Palacios was acquired in the Minor League Rule 5 Draft by the Pirates in Dec. 2022. He went on to appear in 91 games last year for the Buccos, hitting .239 AVG with 10 HR and 40 RBIs. He was originally drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft. Palacios spent almost the entire season with the Dunedin Blue Jays in 2018 where he was named a Post-Season All-Star. In 125 games, the left-handed hitter slashed .292/.357/.418 with 30 doubles, 8 HR, 78 RBIs while stealing 15 bases.
