YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 5-1, for their fourth straight win. **Kai-Wei Teng** started and struck out 10 batters over four scoreless innings. The Richmond pitching staff combined for 21 strikeouts, tying the overall team record and a new single-game franchise record for strikeouts in a nine-inning game. The Flying Squirrels scored all five of their runs in the fourth inning. **Carter Aldrete** broke the scoreless tie with a two-run homer. **Ismael Munguia** added an RBI single and **Luis Matos** brought in two runs with a double. Harrisburg scored its lone run in the bottom of the ninth inning.

UIRRELS

TUDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The only other season the Senators have played their first home series against the Flying Squirrels was 2021, with each team winning three games. Richmond won the first three, including a no-hitter by **Matt Frisbee** and three relievers on May 13, 2021. This year, the Flying Squirrels visit Harrisburg for two series. The will also play a three-game set at FNB Field from July 13-16 out of the All-Star Break. The Senators come to Richmond twice for two six-game series from June 20-25 and August 15-20.

FOUR-FOR-FOUR: With a three-game sweep over the Fightin Phils last weekend and a win in the series opener at Harrisburg, the Flying Squirrels are 4-0 to begin the 2023 season. This year marks the first time the team has opened the season with four straight wins. The previous best unbeaten start was a 3-0 record to begin the 2019 season.

WHIFF: Tuesday's 21 strikeouts for the Flying Squirrels' pitching staff a franchise single-game record, matching a mark set last season against Somerset at The Diamond in an 11-inning game. It was a new team record for the most strikeouts in a nine-inning game. It marked the most strikeouts in a nine-inning game in the minors this season. Only Double-A Rocket City has picked up more in a single game this year, striking out 23 in 11 innings against Chattanooga on April 6. Low-A Rancho Cucamonga also struck out 21 batters against Inland Empire on April 8 in 10 innings. It was the most strikeouts in a nine-inning game in the minors since Double-A Montgomery fanned 21 at Mississippi on June 5, 2022. It was also the most strikeouts for a nine-inning game in the Eastern League since at least 2005. The 10 strikeouts by Kai-Wei Teng was tied for the most in an Eastern League game this year, even with Erie pitcher Ty Madden on April 8 at Akron. The Richmond pitching staff has struck out 54 batters through the first four games, the most in the Eastern League.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS continue the a new season this weekend after qualifying for the postseason in 2022 for the first time in eight years, winning the Eastern League Southwest Division first-half title before being eliminated in the Division Series by Erie. Richmond went 66-71 overall, posting a 40-29 mark in the first half and a 26-42 record in the second half. Last year's team also set a franchise record with 169 homers, passing the previous mark of 127 set in 2021.

THE SENATORS opened the season dropping two-of-three at Somerset last Friday and Saturday. Harrisburg's season-opener was rained out last Thursday. They lost, 6-5, on Friday before alternating shutouts in a doubleheader split on Saturday. In 2022, the Senators went 52-85, the worst record in the Eastern League. They went 30-39 in the first half and 22-46 in the second half. Harrisburg's roster includes six of Baseball America's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Jackson Rutledge (No. 28). The Senators' roster also features four of MLB.com's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Jackson Rutledge (No. 24), Gerardo Carrillo (No. 28) and Drew Millas (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his first start of the season. He made his season debut out of the bullpen in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader against the Fightin Phils and struck out five over two scoreless innings. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College in Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. For more on Murphy, see page two.

FOR HARRISEURG: Right-hander Michael Cuevas makes his Double-A debut. The 21-year-old Texas native was selected by the Nationals in the 23rd round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of high school. He spent last year with the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks, where he went 6-12 with a 4.64 ERA in 26 outings (24 starts).

FULL MUNGUIA: After missing the entire 2022 season with an injury, Ismael Munguia got off to a hot start in his Double-A debut on Saturday. In Game 1 of the doubleheader, he led off the bottom of the first inning with a single to center for his first Double-A hit. He finished the game 2-for-3 with a walk, an RBI and a run scored. In Game 2, he went 1-for-3 with a walk and a run scored, reaching base five times in the doubleheader. After going hitless on Sunday, he picked up an RBI single in Tuesday's win.

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's Opening Day roster includes 14 players who have previously spent time with the Flying Squirrels. Returners include pitchers Matt Frisbee, Ryan Murphy, Kai-Wei Teng, Evan Gates, Randy Rodriguez, Wil Jensen, Chris Wright and Blake Rivera, catcher Brandon Martorano and infielders Tyler Fitzgerald, Carter Aldrete, Brett Auerbach, Riley Mahan and Simon Whiteman.

FRESH FACES: Thirteen players on the Opening Day roster will be playing for Richmond for the first time. Newcomers to Richmond include pitchers Nick Zwack, Erik Miller, Carson Seymour, Mason Black, Nick Swiney, Raymond Burgos, Michael Stryffeler, Juan Sanchez, catchers Andy Thomas and Patrick Bailey, infielder Hayden Cantrelle and outfielders Luis Matos and Ismael Munguia. Of these players, only Miller and Stryffeler have previous experience at the Double-A level.

SQUIRRELS AROUND THE WORLD: The Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster includes players from five different countries. Two players, Luis Matos and Juan Sanchez were born in Venezuela. Randy Rodriguez is a native of the Dominican Republic. Ismael Munguia became the second player in team history born in Nicaragua with his debut on Saturday. Raymond Burgos was born in Puerto Rico and Kai-Wei Teng is from Taiwan. Twenty-one players are natives of the United States, spanning 16 different states, including a team-high four from California.

HOW THEY GOT HERE: Eighteen players were originally signed or drafted by the San Francisco Giants. Eleven players were selected in the MLB Draft, four were signed as international free agents and three were signed as non-drafted free agents. Two players were signed as minor league free agents after starting their careers in other organizations. Riley Mahan, previously with the Miami Marlins organization, was signed last May. Raymond Burgos signed in December after reaching free agency following seven years as a member of the Cleveland Guardians organization. Seven players were acquired via trade. Kai-Wei Teng came in a deal with the Minnesota Twins in 2019. Hayden Cantrelle was swapped from the Marlins in 2022. Carson Seymour and Nick Zwack came to the Giants in a trade with the New York Mets at the trade deadline last year, the same day Andy Thomas and Michael Stryffeler were traded from the Seattle Mariners. Erik Miller was traded from the Philadelphia Phillies in January.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Tyler Fitzgerald is ranked tied for fourth in batting average (.417), fourth for .533 (OBP), tied for ninth in SLG (.667), seventh in OPS (1.200) and tied for first in triples (1). Luis Matos is 10th in OBP (.471), 10th in OPS (1.114) and third in runs scored (5). Andy Thomas is tied for second in walks (5). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for first in strikeouts (10). Nick Zwack is tied for third in strikeouts (9), sixth in BAA (.077) and tied for first in WHIP (0.25).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Erik Miller (No. 15), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24), Patrick Bailey (No. 27) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).


THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY
