a 3.07 ERA (14.2 IP/5 ER) in four rehab starts. Despite his 0-for-4 showing last night, outfielder Tyrone Taylor played his fourth game on rehab assignment last night and is batting .235 (4-for-17) with a double, a triple and three RBI.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 24 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 613-529 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Gasser opened the series on April 25 vs. Omaha. He set a new season high with eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings and getting his first win of 2023. He allowed four hits and three runs on 81 pitches and 49 strikes.
