LAST OUTING: Lindblom last pitched on September 15 vs. Jacksonville in a win against the Jumbo Shrimp. He went 6.0 innings and held Jacksonville to a run on five hits for a quality start. The right-hander totaled 74 pitches and 53 strikes while striking out four.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Lindblom is facing Louisville for the third time in 2022. He went 3.0 innings in a rain-shortened start on May 21 (3.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 K) and took the loss in relief on July 24 at Louisville Slugger Field (1.2 IP, 5 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 2 K). He made four starts against Louisville last year and went 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA. He made two relief appearances against the Bats in 2017 with Triple-A Indianapolis.
