Today marks game #88 of the 2022 season, the first game of a three-game roadtrip, and the first game of a three-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 24 times during the 2021 regular season, with the Whitecaps going 10-14. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 28th season in professional baseball, while Great Lakes is in their 15th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. The last playoff meeting with Great Lakes came in the 2018 Midwest League Eastern Division Quarterfinals, with the Whitecaps sweeping a two-game series.

**UP NEXT:** The 'Caps return home for a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons beginning on Tuesday, July 26 from LMCU Ballpark before hitting the road for a six-game set in the State Capital against the Lansing Lugnuts from Aug 2-7 at Jackson Field.

### STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

**LAST TIME OUT:** Jake Holton's game-winning two-run double delivered the West Michigan Whitecaps a dramatic 5-4, tenth-inning victory over the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in front of 5,452 fans Sunday at LMCU Ballpark. Holton finished the game 2-for-3 with three RBIs and his second walk-off hit of the series, while the West Michigan bullpen held Wisconsin scoreless through the last 4.2 innings with three strikeouts in the win. Timber Rattlers outfielder Tristan Peters opened the game with a two-run home run in the first inning, putting Wisconsin in front 2-0. West Michigan responded in the second as Josh Crouch roped an RBI double before Joe Gray plated Jose Acosta on a run-scoring single in the third, extending the lead to 3-1. Whitecaps relievers Jack O'Loughlin, Bryce Tassin, Andrew Shaps, and Gio Arriera held the Rattlers to two hits as Holton and Bryant Packard pounded back-to-back RBI singles in the eighth, tying the game at three going into the ninth. Wisconsin put runners on first and second with just one out before a double play squandered the opportunity, sending the game tied 3-3 into extra frames. Wisconsin struck first in the tenth as Wes Clarke lifted a sacrifice fly to put the Timber Rattlers on top 4-3. The Whitecaps advanced runners into second and third base with just one out in the bottom of the tenth before Holton delivered the game-winning two-run double, scoring Trei Cruz and Corey Joyce and sending West Michigan on to the dramatic 5-4 victory. Whitecaps closer Gabe Sequeira (2-2) collected his second win of the year, allowing one run with a strikeout in the tenth inning. Timber Rattlers closer Taylor Floyd (1-2) suffers his second loss, allowing two runs through two innings pitched. This victory marks the first time the Whitecaps have won five games in consecutive six-game series since Minor League Baseball reformatted its schedule in 2020. Furthermore, five of the last seven victories the Whitecaps have over Wisconsin have come via a walk-off.

**GOT US A 12-PACK:** The 'Caps scored 12 runs in the third inning of their 7/4 20-1 victory over the Dayton Dragons -- the most runs in a single frame by any team in Minor League Baseball. The 19-run win also broke the franchise record for largest margin of victory in a game, topping the mark of 18 runs in a 19-1 win on 6/1/14 at Fort Wayne.

**LEAVING ON A HIGH NOTE:** The Whitecaps have won 11 of their 15 games to end a series during the 2022 season.

**MADDEN '22:** Pitcher Ty Madden was named Midwest League Player of the Week on June 27 after tossing 10 scoreless innings while only giving up three hits and striking out nine batters. Madden ranks as the Tigers No. 5 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

**HISTORY FOR HOLTON:** Infielder Jake Holton collected seven RBI, including two homers -- one of which served as the game-winning home run as part of a June 14 8-7 win over the Peoria Chiefs at Dozer Park - a performance last replicated by 2012 infielder Aaron Westlake on June 3 at Great Lakes. Only one player in franchise history has collected more RBI in a single game -- Jeremy Laster -- who drove in eight runs in a game played on 8-8-08, at Alliant Energy Field at Clinton. The performance led to his being named the MWL Player of the Week on June 19.

**2,000 SECURED:** The West Michigan Whitecaps opened the 2022 regular season with a 5-1 victory over the Great Lakes Loons for their 2,000th win in club history at Dow Diamond on April 8. The Whitecaps finished the 2021 season one victory short of the franchise milestone, but wasted no time hitting the mark in 2022. West Michigan recorded their 1,000th win when they beat the Clinton LumberKings 5-0 in Comstock Park on April 14, 2007.

**PROSPECTS APLENTY:** The Whitecaps hold six of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects. Players include those mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

Acquired: Signed as an undrafted free agent with the Tigers on August 25, 2016.

The 21-year old righty began the 2021 season as not only the youngest player on the Whitecaps roster, but also their Opening Day starting pitcher at Fort Wayne. Montero entered the 2021 season ranked as high as the Tigers #20 prospect by The Detroit News, but a shoulder injury ended his season in July. He'll look to bounce back in 2022. He's the Detroit Tigers #29 prospect entering the 2022 season, according to MLB Pipeline.

**LAST START:** Montero tossed one of his best games of the season, holding the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers to just two hits without issuing a walk and striking out five as part of a 5-0 victory on July 15 at LMCU Ballpark.

**2021:** Montero was challenged in his 2021 season in High-A West Michigan, going 4-8 with a 5.28 ERA in 15 starts. In 61.1 IP, Montero allowed 84 base hits and opponents to hit .321 against him on the year. The 1.68 WHIP marked one of the highest among Whitecaps pitchers in 2021, and he'll look to improve on in the coming years.

**2019:** Split the season between the Gulf Coast and New York Penn League, and posted a 2.08 ERA in 10 starts and 47.2 innings while striking out 49.

**DETROIT NEWS SAYS:** "Wait on this guy. Because as he adds sinew and savvy to a pitching package that already impresses, Montero could be one of the best stories from Detroit's farm in 2021 and beyond. That work he did at Single-A Connecticut during a short stint there in 2019, when he had just turned 19, was a nice window into Montero's portfolio: 24.2 innings, 22 hits, five hits, 26 strikeouts. This kid has a future." ~ Lynn Henning

**SCOUTS SAY: *From Prospects Live:***

Mechanics: Slings the ball from a high 3/4 slot with medium effort. Hand break, leg kick and impressive arm speed yield decent deception. Repeats fairly well from the windup; rushes mechanics from the stretch.

Fastball: 90-93 t94 with modest life in the zone. Some sink and tailing action low in the zone and slight riding life in the upper third.

Curveball: 72-79 - sits below-average to fringy and flashes plus. Lacks consistent desired velocity, shape and feel. Lobs in more 72-74mph cement mixers than you'd optimally prefer. Offering is at its best when it features tight late breaking 11/5 shape and target zone velocity of 77-79 mph. Continued pro instruction should mitigate these mechanical and grip deficiencies. Throws the high spin rate breaking ball for strikes and as a spiked chase pitch out of the zone. Modest gains of consistency could make it a solid bat missing weapon at the highest level.

Changeup: 83-85 - Minimal feel; lacks conviction and consistent arm-speed. Features moderate downward tumble at its best.

Overall: Modest chance to stick in the rotation; best chance at a big league future is in a relief role. Squint and there's some Role 40 reliever potential should the command improve and the breaking ball find consistency. An uptick in velocity and / or FB life would definitely help move the needle. High risk profile, with a more realistic outcome of a solid, role 30 high minors depth arm. A nice lottery ticket with some upside, worth keeping an eye on.
